

# A horrendous procedure





# Poinsettia...

whose blooms have not opened," said Chip East, Alabama regional Extension agent in commercial horticulture.

Bracts are the colorful leaves most people associate with the plant. The actual poinsettia flower is the small green or yellow flower in the center of the bracts.

"The should plant ' full appear with green uniformly dark leaves attached from the colored bracts to almost the base of the plant," Raymond Kessler, Extension specialist, said in an article on poinsettia care. "The leaves themselves should be completely free of disease and insects.

Kessler advises people to make sure the poinsettia is a high-quality plant before leaving the store.

### **Varieties**

 ${\rm `Most}$ Christmas poinsettias are red and green. However, there is a wide array of other colors including pink, white, orange, marbled, pale green, and cream," added Shane Harris, Tallapoosa County Extension coordinator.

Poinsettias can vary in size of the plant, average lifespan, and sturdiness or strength, according to another Kessler article on the greenhouse production of poinsettias.

### Care and Maintenance

Once a poinsettia is in the house it should be placed it in the window when possible. However, it can be moved to other areas for display when needed, according to East.

The plants do not tolerate moisture or shady areas. They thrive in

bright sunlight with moderate temperatures no higher than 70 degrees. If sunlight is too direct, the bracts will discolor.

"If a pretty wrap is around the pot, remove the plant from the wrap before watering," East said. "Allow the water to drain before placing the plant back in the decorative wrap."

The average lifespan of an attractive poinsettia is about two to four weeks, or with exceptional care, six to eight weeks, Kessler said. However, it is actually a perennial plant that could live for many years.

"Getting a plant to reflower is difficult for the home grower, but it can be done," East said. "Spending time to reflower a poinsettia would make a home grower appreciate the nursery that originally grew it."

If someone wants to attempt to reflower and maintain their poinsettia, it will need more attention than in the Christmas season. For more in-depth information about postholiday care and reflowering tips, see Kessler's article, "Consumer Poinsettia Care.'



will compete in the Big South Conference at the FCS level (former Division I-AA) which formed a football alliance with the Atlantic Sun earlier this year.

UNA officials established Division I as a goal in the summer of 2011. However, that was delayed when the Ohio Valley Conference decided not to expand.

UNA will pay a \$1.57 million NCAA application fee to move to Division I athletics which is due by June 2017. It will be paid by current athletic department reserves and will not require university assistance, according to UNA Athletic Director, Mark Linder.

Additional expenses will be incurred as the UNA athletic department grows its annual operating budget to a more comparable level with other Division I programs. Linder said UNA athletics supplements its annual allocation with \$1.5 million in additional funding raised through sponsorships, fundraising, and ticket sales. That figure needs to grow to over \$3 million annually by 2022 to be in line with other ASUN athletic budgets. Linder estimates that about \$900,000 will come from conference funding and game payouts. The remaining \$700,000 will need to come from corporate sponsorships, fundraising, and ticket sales.

The Atlantic Conference is a NCAA Division I league with eight member institutions headquartered in Macon, Georgia. UNA will become the ninth member and the seventh football playing member of the Big South Conference. The ASUN footprint reaches into seven of the top 50 media markets in the nation, a blend of private and public institutions.

UNA will continue as a member of the Gulf South Conference at the Division II level through this school year and next year, 2017-

The university need to grow its athletic scholarships from 121 to 180 by fall of 2022 to be in line with NCAA Division I regulations.

UNA president, Dr. Ken Kitts, emphasized that the move is about the entire university and not just the athletic program.

"This is an exciting time for Lion athletics, the university as a whole, and the communities we serve,' Kitts said. "The move to Division I will help sustain enrollment, expand our fan base, and bring muchneeded visibility for this wonderful institution.

UNA has enjoyed tremendous athletic success in Division II winning seven national championships, regional titles and 69 conference championships, to go with a combined 122 earned team appearances in NCAA post-season tournaments or playoffs.

The bar says lawyers can't claim to be a specialist in a particular area of the law but the reality is that lawyers tend to concentrate their practice in a specific area. In my opinion, matrimonial lawyers are specialists. These lawyers handle both pre-nuptial agreements before marriage and how a marriage is resolved whether through agreement or trial.

The short answer is yes. Courts still award alimony. If you are in a divorce, hire the best matrimonial (divorce) attorney you can afford. There is no replacement for a good divorce lawyer in a divorce.

In marriages lasting longer than 10 years, retirement benefits are subject

to division by the court. Alimony is based on the current ability to pay and is payable from the current earnings of the paying spouse. Often alimony is awarded to equalized the income between two parties after a marriage of sufficient length. Economic circumstances probably drive more awards of alimony than misconduct although to the parties in a divorce all they can see is the other party's misconduct.

I think we see less alimony awarded in cases where the child support burden is heavy. If you have children by this marriage there may not be a whole lot left over the pay alimony with.

The courts have the ability to award three different types of alimony. Alimony in gross is payable to equalize a property division and it is a set amount for a certain amount of time. A court can award rehabilitative alimony which provides a sum of money payable each month so that a spouse can finish a degree or otherwise rehabilitate themselves to a better economic position in hopes of becoming self supporting. This type of alimony can be a set amount that diminishes each month until the time period for rehabilitation is over. The judge decides how long that is, six months, three years, whatever and that is up to the judge. Probably alimony in gross and rehabilitative alimony are awarded more often than periodic alimony, but periodic alimony is what we normally think of as alimony

Periodic alimony is paid current earnings until the spouse receiving alimony dies, remarries or cohabitates (lives) with a member of the opposite sex. Periodic alimony has traditionally been tax deductible by the paying spouse and counted as income for the receiving spouse. By way of comparison, child support is paid from net income which means you need to earn \$1.38 to pay a \$1.00. Alimony is paid from gross income and deducted from your gross so it really only costs \$0.70 or so cents on the dollar because the taxes are paid by the person who receives it. *Buckle up and drive safely.*







# **Medicare Minute**

# "Post AEP Sign Up"

The Annual Enrollment Period (AEP) for 2017 ended on December 7th. This means that, except for a few exceptions, anyone who was on a Medicare prescription drug plan or Medicare Advantage Plan during 2016 will have to wait until next October to make changes to their plan. One such exception is for those who are on Medicare and receiving assistance from the state on their prescription drugs. If you are receiving state assistance on your prescriptions you can make changes any time during the year.

As we have stated before, AEP is only for those people who are already on Medicare and wish to enroll in or make changes to their prescription drug plan or Medicare Advantage Plan for 2017. AEP does not affect anyone who is getting Medicare for the first time in 2017 or is on Medicare and leaving employer coverage in the coming year. Medicare will give you a Special Election Period (SEP) for these situations.

If you are getting Medicare for the first time and not on employer insurance you will have 3 months to sign up for a Medicare plan. The 3 months begins the month after your Medicare becomes effective. If you are leaving employer coverage you will have 60 days to enroll. This time starts the day you leave your employer coverage. Although you will have a SEP for both these situations it's a good idea to have your Medicare plan in place before your SEP begins.

It is also important to remember that AEP does not affect Medicare supplements. You can enroll in or make changes to your Medicare supplement at any time during the year. Keep in mind that you may have to go through underwriting to make changes to your supplement. If you are getting Medicare for the first time or leaving employer coverage you can sign up for the supplement 6 months prior to your coverage starting.





### ARE YOU LOOKING TO **BUY** a new computer for your favorite geek this Christmas? Do you get as overwhelmed as I do when shopping for one? The choices are dizzying

nowadays so the best I can do in this little column is pass along a few pointers to consider. As always, I am

happy to offer free advice over the phone and it's worth every penny so call or email me if you get stuck.



can within that budget. Plan

to spend \$300 to \$500 for a



complete computer (including monitor) for grandma, and \$500 to \$700 for a family computer. Add about \$100 to each category for laptop computers. Laptops are cool but break expensively so don't buy one unless you really need the portability. Dollar for dollar, you get more bang for the buck with a desktop computer.

When buying a new computer, RAM is ultra-important. 4 gigabytes (GB) of RAM is okay for grandma, 6GB is better and 8GB or more is best. Unless you plan to produce home movies or

download thousands of songs, hard drive size really doesn't matter. Any new computer will come with far more hard drive space than most people will

Tablets are a whole 'nuther subject. Again, you get what you pay for. That \$79 no-name brand from Wallyworld will give you \$79 worth of junk that you might enjoy for a few months. Pay \$300-\$500 and you'll get an awesome tablet. If you use an iPhone, buy an Apple tablet. If you use an Android phone, buy and Android tablet from a wellknown manufacturer such as Samsung.

In our experience, there is no "best" brand of desktop computer. That claim is supported by Consumer Reports which has a ranking from best to worst but the difference between the top and bottom is only 3 percentage points. Durability is another matter. Each manufacturer sells junky low-end systems as well as very nice higher-end systems. You generally get what you pay for so let price be your guide.

Be sure the computer has a 1-year warranty. Some manufacturers try to slip in a skimpy 90-day warranty. Steer away from extended warranties and "protection plans." They are almost pure profit for retailers and rarely worth the price. While I'm at it, don't lef the big box retailers pressure you into buying antivirus software or ANY extras for that matter--especially the snake oil they sell to you as "computer optimization."

That is simply a rip-off.
Almost all inkjet printers are junk these days. If you have any problems with them, you usually have to throw them away. Spend as little as possible on the printer unless you have some specific needs that require higher-end stuff. Happy holidays, y'all!





# **Should Abe** Apologize?

Editor:

On May 27 Barack Obama became the first sitting US president to visit Hiroshima, the site of history's first atomic

did not ask Obama for an apology, nor did he offer one.

On December 27, Shinzo Abe will become the first Japanese prime minister to visit Pearl Harbor, site of the Japanese attack on the US Navy's Pacific Fleet on December 7, 1941. The US government hasn't asked Abe for an apology, nor is he expected to offer one.

Some Japanese citizens -- especially those who survived, or lost loved ones in, Hiroshima -- believe an American apology is warranted.

Some American citizens especially those who survived, or lost loved ones at, Pearl Harbor -- believe Japanese apology is warranted.

Both groups are wrong. Few people are left to apologize to and none to offer an apology. The senior politicians and military figures of World War II, those who planned and ordered both attacks, are dead.

Shinzo Abe was born nearly 13 years after Pearl Harbor, Barack Obama just two days shy of 16 vears after Hiroshima. Neither had anything to do with Pearl Harbor, with Hiroshima, or with the war the two countries waged against each other in between those terrible

Of the two, Abe has a better argument for declining to apologize. Multiple Japanese governments have publicly apologized for, and in some cases paid reparations for, Japan's aggression back

On the 70th anniversary of VJ Day (the day World War II in the Pacific formally ended), himself expressed regret for the Japan's aggression, but correctly spoke against continuing such gestures and letting "our children, grandchildren and even further generations to come, who have nothing to do with that war, be predestined to apologize."

Beyond a certain point, apologies not only cease to be needed, but they become mere rituals rather than genuine expressions of contrition.

In America, the subject of reparations for slavery occasionally becomes a matter of interest. When it does, many quite correctly point out that there's nobody to pay such reparations, nor anyone to pay them to. Every American who was ever a slave owner, or a slave, is dead.

That's not entirely the case with respect to World War II, but it's nearly so. Now is the perfect time to stop endlessly demanding apologies from each other for past wars and instead join with each other in dedication to the prevention of the next war.

Dear David, In terms of mathematics, would advise looking at it the same way you would a small business. The goal, first and foremost, is to keep the doors open in case something bad happens. The secondary goal could be to pay bills on time for the sake of the church's reputation, and the third goal would be to do all this without putting a strain on the organization. In business, we would call this fund "retained earnings." Technically, a church doesn't have earnings, but they do have income. You'll

on a regular monthly basis. For a church, basic things like payroll, utilities, insurance and taxes would need to be covered under an emergency fund. Coffee and donuts, new hymnals, and mission trips aren't necessities. You should already be running a monthly and annual budget on the church, so separate the necessities per month and multiply that by a three to six month figure.

# Why you should avoid cashing out your 401(K)

Many of my clients come to me six months after cashing out their 401(k). At the time, it seemed to be a good idea to solve a shortterm cash crunch. Unfortunately, cashing in a 401(k) can cause problems in the future. Another myth I hear from my clients is "I had to cash out my 401(k) when I changed jobs." That simply is not true. Please go to your bank or any financial advisor for help rolling it over into an IRA which will keep its tax-advantage status.

Another compelling reason to leave your 401(k) alone is security. Your creditors simply can not touch your 401(k). It is 100% exempt in Bankruptcy. It's an entirely different story once you cash it out and it hits your bank account. Your creditors can place a garnishment on your bank account if they have first sued and obtained a judgment against you.
