## Local surgeon initiated into **American College of Surgeons**

LaToya Walker, MD, FACOG, FACS, was among 1,823 initiates from around the world who became Fellows of the American College of Surgeons (FACS) during the convocation ceremony at the College's 2016 annual Clinical Congress in Washington, DC, in October. This year's class of initiates was among one of the largest ever admitted into the

Dr. Walker received a medical doctorate in 2015 from Ross University School of Medicine and is currently practicing at Family Health Center, located at 117 South 11th Avenue in Laurel. In 2014, Dr. Walker attained board certification from the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Dr. Walker has surgical expertise in obstetrics and gynecology, with a strong professional interest in cervical dysplasia and minimal invasive surgery. Dr. Walker holds membership in other professional societies, including American College of

Obstetrics and Gynecology, American College of Surgeons and Association of Women Surgeons. Dr. Walker is a part of the South Central Regional Medical Center medical staff.

By meeting the College's stringent membership requirements, Fellows of the College have earned the distinguished right to use the designation of "FACS" (Fellow, American College of Surgeons) after their names. An applicant for Fellowship must be a graduate of an approved medical school; must have completed advanced training in one of the 14 surgical specialties recognized by the College; must possess certification by an American surgical specialty board or appropriate certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada; and must have been in practice for at least one year at the time of his or her application. Before admission into Fellowship, the surgeon must further demonstrate ethical fitness and professional proficiency, and his or her acceptance as a Fellow of the College must be approved



by three-fourths of its Board of Regents.

## The rut habits of White-tailed deer

White-tailed deer are the most interesting and sought after animals in North America and Mississippi. Depending on where you are located in the Magnolia State, deer usually breed between December 10 and February 4. Does normally breed only once per year; however, they may come into "heat" three to four times a year beginning in December and ending in February. The periods of "heat" last about 24 to 36 hours and occur about 28 days apart. A doe may have from one to three fawns per year, depending on her physical condition; about half the does in Mississippi produce two fawns per year. Does in Mississippi do not breed until they are 1.5 years old. Many people believe that old does do not breed, but they do breed and produce young as long as they live.

Bucks do not come in "heat," but rather enter "rut." Rut consists of sparring, spreading of sign (rubs, scrapes, etc.), courtship and breeding. Sparring begins after bucks lose their velvet. Most bucks are fairly tolerant of each other during sparring. Sparring serves to establish which bucks in an area are dominant. Body and antler size are good indicators of a buck's social dominance. Bucks communicate with other deer during rut through various visual and scent signals. "Rubs" are trunks or stems of trees or bushes that bucks rub bark off of with their antlers and head. Glands in the head leave scent on the rub. "Scrapes" consist of broken limbs three to six feet above ground, with a small depression pawed in the soil underneath on which the buck urinates. Bucks return often to scrapes to freshen their scent. A buck often locates the scent of a doe in "heat" near a scrape and will follow her with his nose to the ground while making a grunting sound. Bucks will also urinate on their inner leg glands to signal other deer. Rubs, scrapes and urinating on the tarsal glands all serve to assert a buck's social dominance and to locate does.

During courtship, bucks become loners. Also, during courtship, tolerance among bucks disappears and fierce fights between bucks occur. Unless a doe is in "heat," she will run from a buck. Although all bucks court, only dominant bucks breed with does. Peak fawning times in Mississippi occur between June 22 and July 22. Fawns remain hidden near their birthplace for roughly two weeks, but by the time the fawn is 1-month-old it will begin to follow its mother. Fawns will nurse until they are three to five months.

Bucks take no part in raising the fawns. A fawn will lose its spotted coat at four months. Male fawns follow their mother for about one year; female fawns follow for about two years. Deer in Mississippi feed mostly during the late afternoon and night. Generally, they spend the day bedded down in cover resting. An adult deer requires about 8 to 10 pounds of food per day, and about two to three quarts of water per day (depending on the type of food eaten).

## A Shepherd's Heart -Be it unto me

In Luke's narrative of the Christmas story, we are given the account of the angel Gabriel appearing to Mary and informing her that she has been chosen by God to be the mother of His only begotten Son. As we read



this narrative, found in Luke 1:26-38, we cannot help but ask the question, "How would I respond to a message like that?" Mary, a young teen-aged girl, was engaged to Joseph and they were certainly anxiously waiting for the engagement period to end and the marriage to be consummated. In the meantime, Gabriel, a messenger from the God, appeared to Mary with some shocking news.

This news was so shocking that it left Mary fearful, confused and in a state of amazement. It is interesting to note that Gabriel was fully aware of Mary's reaction to his news, and he was able to soothe her fears and encourage her by letting her know that she had been chosen by God so there was no need to be fearful. That reminds me of a pastor friend who I hear say quite often, "If God calls you to it, He will carry your through it." Certainly this was the case as Gabriel continued his conversation with Mary. Gabriel gives her all the details of God's plan for her to conceive and bear a Son who will be named Jesus. Mary's first response was, "How can this be since I am a virgin?" This question was given a response by Gabriel that described how God would miraculously cause her conception of this child who would be called the Son of God.

To further answer her question, Gabriel told her of Elizabeth's pregnancy in her old age and reminded Mary that nothing is impossible with God. This response to her question must have been all she needed to hear to completely surrender to God's Will for her life. We see the evidence of this reality in the following statement, "Be it unto me according to your Word." When I read that statement made by Mary, I cannot help but think ahead in time to when the Child she would bear would be kneeling in a garden with a few of his disciples on the night of His arrest, praying these words, "Not my will, but Yours be done!" The mother of Jesus was praying the same prayer of surrender to the will of the Father in her life. Simply Amazing!

This leads me to ask the following question, "Am I willing to make the prayer of Mary, and that of Jesus, my prayer of commitment to the Father?" 

## Tyler Moore may be headed to Marlins

We finally have a Final Four in college football. Number one Alabama will meet No. 4 Washington in the Peach Bowl, while No. 2 Ohio State will play No. 3 Clemson in the Fiesta Bowl. Both games will be played on December 31. Penn State (11-2), who



won the Big 10 championship and beat Ohio State in the regular season, may have a case for being left out. But, in the end, the playoff committee picked four worthy teams. Former USM football coach Jeff Bower is a member of the 13-person committee.

The Magnolia State had two teams selected for postseason play. Mississippi State (5-7) will play in a school record seventh straight bowl. The Bulldogs will play Miami (Ohio) in the St. Petersburg Bowl, on Monday, December 26. The Bulldogs slipped into a bowl despite a losing record because of their outstanding NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR), which was 971. # Cattle producers come together, push back against market crash

When you visit the grocery store and shop for meat to feed your family, you are likely unaware of the market dynamics that affect the prices you pay at the register. But America's beef producers are painfully aware of those market dynamics and have been feeling the effects of them within their fields and pastures

Just recently, the Organization for Competitive Markets, a farmer oriented political action group, met in Bay Springs at the Jones County Junior College Jasper County Center to discuss the falling beef prices and its impact upon the farming industry in the U.S. When you pay nearly \$4 a pound for ground beef, you are likely thinking that the guys and gals who work to produce that beef are making a fortune. In fact, nothing could be further from the truth. According to Fred Stokes, director of OCM, calf prices are one half of what they were, even a year

"Its as if someone rode into your herd and stole half your

So, if the local farmers and beef producers are not realizing the profits to be made from the continued rise of beef prices at the grocer, who is getting all the money? According to Stokes, the bulk of the money is being collected and summarily spent by the National Cattlemen's Beef Association. Stokes says upon auditing the association, it became apparent that according to a limited survey by the Clifton Gunderson accounting firm in a 2010 audit, it appears \$200,000 of improper expenditures were made with the probability that millions of dollars were misappropriated by the board with no accountability as to where it went. Stokes says the misappropriations are important to cattle producers across the country because all of the money received by NCBA comes from a beef tax known as, 'the check off,' program. Under the "check off" program, the NCBA mandates that beef producers who sale their cows into the U.S. marketplace must pay \$1 a head to the NCBA each time any particular animal is sold. Stokes says the result of an investigation requested by OCM into the handling of the funds was finally revealed in 2012; that report exonerated NCBA of all misdeeds involved with the handling of the "check off" money. Stokes said that report was obviously flawed, and OCM launched a lawsuit in 2013 against NCBA to finally get to the bottom of what happened to the "check off" funds cattlemen have been paying for years. The lawsuit was enjoined by the Humane Society, which

tion to be involved with farmers who produce animal products, but the Society knows and understands that U.S. farmers give the best care to their animals than anyone in the world," Stokes Said. "The Humane Society has been and continues to be an invaluable asset to the effort we are now involved in."

of funds from the check off program, other matters of interest were addressed at the meeting. Stokes said one other matter U.S. cattle producers face, as relates to profit margins on the farm, is the repeal of a law that mandated beef and pork producers to put "country of origin labels" on all beef, pork and chicken products sold in the U.S. The law, called COOL, was originally passed in 2013 as a consumer information effort that would allow the

public knowledge of where beef, pork, and chicken that makes it to the dining room table, is actually grown and produced. The law met stiff competition from foreign producers and packers, represented by the World Trade Organization, saying it unjustly gave the U.S. producers an advantage as consumers, given the choice, would choose U.S. produced commodities as opposed to those produced outside the U.S. In response to the law, and led by the WTO, both Canada and Mexico threatened retaliatory tariff measures that would amount to \$3.6 billion dollars, greatly engorging the whopping trade deficit the U.S. already had incurred. The fear of such a tariff inspired Congressional legislators to declare the COOL law a failure and thus the repeal it in June of 2015. Since the repeal of COOL, U.S. cattle, pork and beef profits on livestock produced here in the U.S. has plummeted. Mike Callicrate, an OCM director and cattle producer from Colorado Springs, CO, told the gathering the mission of OCM had to be the reclamation of a competitive market in all the farming sectors within the U.S.

"Never has so much money been spent (by consumers) on food with so little of it coming back to the farmers," Callicrate

told the audience. "Every month, one thousand farmers and ranchers go out of business.

In 2014, according to Calicrate, the move to repeal COOL was an overt move to increase imports of cheaper commodities. That 2015 repeal of COOL has led to the consumer not knowing where their food is coming from and has created an unfair market place for U.S. producers that is putting farmers and ranchers out of business. While all of us would like to see better prices at the grocery store, the consumer has not seen a reduction in meat prices since the repeal of COOL. In fact, if anything, meat prices have increased and are continuing to increase at the grocer.

According to Callicrate and Stokes, the cheaper foreign commodities coupled with the increased cost of meat products at the grocery store, has inflated the pockets of large corporations that have taken over the beef, pork, and chicken markets in the U.S.

"I truly think that if the people of this country knew that there is no way for them to know where the meat and produce items that they put on their tables comes from, there would be a uproar." Stokes said. "That is what the repeal of 'COOL' has

"He [Murphy] is an outstanding player and is as good as anyone we've seen this year at that position," Laurel head coach Todd Breland said after the game.


