

### Greens Bring Luck in the New Year

For many people, the new year is a time for making resolutions and eating certain foods for "luck." On New Year's Day, eating greens, blackeyed peas and cornbread are thought to bring financial reward. While I'm not superstitious, I do believe in the health benefits of eating greens.

Greens include any vegetable in the cabbage family that doesn't form a compact head, like collards, mustards, turnips, spinach and kale. There are several varieties of tasty and unusual types of greens, so be bold and experiment! Dark, leafy greens such as spinach, kale, collards and mustard greens are an excellent source of many nutrients. Greens contain high amounts of vitamin A and iron, as well as some calcium. Greens also are packed with antioxidants and are a wonderful addition to any diet.

If the stems of the greens are tough, don't throw them away. There are nutrients in the stems, so chop them up into small pieces and freeze them. You can add the stems to soups and stews, saute them along with onions, or add them to dishes just as you would carrots.

Pot liquor, the highly seasoned liquid that is left after the greens are cooked, is full of vitamins and minerals and is a nutritious drink.

The practice of combining different types of greens is called a "mess of greens" in the South. Cooking a mixture of greens along with pieces

of pork is an integral part of African and African-American culinary history. During times of slavery, if greens were served one day, the leftover pot liquor and a pan of cornbread often made the meal for the next. My vegetarian version for preparing a mess of greens retains the flavorful soul of the recipe, but is much healthier.



luck or eating certain types of food on the first day of the new year, a dish of dark, deliciously fresh greens makes me feel blessed all year long!

### MESS OF GREENS

- pounds greens (mixture of kale, collards, mustard, turnips or spinach)
- cup olive oil
- large onion, sliced
- jalapeno, diced
- cloves of garlic, diced tablespoon sugar
- tablespoons salt, divided
- tablespoons pepper, divided cups water
- sun-dried tomatoes, sliced, and the oil (optional)

1. Wash greens thoroughly: Remove any brown spots or blemishes, and wash the greens 3 or 4 times in cold water to ensure they are clean and free of insects. Roll the cleaned greens up and slice them into smaller pieces so they'll cook evenly. Remove and reserve any large stems.

2. Using a large pot, season the onions with salt and sweat them in the olive oil over low heat for about 10 to 12 minutes, stirring occasionally. While I don't personally believe in Add the garlic, jalapeno, sugar, salt

and pepper to the pot, and saute the mixture for about 5 minutes.

3. Add the greens and water to the pot and continue cooking for 45 minutes to 1 hour over medium-low heat, stirring once after about 30 to 40 minutes. Test the greens for tenderness by piercing the stems with a fork or knife. Cook for another 10 to 15 minutes, if needed. Season

with the remaining salt and pepper.

4. Place the greens in a bowl with the pot "likker." Serve with the sundried tomatoes and the oil, if desired, and the traditional Southern condiments: vinegar, hot sauce, hot peppers in vinegar, wine vinegar and chopped

### Wow! Grapefruit Baked Alaska

Greet the new year with a showy, wintry dessert. It's a take on traditional Baked Alas-ka that you may have enjoyed at a fancy restaurant. This mini version is much easier, using fresh grapefruit in its own "bowl" instead of cake, but still keeps the "wow" factor with billowing warm meringue on top and chilly ice cream nestled

Timing is everything. Do some simple prep work beforehand. Then, as the table is being cleared after your main course, preheat the oven and whip the egg whites while your child spoons fruit into the grapefruit bowls and tops each with ice cream and mounds of sweet meringue.

### GRAPEFRUIT BAKED ALASKA

- grapefruits
- scoops vanilla ice cream egg whites (1/2 cup) at room temperature
- teaspoon cream of tartar cup sugar
- teaspoon vanilla extract

One hour or more before serving:

1. Prepare grapefruit by cutting evenly in half crosswise. Use a grapefruit knife to cut out fruit sections. Place in a bowl and drain juice (enjoy drinking it for a snack). If grapefruit is rather tart, add some sugar. Cover and refrigerate. Remove and discard membranes

in six of the halves to form hollow 'bowls," and discard the two remaining grapefruit halves. (You are using 6 halves for the dessert, but the fruit from 4 grapefruits to have ample servings.)

Pre-scoop ice cream in six rounds

on a tray lined with wax paper or plastic wrap. Place back in freezer. 15 minutes before serving:

4. Heat oven to 400 F. Line baking sheet with parchment paper or foil. Have child spoon refrigerated grapefruit pieces evenly into the six grape-fruit "bowls" and set them on the baking sheet.
5. In a mixing bowl, with an electric

mixer set at low speed, beat egg whites until frothy and foamy. Add cream of tartar. Increase speed until soft peaks form. Slowly add sugar, a tablespoon at a time. Let your kids watch as the



mixture changes and enlarges, and glossy, stiff peaks form.

6. Set an ice-cream round in center of each fruit-filled bowl. Immediately spoon the stiff meringue on top, and seal edges around the cut grapefruit rim with a butter knife. Bake in the middle of the oven for 5 minutes, or until meringue is golden.


Serve immediately plates. Makes 6 servings.

Tip: For a special occasion such as New Year's Eve, top each one with a birthday candle and light.

It takes a professional to determine which, and that is why my answer for readers is generally the same: Hire a professional appraiser. Determining an accurate value requires both time and expertise. If you feel you have a work that could be valuable, it is certainly worth

paying for the services of a professional appraiser. Case in point: A woman in Phoenix didn't want to spend \$400 to find out the value of four etchings she wished to sell. She received \$250 for the etchings, only to learn later that they were worth about a \$1,000 each. Her refusal to spend \$400 cost her about \$3,750.

The more expensive model, the RA-101-1A, which featured a motorized TV screen, radio and phonograph, is worth slightly more, about \$1,500.



There is no doubt that Eli Manning is one of the game's alltime great quarterbacks, and Odell Beckham Jr., even if he never catches another pass, will still be rembered as having the best start of any wide receiver in NFL history. But how long can the Giants go with this game plan?

Actually, the better question to ask is how deep can the Giants go in the playoffs with that plan and zero running game. True, there is a certain charm to the Manning-Beckham plan. For one thing, you don't need to be a technical football wiz to understand what is going on there. They're calling the same plays you did when you huddled up in your backyard as a kid: "You get open, and I will throw the ball to you, and then you just outrun everybody and score. Got it?

For the time being, this strategy has largely worked. That's because Odell Beckham Jr. is just that good. He is a game breaker, he is young and healthy, he can catch, he's a fierce competitor, and he's got turbo jets. As long as the Giants' truly superb defense is around, the G-men can get away with this plan.

As for Dallas, the team that beat everyone but the Giants, they still have one of the greatest offensive lines in modern times. They don't just give rookie sensation Dak Prescott time to throw ... they give him enough time to drop back and meditate, write a little bit in his journal, eat a yogurt with fruit on the bottom (ya know, the kind you have to stir), call to check in on his mama and decide he needs to buy a house out in Hackensack before throwing a pass. But when he ends up on the short end of a throwback 10-7 game against the Giants, people jump to conclusions. Seven points? Is that all you get for your money?

The question there is whether Dallas fans and Romo-smitten owner Jerry Jones will have the patience to stick with the kid once they're in the playoffs. After all, if you're going to use Romo, the clock is ticking. At best, has about two seasons left before he succumbs to chronic, lifelong pain. But it would seem such a waste of time to try and develop Prescott only to bail on the guy come playoff time. If the franchise is eyeing another dynasty, it'd be foolish to jump off that Patriot-esque potential 10-year train.

Dallas should look at Romo as being the best backup quarterback since Johnny Unitas. He can still chip in. We've seen him play long enough to know by now that if he can't drive the Cowboys with a broken back, at least he can polish the fenders.





### Hints For The Home

Smart Storage Suggestions For Your Clothes



Keep your warm-weather clothing bright through the winter and your cold-weather clothing cozy throughout the summer with proper fabric care.

(NAPS)—When the seasons change, there are a few important steps you can take to protect your clothes and save yourself time, trouble and money.

Try these tricks:

 Make sure clothing is washed and free from stains before you store it. Stains can suddenly appear months later if the fabric is not clean when put away.

• Use cold water for rinsing whenever possible.

 If the care label recommends dry-cleaning that favorite sweater, take it to the dry cleaner before storing. Not all wool has to be dry-cleaned, however. If the label says "hand wash," you can use your washing machine's "hand wash" or 'wool" cycle with cool water. Easy-care wool knits can be cleaned on the "wool" or "gentle" cycle of your washer with warm water. When the cycle is finished, dry the clothes on a flat surface away from direct heat or sunlight.

• When drying clothes, sort by fabric types. Drying similar fabrics together reduces drying times and ensures even drying.

 Don't waste leftover heat. Try to get the second washload into the dryer while it's still warm from the first to shorten drying time and save energy.

• Don't overfill the dryer. Air circulation is important for proper drying. Overloaded dryers may have to be run more than once-wasting energy, time and money.

· Clean the lint filter before each dryer cycle to maintain proper air circulation and to speed up the drying process. · Before storing your

clothes, make sure they're completely dry.

• Don't store too many in too small a spot. Clothes need room to breathe while in storage.

• Fold and stack knits loosely; do not hang them.

 Instead of using garment bags, use clean storage boxes or even a suitcase.


