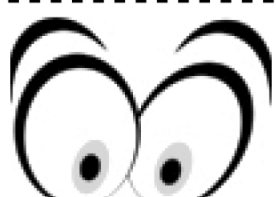

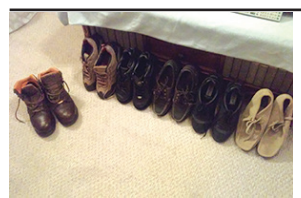

Souvenir Spoons

Q: I inherited several spoons from a great aunt. Each is marked "sterling" and engraved with "Lois" and the years 1899, 1900, 1901, 1902 and 1903. What can you tell me about them? -- Gloria, Buffalo, New York

A: Souvenir spoons were especially popular during the Victorian era. I suspect that the spoons in your collection were purchased and given to mark a birthday. They look quite stunning in the photos you provided, and I recommend you proudly display them in your home. I have seen spoon holders that would be perfect to showcase your collection.

Q: I have a watercolor by Pedro Cortez that I purchased at an estate auction a year or two ago. How much is it worth? -- Ken, Providence, Rhode Island

A: I get dozens of letters and emails from readers who are curious about artwork they have purchased. Most want to know about values. A painting or artwork can be worth a great deal or very little. It takes a professional to determine which, and that is why my answer for readers is generally the same: Hire a professional appraiser. Determining an accurate value requires both time and expertise.

If you feel you have a work that could be valuable, it is certainly worth paying for the services of a professional appraiser. Case in point: A woman in Phoenix didn't want to spend \$400 to find out the value of four etchings she wished to sell. She received \$250 for the etchings, only to learn later that they were worth about a \$1,000 each. Her refusal to spend \$400 cost her about \$3,750.

Q: My uncle lived in New York City during the 1940s and had one of the first television sets, a 1946 DuMont, Model RA 102. It is a console with a 12-inch screen. Although it doesn't work, is it worth much in today's market? -- Stephanie, Walla Walla, Washington.

A: I found your television set referenced in The Antique Trader Radio and Television Price Guide, edited by Kyle Husfloen (KP Books). According to Husfloen, your set is worth approximately \$1,200. The more expensive model, the RA-101-1A, which featured a motorized TV screen, radio and phonograph, is worth slightly more, about \$1,500.

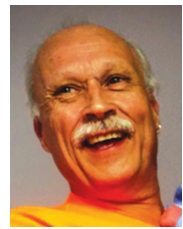

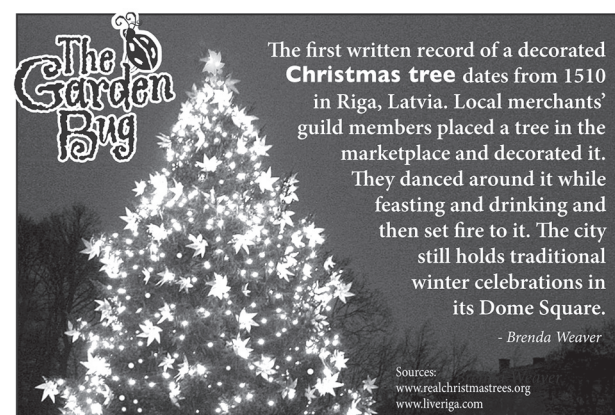

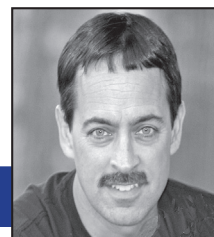

"The Birthday"

The. Definite article. A three letter word indicating specificity. A word that sets something apart from all others. I am Bo Wagner, but I am not "the Bo Wagner," since a quick Google search reveals singers, medical doctors, insurance salesman, and lawyers of the same name.

But when it comes to the birth of Jesus, it really is appropriate to call it "The Birthday." Yes, others (many, many others) have been born and thus had a birthday, but no one anywhere at any time has had a birthday quite like his.

It started in the garden of Eden, really. When God spoke to the serpent in Genesis 3:15, he informed him that he would send the "seed of the woman" to bruise the serpent's head. That is the Protoevangelium, the first gospel, the promise of the Messiah. In practical terms, though, it was a birth announcement 4000 years before the fact. "The" indeed!

Fast forward 3300 years or so to the time of Isaiah. Two enemy kingdoms were coming against Judah. Ahaz, the king of Judah, was rightly terrified. But God sent Isaiah the prophet to meet the king, and to deliver a message to him. It was a message of comfort for the present and for the near future, but in the midst of that God also sent a prophecy of the distant future. He said in Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel." 700 or so years later, an angel

appeared to a simple man named Joseph and said these words, "Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins."

Matthew then added this Holy Ghost inspired commentary, which tied this event to the prophecy of Isaiah: "Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us." "The" indeed!

When Jesus was born, the very heavens above moved to give testimony to the greatness of the event. Matthew 2:1-2 says "Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him." This, too, was prophesied so very long ago. In Numbers 24:17, a wicked prophet named Balaam was overcome by God, and uttered these words: "I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel..." A star particularly identified itself with the Christ child, and stayed at its post for two years at the very least. No one else, ever, has had a celestial body of heaven put

everything else aside to form a night-light for a newborn, and a beacon for those seeking him. "The" indeed!

Perhaps most poignant of all is the consideration of to whom the birth announcement itself first came on that blessed Christmas morn. Luke 2:8-12 says "And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger."

Shepherds? Why should such social outcasts receive the first word of the birth of a king? Why should they be so tacitly invited to come and visit with him and his new family? Because Jesus, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, came during his first coming as the Lamb of God which taketh away the sins of the world. Who better to understand and appreciate that concept than shepherds? They above anyone else could understand that this precious child, laying so sweetly in the manger, would one day shed His blood to pay for the sins of us all.

"The" indeed!

"The nursing program takes a lot of diligence and dedication," Rudd added. "DCC instructors do an excellent job preparing and molding students into competent nurses."

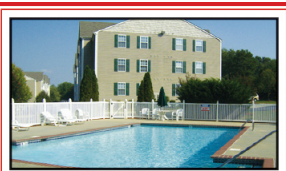

Improved Veterans Health Care Act

Democrats and Republicans shook hands across the aisle in the U. S. House of Representatives and voted unanimously to pass the Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2016.

Here are some highlights.
* Section 301: Until now, survivors of veterans who died after Nov. 1, 1990, and who provided a privately paid-for headstone for their veteran could apply for a service medallion to be put on that headstone. Section 301 makes that any veteran who served after April 6, 1917.

* Section 303: In some places, the coroner's office holds unclaimed remains of veterans who died without family. Often a town's citizens will get together, along with local veterans groups, to provide a funeral and burial. Section 303 requires a study of this with a report to Congress.

* Section 401: The Fry Scholarship provides education benefits to spouses and children of veterans who died on active duty after Sept. 10, 2001. It extends the eligibility period for five years.

* Section 501: If a veteran dies as a result of service-connected disability (100 percent rating) and owned a small business, the spouse will be allowed to own and control the business for 10 years. If the veteran had a 10 percent disability, the time will be three years.

* Section 603: Medal of Honor recipients who are now in Priority Group 3 of the Department of Veterans Affairs health care system will be moved up to Group 1. They will be eligible for extended care, and co-payments will be eliminated.

* Section 632: Children across the country were medically affected by toxins (Agent Orange and others) in their military parents. This section requires an agreement with the National Academy of Medicine to conduct research on those descendants. Hopefully the Act will pass the Senate as it is, with no changes. Cross your fingers.

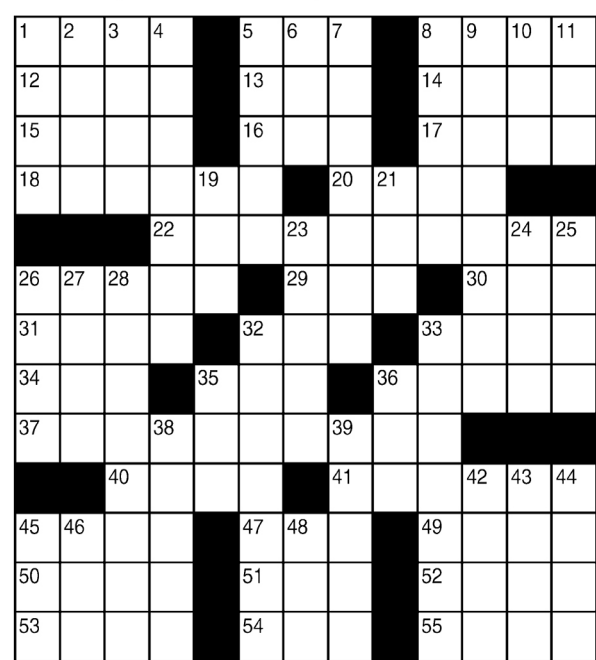

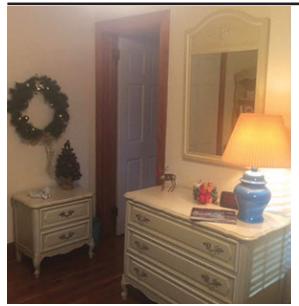

CHRISTMAS SUGAR COOKIE TRUFFLES

Ingredients

- 12 sugar cookies (about 2 1/2 to 3-inches in diameter)
- 3 tablespoons cream cheese, room temperature
- 2 cups white chocolate for melting (or candy melts)
- Sprinkles for decoration

Instructions

Place sugar cookies in a food processor and process until cookies turn into fine crumbs. Add cream cheese and process again until well-combined and mixture can be pressed into a ball, 1 to 2 minutes.

Shape cookies into balls about 1-inch to 1 1/2-inches in diameter. Place on a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper and place in the freezer for 15 minutes or the refrigerator for 1 hour.

In medium bowl, melt white chocolate according to instructions. (See my tips for melting chocolate.)

Remove the cookie balls from refrigerator. Using a spoon or two forks, dip and roll chilled cookie balls, one at a time, in coating. Return to lined cookie sheet and immediately top with sprinkles. Repeat process for remaining cookie balls. Store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to a week.

Notes

If the sugar cookie truffle dough is not firm enough, add another tablespoon of cream cheese.

Greens Bring Luck in the New Year

For many people, the new year is a time for making resolutions and eating certain foods for "luck." On New Year's Day, eating greens, black-eyed peas and cornbread are thought to bring financial reward. While I'm not superstitious, I do believe in the health benefits of eating greens.

Greens include any vegetable in the cabbage family that doesn't form a compact head, like collards, mustards, turnips, spinach and kale. There are several varieties of tasty and unusual types of greens, so be bold and experiment! Dark, leafy greens such as spinach, kale, collards and mustard greens are an excellent source of many nutrients. Greens contain high amounts of vitamin A and iron, as well as some calcium. Greens also are packed with antioxidants and are a wonderful addition to any diet.

If the stems of the greens are tough, don't throw them away. There are nutrients in the stems, so chop them up into small pieces and freeze them. You can add the stems to soups and stews, saute them along with onions, or add them to dishes just as you would carrots.

Pot liquor, the highly seasoned liquid that is left after the greens are cooked, is full of vitamins and minerals and is a nutritious drink.

The practice of combining different types of greens is called a "mess of greens" in the South. Cooking a mixture of greens along with pieces

of pork is an integral part of African and African-American culinary history. During times of slavery, if greens were served one day, the leftover pot liquor and a pan of cornbread often made the meal for the next. My vegetarian version for preparing a mess of greens retains the flavorful soul of the recipe, but is much healthier.

While I don't personally believe in

water to ensure they are clean and free of insects. Roll the cleaned greens up and slice them into smaller pieces so they'll cook evenly. Remove and reserve any large stems.

2. Using a large pot, season the onions with salt and sweat them in the olive oil over low heat for about 10 to 12 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add the garlic, jalapeno, sugar, salt and pepper to the pot, and saute the mixture for about 5 minutes.

3. Add the greens and water to the pot and continue cooking for 45 minutes to 1 hour over medium-low heat, stirring once after about 30 to 40 minutes. Test the greens for tenderness by piercing the stems with a fork or knife. Cook for another 10 to 15 minutes, if needed. Season with the remaining

salt and pepper.
4. Place the greens in a bowl with the pot "likker." Serve with the sun-dried tomatoes and the oil, if desired, and the traditional Southern condiments: vinegar, hot sauce, hot peppers in vinegar, wine vinegar and chopped onions.

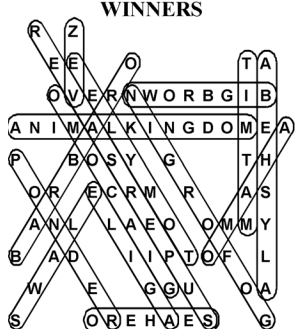
