





- 12-pound fully cooked smoked whole ham
- tablespoons whole cloves
- (10-ounce) jars orange marmalade
- cup orange juice
- tablespoons prepared mustard
- teaspoon ground cloves
- teaspoon ground ginger cup dark seedless raisins
- (15 1/4-ounce) can pineapple rings for garnish Maraschino cherries and parsley sprigs for garnish
- 1. With sharp knife, remove skin and trim all but about 1/4-inch fat from ham. Stud ham with whole cloves. Place ham, fat-side up, on rack in large roasting pan. • While going through a family storage area, I found about two dozen issues of Snappy Magazine from 1930 and 1931. Since they were tied up with string and labeled smut," I was naturally interested. What can you tell me about them?

Russell of Hobbs, Brockunier & Company. Incidentally, one of the earliest names for this glass pattern was dew-drop.


