





own insurance company a statement, this does NOT require you to give a recorded statement to the other driver's insurance company. In fact, you should never give a recorded statement until you have consulted with an experienced personal injury lawyer. Insurance companies' claims adjusters are professional negotiators with extensive experience. They are well trained to ask questions in a manner designed to hurt your claim. Insurance adjusters are trained to save money for the insurance companies.

If they can do that by making fault questionable or by establishing that your medical claims are unfounded or unrelated, they may avoid having to pay for the full extent of your injuries.

Usually the insurance adjuster taking the statement is not the insurance adjuster who handles the property damage and the adjuster that handles the property damage claim is not the one that handles the personal injury claim. The one who wants you to talk can be charming. The one who wants to pay you as little as possible won't be.

I also don't believe that these questions really can be answered accurately after an accident. Yet we all know that any inaccuracy will be used by the insurance company to make it appear as if you were lying. The problem is that the impressions left in memory after a sudden accident aren't accurate. There is no substitute for going to the scene with an attorney and foot looking at skid marks, scuff marks and debris left on the pavement as well as having a look at the distances involved. Only after you know the facts should you attempt to state the facts.







A Date Which Will Live in Infamy

EDITOR'S NOTE: Japan's

December 7, 1941 attack on seven military installations on the Hawaiian island of Oahu precipitated America's entry into World War II. That action galvanized this nation in one spirit like no other event before or since. Pearl Harbor still stands as a symbol of American unity, resilience, and resolve. The four tumultuous years that followed were led here and abroad by the men and women who are often recognized as part of America's greatest generation. Precious few of them are still with us.

As our nation recognizes the 75th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor, the following text is the complete December 8, 1941 address by President Franklin Delano Roosevelt to Congress, now known as the Infamy Speech. 

Medicare Minute

The Medicare "Donut Hole"

Most Medicare prescription drug plans have a coverage gap or "donut hole". This means there is a temporary limit on what the drug plan will pay while you are in the gap. The good news is not everyone will enter the coverage gap. The coverage gap begins after you and your plan have spent a certain amount on covered drugs. In 2017 once you and your plan combined have spent \$3,700 you will enter the coverage gap.

Here's the way the coverage gap works. Imagine you have a prescription that retails for \$300 per month. Your copay, hypothetically, is \$30. This means your plan would pay the rest of the cost or \$270. Medicare will track what you paid (\$30) and what your plan paid (\$270) and count the cost of the drug as \$300 for that month. Let's also say that the other prescriptions you are taking equals \$100 per month. You are now at \$400 per month. In this example you would reach the coverage gap sometime in October.

Under most plans in 2017 once you have reached the coverage gap your plan will temporarily stop paying anything on your drugs. This means you will be responsible for the entire cost of your prescriptions. The silver lining around this very dark cloud is Medicare has negotiated a discount on the drugs you use. For name brand drugs you will pay 40% of the retail price of the drug and on generic drugs you will pay 51% of the retail price.

If you are eligible for Medicare but still on employer coverage you may wonder why you have never reach the coverage gap. This is because employer coverage does not have the "donut hole". The coverage gap only applies to Medicare prescription drug plans. Also remember that Medicare drug plans can vary which means your coverage in the gap can vary.

Home Security for the Holidays

Do you feel like the Christmas holidays are super busy? Are you a little stressed and overwhelmed at everything you have to do? According to Lieutenant Ken Lester of the Florence Police Department, burglars are counting on that. Lt. Lester said that the Shoals sees an increase in home-related thefts between Thanksgiving and Christmas every year. He says that everything is so busy around the holidays and thieves take advantage of people being preoccupied. If you're busy, you might forget some of the important ways to protect your home, leaving it vulnerable to a break-in. These are some of the most important things to remember:

 Never leave boxes for expensive items outside your home for any length of time. Lester recommends cutting boxes up and otherwise breaking them down so that they fit into the recycle bin with the lid closed. You can also call and schedule pickup of large boxes, putting them out just in time to be picked up. Another option is to take the boxes to the Recycling Center at 1200 Terrace Street, Florence. They have bins outside for drop-offs, whether the office is open or not.

• Always leave your home with the appearance that there's someone there. One common misconception is that it is best to close all blinds and curtains when you aren't home. According to Lt. Lester, that screams "Unoccupied!" Instead, leave at least one window blind or curtain open and a light somewhere inside that can be seen. He advocates the use of timers, inexpensive devices which turn lamps or other items on and off at scheduled times. You want the home to be well-lit after dark. Away for a few days? Definitely have your mail and paper stopped or have a trusted person to collect it. Finally, leave a vehicle in the driveway, even if you have room for four in the garage.

• Make your home look like a hard target. According to Lt. Lester, statistics prove that most professional thieves won't spend more than 1-2 minutes assessing a target. If your home appears to be difficult to get in and out of undetected, they will usually move on to another, easier target.

• Either have a security system or appear to have one. While signs advertising a system are in no way a replacement for the real thing, they are certainly better than none.
