A: Anna Mary Robertson Moses was known throughout the world as Grandma Moses, a famous folk artist who began her art career in earnest when she was 78 years old. She was born in Greenwich, New York, in 1861, and died in Hoosick Falls, New York, in 1961. Her artwork can be found in major museums. Her painting "The Sugar-ing Off" sold for \$1.2 million in 2006. In 1950, a registration mark was secured, and soon the Atlas China Company was issuing plates that featured some of the designs of Grandma Moses. They are identified with marks that say either "A Grandma Moses Product" or "Anna Mary Robertson Moses."

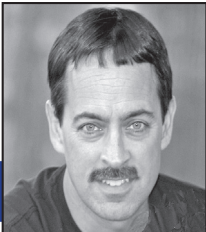

**“Assembling The Family Circle”**

He wasn’t an actor or a singer or a politician or an athlete. No one put posters of him on their wall, and it is likely that no one ever even googled him. He was just an eighty year old man, a husband of fifty years, a father of two, a grandfather of five, a deacon in my church, and a friend.

Brother Joe. That is what we all called him. And in addition to the modest resume above, he was also an Air Force veteran of seven years. He was on a refueling plane during the Cuban Missile Crisis, operating the boom, refueling a bomber with a Russian Mig off his wing ready to blow them all out of the sky. I got to see a picture of that boom refuel in operation, it is incredibly cool.

When Joe and his family got to our church he was already well up in years. But he was so godly and had such a servant’s heart about him that it was almost inevitable that we would make him a deacon.

He called members almost daily, just to speak an encouraging word or two. He did the same for me.

By all of the past tense verbs I am using, you probably know by now that he is “gone.” Just a couple of days before Christmas the family called me to tell me he would probably be dying

shortly. I left a hospital visit and went straight there. Joe had, they said, be unresponsive all day. But when I stepped up beside his bed and said, “Brother Joe, it’s preacher, I came to see you and pray with you” his eyes snapped open. I spoke to him for a moment, and then said, “I have a couple of people I need you to pray for.” I then told him who they were, and what the needs were.

“Okay, I’ll pray.”

Those are the last words he ever said to me. Then he closed his eyes and went back to sleep. A little while later he was looking Jesus face to face and, doubtless, relaying those prayer requests. That is just the kind of heart he had.

I am looking forward to seeing Joe again, and I know that one day I will. You see, way back in 1961, his captain in the Air Force led him to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. And for fifty-five years, his life proved that his conversion was real. And his family followed in his footsteps. While he was laying there unresponsive, we all joined together and sang “What a Day that Will Be” to him.

Moments after he died, the family was rejoicing even through their sorrow, wondering aloud what he was doing in heaven at that moment.

How is such a thing possible? How can people with broken hearts still manage to rejoice? It is pretty simple, really. People often think that death breaks the family circle, but for Christians, every death is actually eternally assembling the family circle piece by piece. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 says, “But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

Christians never really do say goodbye, in reality it is always “see you soon.”



## Seven firefighters graduate from city’s fire academy

Nearly 75 family members and friends celebrated the graduation of the Danville Fire Department’s seven newest professional firefighters on Friday. Each firefighter received their individual badge, which was then pinned to their uniform.

**The new firefighters are Chance Bartee, Scott Birney, Adam Brown, Ryan Lankford, Cody Phelps, William Stephens and Lawrence Woodson III. They will fill positions on battalions at fire stations across the city.**

To graduate, each firefighter had to complete the department’s recruit school academy, which began Oct. 1 and concluded with Friday’s ceremony in Council Chambers at the Municipal Building. An academy provides training in areas such as live firefighting, hazardous materials, search and rescue, vehicle extrication, rapid intervention and first aid.

“We are going to make them part of our family,” said Battalion Chief Barry Neal, who is in charge of training and safety. “This (firefighting) in undoubtedly one of the strongest brotherhoods and bond of any career you will have in your life.”

“It takes a special person to preach, to teach and to be a police officer. But it takes an extremely extraordinary person to be a firefighter. This is not a job. This is a career. We are a service-oriented agency. We do many different things now from EMS (emergency management services) to hazmat (hazardous materials) to technical rescue. Occasionally, you fight fires.”

Dan Jones, retired fire chief of the Chapel Hill, N.C., Fire Department, talked about the responsibilities of a firefighter.

“You are a firefighter not only on the job but around the clock,” Jones said. “Once people know you are a firefighter, you are a firefighter all the time. Others will seek you out in times of crisis. It’s what we do. Firefighting and emergencies is a life you are taking on.”

Friday’s ceremony marked the completion of the department’s only academy this year. The department has 114 firefighters, 21 dispatchers and 10 administrative staff members.

## Diagnosing PTSD, TBI

The Department of Veterans Affairs has come up with a new way to tell the difference between post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and mild traumatic brain injury (TBI).

The difficulty with diagnosing one versus the other is that they both share some common symptoms, such as fatigue, memory loss, irritability, hypersensitivity and dizziness. A recent study used an electroencephalogram to measure the electrical activity in the brain. When researchers studied a large group of EEGs, patterns emerged -- the activity was coming from different parts of the brain. While it doesn't pinpoint the exact place in the brain, it does indicate an overall location. TBI, for example, showed low-frequency waves in the prefrontal and right temporal regions of the brain. PTSD, on the other hand, showed decreased low-frequency waves in the right temporoparietal region. (Low frequency also is indicated in other disorders, such as Alzheimer's disease.) By learning which area of the brain is affected, doctors can diagnose more accurately. This is key, especially with mild TBI that's been present a long time but hasn't responded to treatment. Researchers looked at the records of 147 veterans and servicemembers who'd been exposed to blasts. Of those, 115 had mild TBI, 40 had PTSD and 35 had both. Despite the progress, this study isn't the complete answer. Researchers need to analyze more large groups to further pinpoint the brain locations. Still, being able to make a more accurate diagnosis based on an EEG goes a long way toward getting it right the first time and being able to offer treatment that's more likely to be accurate.

Is Medication Risk Worth the Benefit?

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 76-year-old woman with diabetes. My body, as I have been told, is bad with arthritis, for which I have been prescribed Celebrex. I have been taking it for a few months now, and am definitely moving around with a lot less pain. I recently watched a program that devoted the entire hour to Celebrex. It scared me out of my wits upon hearing the side effects of the medicine. I am asking your advice about whether to stop taking the Celebrex. -- S.A.

ANSWER: All medicines have risks, and in order to decide whether you should keep taking the medicine, you need to really understand what the risks are and balance them against the benefits you feel in your ability to move around more easily.

In the case of Celebrex, we have a pretty good idea of what the risks are. Like all related drugs (including ibuprofen and naproxen), celecoxib (Celebrex) can damage the kidneys, so it isn't recommended for people with kidney disease. There also can be allergic reactions, which may be related to allergies to sulfa drugs. A few people have had vision changes. However, the most concerning risk is heart disease -- both heart attacks and heart failure. These risks definitely are increased among users of celecoxib.

However, the absolute risk is small: There were about two extra cases of all heart events, including heart attack and heart failure, per thousand people taking 400 mg once daily, and six extra events in people taking 400 mg twice daily. Those risks probably are higher if you are at increased risk for heart disease (which you probably are, because of your diabetes), but it still means less than 1 percent of people per year. If the medicine isn't helping, the risk certainly isn't worth it. However, only you can decide if the risk is worth the benefit. Drug companies get into big trouble when they try to hide the risks of their medications, and honesty demands that we admit that all drugs and supplements have risks. Only you can make that decision, but I think it's up to us as doctors to have a frank discussion, especially about medications intended to be taken long-term.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 72-year-old female. My doctor told me four years ago that I would need a Pap test only every two years, which I have done. She told me recently that I would not need to have any more. My tests have always been negative. I am concerned, as I would rather be proactive and know early if I had cancer. What is your opinion, and what does the American Cancer Society say? -- B.L.S.

ANSWER: All of the leading organizations, including the American Cancer Society, have recommended stopping screening at age 65 for women with no history of cancer and who have had adequate screening, meaning three negative Pap smears (or two negative combination Pap and HPV tests) in the past 10 years, with at least one in the past five years. The risk for cancer in this specific group is very low.

- 1 pound bacon, cooked and crumbled
- 2 tbsps bacon drippings
- 3 (15 ounce) cans kidney beans
- 3 (15 ounce) cans white beans
- 3 (15 ounce) cans pork and beans
- 3 small onions, diced
- 1 cup light brown sugar
- 1 cup ketchup
- 1/2 cup molasses
- 3 tbsps yellow mustard

#### Instructions

In a large skillet, cook the ground beef and onions until the meat is no longer pink; drain.

Drain all of the beans except for one can of pork and beans. Combine the beans, cooked ground beef and onions, and remaining ingredients to your crock pot.

Cook for 4 hours on high or 8 hours on low.

#### Notes

*This recipe makes a TON of beans. Plan to use a large oval crockpot or halve the recipe. This is the size crockpot I use. I served 20 people and still had leftovers, but everyone was more than willing to take some home!*
