

Transfer Station News

Due to increased costs of doing business, the Town Board regrettably finds it necessary to increase refuse disposal fees. Tickets for bagged trash will cost \$3.00 each beginning January 1, 2017; the schedule for number of tickets per bag will remain the same. Any tickets purchased prior to this date will still be accepted with no additional charge.

Again, we ask our recycling customers to do their part to lower costs. The Town has to pay a hauling fee of almost \$300 every time the dumpster of co-mingled recyclables is full. PLEASE FLATTEN ALL PLASTICS AND METALS. When items are not flattened, we are paying to haul air!! We need to maximize the amount of material in this container.

The Town Clerk will be at the Transfer Station to sell permits for 2017 on Saturday, December 31st and Wednesday, January 3rd. Permits are also available at the Town Clerk's office. Rates remain \$20 for Mount Morris Seniors (65+), \$25 for other Mount Morris Residents and \$35 for Non-Residents.







2016 REDC Grants total \$3.5 Million for Livingston County

Governor Cuomo announced the 2016 New York State Regional Economic Development Council Awards on December 8th. Livingston County came out strong with several awards including:

\$185,000 for the Livingston County Microenterprise Program. Funds will be used to promote the Brew IN Livingston initiative- business plan competition with the goal of creating a craft brewery trail in Livingston County. This grant is awarded through the NYS Office of Housing and Community Renewal.

\$15,000 for a County-Wide Public Market Study. Funds will be used to create a feasibility study for a public market facility to be located within Livingston County with the purpose of supporting the local agricultural and food industry. Funding for this grant is awarded through Empire State Development.

\$2.3 Million for development of the Livonia Gateway Agribusiness Park. Funds will be used in The Gateway Project for the creation of an agribusiness park in the Town of Livonia. Infrastructure work will include a new access roadway, a bridge, water and sanitary sewer. Funds for this award come from Empire State Development.

\$1 Million for Town of Springwater Wastewater System Improvements. Funds will be used to improve the physical infrastructure of the municipal sanitary sewer collection and treatment system. This allocation comes from the Office of Housing and Community Renewal.





BREW IN LIVINGSTON FINALISTS ANNOUNCED

Livingston County Development is pleased to announce 15 finalists for the Brew IN Livingston business plan competition, which is an effort to create a craft beer trail in Livingston County, NY. "We've been overwhelmed by the response to this initiative," stated Livingston County Development Director Bill Bacon. "Not only have we received more response than was anticipated, but the quality of submissions has been remarkable."

The County's Economic Development office first announced the Brew IN Livingston initiative in June. Since that time the field has been narrowed from 75 interested parties, to 35 semifinalists, and now just 15 finalists. Last week, Governor Cuomo announced the regional economic development awards for round six of the Consolidated Funding Application process. Among those awards was \$185,000 for Livingston County's Brew IN Livingston initiative.

Contestants are ultimately competing for four equal prize packages which include access to \$35,000 in grant funds, \$100,000 in loan funds, and an array of assistance and services from groups including but not limited to the Livingston County Area Chamber of Commerce and Tourism and the New York State Brewers Association.

Finalists will receive technical assistance through the Brew IN Livingston "business boot camp" designed to assist with building and refining a business plan. Throughout the five week course, contestants will hear from professional service providers on licensing, trademark, business finance, taxes, branding, and marketing. Owners from breweries including Three Heads Brewing in Rochester and Big Ditch Brewing Company in Buffalo will speak to finalists about their experience starting and running a brewery.






