### Code Corner by John Polito,



Village of Mount Morris Code Enforcement Officer

#### Unregistered vehicles, boats, trailers and campers.

The building codes do not allow residents to have unregistered vehicles, boats, trailers or campers visible in their yard. The Mayor is heading up a task force to begin working on compliance with these codes early in 2017.

If you have an unregistered vehicle(s), find your titles and either register them with DMV, sell them or take them to the junk yard. It can take up to 10 working days to get your title, so please act now.

A junk yard can take your vehicle without a title if it is old enough. They will then issue you a statement saying they properly disposed of the car.

There are some exceptions to the rule.

 You can keep a vehicle inside a building or in an enclosure.
A racecar or historic vehicle can be on a trailer and does not need registration.

3. Vehicles for sale: 60 days is the maximum number of days you may sell a vehicle in the Village on a lot. A lot is only allowed to have 2 vehicles sold from there in a 12 month period. The vehicle must belong to the lot owner or a resident of said lot. The vehicle must sit on stone or pavement while it is up for sale. Additional regulations apply to commercial sales lots.

4. Commercial garages come under separate rules and regulations

The old law used to allow one unregistered vehicle to be present. Today's New York State code does not allow any.

Fines for violators can start 10 days after receiving a written notice. The fines continue to add up for each day afterwards at a rate of \$100/day. The Village, after proper notice, may elect to tow the vehicles and charge the expenses back. (Please note: some of these codes are specific to Mount Morris and may not apply in other Towns or Villages)



#### LIVINGSTON COUNTY Planning Department Awarded \$25,000 Grant as part of New York's Great Lakes Basin Small Grants Program

Geneseo, NY: The Livingston County Planning Department was recently awarded \$25,000 from the New York Sea Grant (NYSG) in partnership with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYS DEC) for its proposed project that will serve to benefit the environment and economy of New York's Great Lakes basin by demonstrating the application of ecosystem-based management (EBM) to local watershed challenges. 
