"Christmas, Minus The Tinsel"

The snow is gently falling, while father is dragging the freshly cut tree from the forest. The lights of the cabin beckon lovingly, as mother and children wait for him on the front porch. Yes, it looks like it will be another Norman Rockwell kind of a Christmas...

The picture is lovely, idyllic, and usually hilariously unlike reality.

If we were to paint a real Christmas picture, we might instead have brothers and sisters fighting

like cats and dogs in the dining room while mother is struggling to keep them quiet while at the same time trying to keep the tree from falling over (again) so that she can decorate it. Dad, meanwhile, would likely be at the table, looking over the budget. He would have a bottle of Tums nearby that he is popping like candy, while he sweats bullets trying to figure out how to both keep the lights on and at the same time buy gifts for Christmas.

When we face real world struggles at this blessed time of year, we often wonder where we have gone wrong. Why, we ask, can we not have a Christmas as peaceful as the very first one? Why can our holiday not be like a beautiful Christmas song, maybe like "Mary, Did You Know?'

I am not knocking that song, it really is lovely. But do you realize the version of it we almost

to end up singing? It

would go something like this:

"Mary did you know that your husband's gone, he's with a girl named Mable, Mary did vou know, that you need a job, to put food on the table, did you know, that you are alone, to raise this baby boy, a normal peaceful home life, you never will enjoy, Mary did you know...

The first Christmas? Norman Rockwell would shudder at the thought of painting it in all of its gritty reality. Matthew 1:18 tells us that Mary was 'found" with child of the Holy Ghost. She did not boldly and with full faith and confidence say "Joseph, I have been overshadowed by the Holy Ghost, and even though I am still a virgin, I am pregnant with the Son of God." No, she was "found" with child; she started to show, and Joseph started asking

questions. She apparently

could not think of a way

so he learned the hard

to break the news to him,

Matthew 1:19 tells us his reaction. He determined to divorce her. Espousal was much stronger than our engagement; it was more like marriage with no intimacy allowed until the actual ceremony. The only way to undo it was by divorce, and that is the route Joseph determined to take. Mary was very nearly made an unwed mother, she was very nearly alone to raise this precious child.

God spoke to Joseph

through a dream, and explained everything to him. Joseph believed, and took Mary as his wife, though he obeyed the command not to be intimate with her till after birth. The end of the

difficulties? Not by a long shot. Though Micah 5:2 prophesied the birthplace of the Messiah as Bethlehem hundreds of years beforehand, Joseph and Mary were still a very long way away in Nazareth very late into the pregnancy. They

either did not know, or ignored, or procrastinated. And what golden trumpet sounding dulcet tones from heaven caused

them to go to Bethlehem? None. What caused them to go to Bethlehem was a government mandate that everyone enroll for one of the least Christmas-like things imaginable: taxes. And when they obeyed, where did that put them? Five miles from Herod's palace, near enough to be well withing reach of his bloodthirsty plan to kill

In other words, the original Christmas was perhaps the most disjointed, stressful, frightening one ever.

this newborn king.

Whatever stress and turmoil you are facing this Christmas, do try to remember this: Christmas has never been about idyllic perfection, Christmas is about God working in the midst of all of our imperfection.







VA Pushes Research on Prostate Cancer

The headline on the Department of Veterans Affairs news release cited a grim fact: 12,000 veterans are diagnosed annually with prostate cancer. The VA's partnership with the Prostate Cancer Foundation can't come too soon. Their goal: to prevent, screen and promote research to speed the development of treatments and cures among veterans.

To that end, they're bringing together the big guns: researchers, data, cancer experts, advanced screenings and diagnostics. The PCF kicked in \$50 million to get things started.

PCF will be partnering with many groups around the country to enroll more veterans in studies, provide data for studies, increase the number of VA facilities applying to them for funding and much more. Key in cancer treatment will be the development of precision medicine. The research and data also will be shared with public agencies and corporations.

This won't be the VA's first time partnering with others to search for cancer prevention and cure answers. In 2016 alone, it was part of 262 projects.

The new efforts include the Million Veteran Program, the world's largest database of health, military and genetic data; VA Precision Oncology Program, providing state-of-the-art care; and VA Cooperative Studies Program, a colonoscopy screening, which wants to enroll 50,000 veterans.

Meanwhile, don't wait for a call. Take charge of this. If you haven't had a prostate-specific antigen test in a while, go get one. It's a simple blood test that could save your life. Even if you have no symptoms at all, get the test. The result will tell you the likelihood that you'll ever develop cancer. You might just be told to come back for another test so the results can be compared. The earlier you get on this, the better. So, go.

#### Snappy Magazines

Q: While going through a family storage area, I found about two dozen issues of Snappy Magazine from 1930 and 1931. Since they were tied up with string and labeled "smut," I was naturally interested. What can you tell me about them? -- Steve, Metarie, Louisiana A: Your magazines were part of GlemArt, which also included Gay Parisienne and Paris Nights. Not exactly smut by today's standards (or lack thereof), the issues often included pinup illustrations, occasional nude art images and suggestive stories. Look for contributions by Octavus Ray Cohen, Achmed Abdullah (Michael Romanoff), and Jack Woodford, since they are especially collectible. According to "Vintage Magazines Price Guide," by Richard Russell and Elaine Gross Russell and published by Krause Books, most issues of Snappy magazine are valued in the \$30-\$85 range, but there are exceptions. Due to content, May 1931 and May 1933 issues are worth about \$125 each; April 1933, \$100; and June 1934, \$150. According to these prices, your stack of Snappy publications -- if in good condition and complete -- could easily be worth several thousand dollars.

Q: I have an old 78-rpm recording of "Long Ago and Far Away" by Dick Haymes and Helen Forrest. I believe it is from World War II. What is it worth? -- Billy, Rio Rancho, New Mexico A: Your recording -- Decca 23317 -- was issued in April 1944 and spent 18 weeks on the nation's bestsellers chart. At one point, it was the No. 1 recording in sales in the country. It was introduced in the film, "Cover Girl," featuring Betty Grable. Hubba Hubba. Your disc is worth about \$5 in excellent condition.

Q: I inherited a small bowl, which my late grandma told me was hobnail glass. What exactly is hobnail glass? -- Martha, Postsmouth, Virginia A: Hobnail glass is a

pattern on pressed glass that has raised bumps as part of its distinctive design. Dozens of hobnail patterns and variants have been made in a wide variety of colors. This type of glass was perfected in 1886 by William Leighton Jr. and William F. Russell of Hobbs, Brockunier & Company. Incidentally. one of the earliest names for this glass pattern was dew-drop.

**Ingredients** 

12 sugar cookies (about 2 1/2 to 3-inches in diameter)

3 tablespoons cream cheese, room tempera-

2 cups white chocolate for melting (or candy melts)

Sprinkles for decoration

Instructions

Place sugar cookies in a food processor and process until cookies turn into fine crumbs. Add cream cheese and process again until well-combined and mixture can be pressed into a ball, 1 to 2 minutes.

Shape cookies into balls about 1-inch to 1 1/2-inches in diameter. Place on a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper and place in the freezer for 15 minutes or the refrigerator for 1 hour.

In medium bowl, melt white chocolate according to instructions. (See my tips for melting chocolate.)

Remove the cookie balls from refrigerator. Using a spoon or two forks, dip and roll chilled cookie balls, one at a time, in coating. Return to lined cookie sheet and immediately top with sprinkles. Repeat process for remaining cookie balls. Store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to a week.

Notes

If the sugar cookie truffle dough is not firm enough, add another tablespoon of cream cheese.





#### Few Children **Outgrow Tree-Nut Allergy**

DEAR DR. ROACH: Can you tell me if there is any hope of a cure for treenut allergy, particularly for a child? -- X.M. ANSWER: Tree-nut allergies, like all allergies, vary in severity from mild to life-threatening. Allergies to tree nuts (these include walnuts, cashews, almonds and others) are common, are more likely to be severe, and tend to persist throughout lifetime. People with one tree-nut allergy may have others, and about 30 percent to 40 percent also may be allergic to peanuts (despite their

being legumes, they share enough characteristics for co-allergic reactions).
Peanut and tree-nut allergies appear to be increasing in prevalence

over time. The mainstay of treatment is avoiding the allergen, which requires constant vigilance, careful reading of nutritional labels and a plan for treatment in case of

ingestion, such as an epinephrine auto-injector. Only about 15 to 20 percent of younger children will develop tolerance to ("outgrow") their allergy; an allergy that develops later in life usually is lifelong. Your allergist can do skin testing to see if the allergy is resolving.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm a retired ob-gyn and am married to a practicing MD. I'm writing you today about autism and its use as a diagnosis. My view is that each individual is unique, mentally and physically. While autism may be one way to describe a personality, each person must deal with the world on its terms, not because of a

diagnosis. I personally believe I am a variant of Asperger's, but who knows? I don't qualify as an Asperger's if given a test prepared

by psychologists/psychiatrists. Yet, I have had many life experiences that are best explained by an Asperger's diag-nosis. What are your thoughts on Asperger's syndrome? -- A.G.

ANSWER: Since I recently published a letter by an adult who believed he was autistic despite never having received a diagnosis, I have had several letters like this. Autism, including its variant Asperger syndrome, is a spectrum of illnesses that share deficits in social interaction, communication and stereotyped, repetitive behaviors. In Asperger syndrome, there is no clinically significant delay in language and intellec-tual development.

I certainly agree with you that each person is unique and that the label of a psychiatric condition, such as autism, bipolar or a personality disorder, has only limited usefulness. In the best case, it can give a person a way to start learning how to overcome challenges that similar people have faced. At worst, a label predisposes others to look at the person through a certain lens and to expect certain

behaviors.

I have had many patients with psychiatric diagnoses ask me not to put that into their medical record, after having built up enough trust to share the diagnosis with me.
People have had such negative experiences based on their diagnosis, their label, that I don't blame them for wanting to avoid being stereotyped. There is so much variation in all of these conditions -- even in those of us considered neurologically typical that we need to recognize the good and the bad side of making such a diagnosis.



I know families that collect them on their summer vacations, and on occasion they give them a good shake, turn them upright and then smile with the memories. Now you can make your own to commemorate something special you did in 2016.

Reminisce with your kids about activities your family enjoyed this past year, and then make a memory snow globe using a small waterproof object to represent the activity or event. Here's how:

recipe you cooked up. Talk about the memory as you create.

First, you want to have a vision for your scene and how it will be contained. Will you need a little jar, a fat jar or a skinny jar? A tall jam jar might accommodate that plastic bear figure as a reminder of a camping trip at a national park. A baby-food jar would make a perfect home for a little rubber starfish to represent the sea life you observed at an aquarium. It's all up to you and your imagination.

Step 1: Fill the jar with water and shake to test the lid for tightness. Pour the water out, remove the paper label and let it dry completely.

Step 2: Choose a clean, waterproof toy, game piece, travel souvenir or trinket to inhabit the imaginary world. Place it temporarily inside the lid and lower the jar down over it, just to make sure it fits and allows enough space for the "snow" to fall when complete. An adult should glue the object on the inside of the lid with water-resistant glue, such as aquarium sealant from your local pet store. Let dry 24 hours.

Step 3: Fill the jar almost to the top with baby oil, or use distilled water with a few drops of glycerin added. Sprinkle glitter or waterproof confetti into the liquid. An adult should apply water-resistant glue to the outside grooves of the jar rim and carefully screw on the lid. Stand the jar with lid end up to dry for 24 hours. Gather your kids around and shake your 2016 memory globe. Then hold still and watch.

with objects that represent something you did together, such as a fishing trip, a book you read, a movie you saw or a
