



Rustic Tent Camping

Lake Metroparks offers a camping "rustic" experience for small groups of up to eight people staying in tents. Campers must hike or paddle to the campsites. The sites are set back from the developed areas of the parks from about ¼-mile to more than a mile. Each location is different, and there is only one campsite per park to provide a quiet, intimate natural experience.

Reservable tent camping sites are available May 1 through November 30 (Labor Day for River Road Park campsite); year-round camping available at Girdled Road Reservation. Reservations can be made up to 3 pm one day prior to arrival. There is a limit of three outstanding permits at one time with a three night limit on each reservation. Lake Erie

Lake Erie and its tributaries dominate Lake County's angling opportunities. That's not necessarily a bad thing, either, as the great lake's Central Basin has a long and storied history of providing outstanding fishing for walleye, smallmouth bass, steelhead trout and yellow perch.

Likewise, such tributaries as the Grand River and the Chagrin River have earned their stripes as go-to destinations for lake-run steelhead. They have received rave reviews in various national outdoors magazines such as "In-Fisherman" and "Field & Steam." And for those anglers without a vessel to ply the waters of Lake Erie there are any number of land-based locations in the county where a person can toss a line into Lake Erie.

Lake County boasts of having the finest natural small boat harbor on the Great Lakes – the Mentor Lagoons. Small boat owners and anglers can find a wealth of public and private launching facilities there as well as on both the Grand and Chagrin rivers.

And you don't have to be a professional angler to catch fish like one as Lake County is the home port to some of the finest Lake Erie licensed charter fishing captains.

Cast your lure in Lake County

Inshore to offshore, visiting anglers from near and far will certainly find accommodating Lake Erie fishing opportunities off Lake County.

Toss in some spectacular stream fishing for a host of species that include world-class steelhead – plus untapped muskie fishing and stellar smallmouth bass fishing – and one has the potential for an exciting and fruitful angling adventure.

Leading it all off is the Lake Erie walleye fisheries with access via ports on the Chagrin and Grand rivers as well as from Mentor Lagoons.

There are walleye available from several year class; some of which are stronger than others, of course.

This past summer – 2016 – Lake Erie walleye anglers had no problems catching boatloads of fish. Many were "throwbacks" from the exceptionally vibrant 2015 hatch, or fish measuring just under Ohio's 15-inch minimum length limit for keeping. These fish will provide robust angling opportunities in 2017 when they'll average 15 to 18 inches.

And a lesser number of walleye from the previous two years' hatches will be available, too, with these fish averaging several inches longer.

Expect for Lake Erie's Central Basin – which includes all of the waters off Lake County – to have trophy-class walleye from the geezer groups hatched in 2003 and 2007. These are the year-class fish that

will top 28 inches and from which may even come a new state record walleye.

And though many walleye anglers will hire a licensed charter captain others will no doubt trailer their own vessel. They could be on to a good thing. Trolling along the Lake County shoreline in water less than 40 feet deep can be very productive for the savvy angler using stickbaits and spoons.

When the weather turns sour and the Witch of November roars in and stays through to ice up walleye anglers can often do well by casting crankbaits off such locations as the Eastlake CEI seawall, the so-named Fairport Harbor Village short pier, and soon – the revamped and state-of-the-art pier at Lake Metroparks' Painesville Township Park, set to open next September, weather depending

David Berg of Mentor, Ohio, who on April 18th of last year (2016) caught Ohio's new state record yellow perch. This behemoth was taken from a private marina's pier just east of the Grand River in Lake Erie and weighed 2.86 pounds, measured 15.75 inches and having a girth measuring a whopping 13.75 inches.

For steelheaders the news is pretty much all good. The fall run this past autumn (2016) often proved exceptional when stream flows were not hampered by a lack of rain. Both the Grand and Chagrin Rivers provided good steelhead fishing activity with a key public access point being Lake Metroparks' Chagrin River Park in both Eastlake and Willoughby.

Over on the Grand River Lake Metropark' Beatty Landing in Painesville has proven a hot destination and downstream to Painesville City's Recreation Park. A really neat thing is that Lake Metroparks seems to be forever upgrading Beatty Landing and has just added a small boat launch there along with improved parking right along the river proper.

This new launch site was still being built and steelhead anglers using drift boats were utilizing the facility. No doubt they were drifting downstream to the parks system's Grand River Landing several miles downstream in Fairport Harbor. While this lower

section of the Grand River is typically too shallow for motorized craft it is excellent paddle-sports and drift boat water.

Further upstream the parks system has its Indian Point Park in Leroy and Perry townships which embraces both Paine Creek as well as a portion of the Grand River. It is at this junction that steelheaders congregate from ice-out in late February or early March until near the first of May. And often very well they do here, too, using spinning tackle, fly fishing gear and center-pin equipment.

What's more the parks system has picked up more than one-half mile of Grand River frontage along the bank opposite Indian Point. This new swath of valuable real estate will now provide public access to one of the finest and most productive muskie fishing holes in the Grand River's mid-section. From late spring through autumn, anglers toss spinnerbaits and plugs to the toothy muskies that take up residence in this acclaimed fishing hole.

But you're getting the picture that Ohio's smallest county still can boast of some pretty impressive places to cast a lure, fling a fly, troll a spoon, and dunk a nightcrawler.

Sports & Outdoors

With approximately 30 miles of Lake Erie shoreline at its disposal, Lake County offers sunbathers and swimmers ample opportunity to enjoy themselves. Among the possibilities are Headlands Beach State Park with its one-mile-long sandy beach and family-friendly Lake Metroparks' Fairport Harbor Lakefront Park with kayak rentals and a separate dog swim area. Access to pristine, natural beach areas are offered at Mentor Lagoons, with 1 ½ miles of undeveloped beachfront as well as at the 592-acre Lake Metroparks Lake Erie Bluffs, where bald eagles are frequently sighted along nearly two miles of natural beach.

Life along the south shore of Lake Erie is a plus for those who relish the chance to observe resident and migrating birds. That's because waterfowl seasonally cruise their way along and across Lake Erie while raptors and song-birds utilize the coast to rest and refresh before heading south in autumn and back home in the spring. Some of the choicest viewing areas include Headlands Beach State Park and Headlands Dunes State Nature Preserve, the Mentor Marsh State Nature Preserve, Mentor Lagoons Nature Preserve, Lake Metroparks'

Lake Erie Bluffs, Veterans Park and Chagrin River Park, as well as the Eastlake CEI Seawall.

The award-winning and nationally recognized Lake Metroparks is Lake County's parks system that maintains 37 public parks along with additional parcels designed to preserve and protect natural resources. 


