### **Medicare Minute**

#### "Year-end Reminders"

We have spent the past two months discussing the Medicare Annual Enrollment Period. We have talked about Medicare health plans. We have covered the different types of health plans and how to choose the one that may be best for you. We also discussed Medicare prescription drug plans and how they can change and need to be reviewed each year. But, just because the Annual Enrollment Period is over doesn't mean you can go to sleep at the wheel. There are some things you need to stay on top of.

To begin with you should make sure you have received your enrollment card from each insurance company you signed up with. If you enrolled into a Medicare Supplement and prescription drug plan you should have received two cards. One card from the company handling your supplement and another card from the company handling your drug plan. If you enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan you should have received one card and that's from the company your Advantage plan is with.

The second thing to verify is your premium is coming from the appropriate place such as your bank account or Social Security check. You may not know this until January. If the premium is taken out of your bank account, for example, and you don't see it deducted in January you will want to contact the company. You don't want to go two or three months without paying the premium and then have to pay those months at one time. It's better to address it up front.

# **House Calls** with Dr. Barco

I feel very privileged to be writing this column to help raise awareness of important medical topics to the Shoals and to provide a forum where people in the community can get their burning medical questions answered. Keep in mind that medical advice that may apply well to one person may have bad consequences to another depending on their age, health, medicines taken and many other factors. Therefore, always consult your physician or other primary health care provider before implementing any advice given in this column. Feel free to submit your questions by contacting us. Due to health privacy laws, I ask that you do not share any personal medical information with myself or office.

## Why is high blood pressure called "the silent killer"?

Having high blood pressure, or hypertension, puts you at risk for several medical conditions, including coronary artery disease (think heart attacks), congestive heart failure, circulation problems, stroke, kidney disease and vision loss to name a few. Although some people may notice symptoms like headaches, dizziness, fatigue or chest pain when their blood pressure is high, most people don't usually feel symptoms early on. Its effects are often gradual and asymptomatic, hence the term "silent killer". In fact, when most people start to feel symptoms of having high blood pressure, there's a good chance that the high blood pressure has already caused some damage. As an example, if somebody with very high blood pressure has not had it checked or treated for years and suddenly notices that their urine output is much less than normal, a lot of kidney injury has likely been done. Often, the damage cannot be reversed.

It's because of this that it's important to get your blood pressure screened regularly, at least on a yearly visit with your primary care doctor if you are 40 and above. If you are 18-39, it should be monitored every 1-5 years depending on whether you are at high risk for developing hypertension. This can be determined by your physician or other health care provider. What your blood pressure should run depends a lot on your age and what other medical conditions you have, so always consult your primary care provider.

On television, I hear about how some athletes use steroids to build muscles. Are those the same as the steroids that people take, like prednisone, for breathing problems and rashes?

Steroids like prednisone, dexamethasone methylprednisolone are often prescribed by physicians for treatment of conditions like asthma flares, COPD, cancer, autoimmune disease, certain rashes and gout attacks. These steroids are called corticosteroids and fight inflammation, which is why they work so well for the above conditions. Aside from corticosteroids are another family of manmade steroids called anabolic steroids. Unlike the antiinflammatory corticosteroids, the anabolic steroids are used to build muscle mass and are the ones you hear about some athletes using. The downside to anabolic steroid use, other than it represents cheating in sports, is that it can lead to serious health problems like heart disease and stroke. The reason anabolic steroids and corticosteroids have the word "steroid" in them is that part of both substances have chemical pieces that look like rings. However, the other parts of these substances make one of them fight inflammation while making the other cause muscle growth.



#### DON'T BE A VICTIM

husband, Jason, have been foster parents to 30 children who needed a safe, temporary place to call home. The Cains currently have five foster children in their care, ranging in age from six months to 17 years. In addition the couple has two biological sons, Dylan and Deven Guzowski, and a daughter, Haven, who permanently joined their family through adoption out of foster care.

Haven is the reason Jason and Suzanne became foster parents. When they first met Haven, she was already living with another foster family. As the Cains helped this family care for Haven, they formed a special bond with her. After becoming more involved in Haven's life, they decided to become her foster parents. By September 2015, her

adoption was finalized.

Through their interaction with Haven as a foster child, Suzanne said that she and Jason realized there were many children in the Shoals area who were in similar situations. Their hearts were deeply touched thinking about all of the other kids who needed a stable home. That's when they decided to

foster even more children. With a total of eight children currently in their home, their life is a constant whirlwind of activity. Suzanne and Jason know what they are doing for each child is worth it. Through their experience the Cain family have learned that blood doesn't always make you family. It's the love you share which does. "Some people say my kids are lucky to have us, but really we are lucky to have each other. To this day each and every one of our kids knows they are always welcomed home," Suzanne said.

Sabrina Kilburn is the office manager and long-time employee at Oakland. She also knows how important it is for people

to invest in those around them. She lived with a foster family as a young child. Through her own experience Kilburn knew how much it would mean to these children when she suggested to co-workers about helping a local foster family.

## **Check-up on Mom**

from school. Holidays are also an excellent time to assess the condition of an older family member. Whether Mom and Dad live at home, a retirement community, or with another relative, you can use holiday gatherings as an opportunity to assess the health

and welfare of your aging parents.

1. Watch for inappropriate behavior during holiday gatherings. Exhibiting inappropriate behavior including paranoia, agita-tion, or making unusual statements or phone calls at odd hours during family gatherings may indicate dementia or cognitive prob-

2. Look for changes in relationship patterns. Talk to friends and neighbors and listen for any concerns they may express about your parent's health or wellbeing.

3. Take note of any changes in routines. If Mom or Dad have slowed down or even stopped participating in activities he or she once found enjoyable such as attending church, sharing a meal with friends, or playing bridge, it can be a sign of a more serious underlying problem.

4. Be on the lookout for any signs of forgetfulness. While it is normal to temporarily forget a person's name (how many times have you had to work through all of your children's names before getting to the right one, after all?), not recognizing a growing child, losing track of time during the busy holidays, and exhibiting serious lapses in memory may be a sign of dementia or other mental health issues. Forgetting common words, getting lost in familiar places, and being unable to follow directions can be signs of significant memory loss.

5. Look for signs of forgetfulness that could have life-threatening consequences. Burnt pans or other evidence of damaged cookware or appliances could be evidence that your parent frequently forgets about food cooking on the stove. Forgetting packages or other clutter on stairs or in walkways can result in dangerous accidents.

6. Watch your parent as he or she performs normal holiday tasks. Has Dad suddenly forgotten how to wrap or unwrap gifts, for example? Does Mom now have trouble remembering how to make a simple family recipe?

7. Look for signs of depression. Irritability, crankiness, sudden mood changes, and social withdrawal, loss of self-regard (such as a lack of pride in appearance) are all signs depression. Mom may be at higher risk for depression if she were recently in the hospi-

**8. Evaluate purchases**. If gift giving is part of your family tradition, did Mom forget to purchase a gift for one or more people attending the celebration? Were the gifts appropriate for the recipient's age? Forgetting gifts for half of the family or purchasing a new wide screen TV for each member of your family may be signs of cognitive problems.

9. Assess your parent's appearance. Failure to bathe, brush teeth or comb hair may be a sign of depression, a physical impairment, or even dementia. Pay special attention to personal hygiene including body odor, clothing, nails, and skin.

10. Take a good look at your parent's living space. A neglected home with a noticeable change in sanitation and tidiness can be a sign that your parent cannot keep up with the physical work of maintaining a home. An overgrown lawn, non-working lights or heat, or a messy house may be a sign that you need to provide more care for mom or dad.

The Salvation Army of the Shoals—Our local chapter of this international organization is able to offer shelter for around 60 individuals on a first come, first served basis. Their Soup & Shelter program provides warm meals, showers and beds to homeless and transient men and women. On the grounds of the Florence Salvation Army is the fourunit Martha Morgan Hensley Family & Women's Facility, which provides shelter for displaced/ homeless women and families. 


