While wooden pallets move most products across the globe, the industry often remains a mystery to those not involved in it. The vast majority of consumer and manufacturing goods move domestically and internationally on pallets. Nearly 95% of those pallets are crafted from wood. Building and transporting wooden pallets is an \$11.5 billion industry with nearly 3,000 mostly small family businesses operating in all 50 states.



Medicare Minute

"Frequently Asked Questions"

We began in the Medicare business in 2009. Since that time we have been asked some interesting and unique questions about Medicare. However, the majority of the questions we are asked we get on a regular basis. Over the next few weeks we are going to discuss some of our most frequently asked questions.

Do I have to sign up for Medicare Part B when I turn 65 if I'm still employed? This is one of the questions we get asked the most. In most cases the answer to this is "no". When you turn 65, if you are still working and on your employer's health insurance plan you probably will not need Medicare Part B. I say probably because most employer plans do not file on Medicare if you have a claim. Because you have to pay a premium for Part B, Medicare does not require a person to sign up for Part B as long as you are on your employer's plan. Once you retire the rules may change. The safest thing to do is check with the benefits coordinator at your place of employment for guidance or give us a call at our office.

I am on Medicare and Social Security Disability. I'm turning 65 soon. What are my options? Once you reach the age of 65 you have many more options than before. As you know if you go on Medicare and you are under the age of 65 your options for health plans are limited. When you turn 65 you will have another open enrollment period to sign up for any plan you wish to get. In other words, just because you are already on Medicare does not prohibit you from

having all the options a person not on Medicare and turning 65 would have.



Conversely, the more weight that's lost, the more sensitive your body gets to your insulin. If someone can get their weight to a normal level, in many cases the blood sugars normalize. That is why in my practice, I emphasize getting

The other major reason is that the genetic and environmental factors that made you diabetic in the first place are usually still there. That is, if you are "cured" of diabetes by weight loss and go back to eating poorly, you will start to gain weight that will lead to recurrence of type 2 diabetes. Therefore, remember to adjust your lifestyle to keep the weight off.



TORT LAW -**DEFENSES**

Last week we talked about how when a person behaves in a way that either breaks a rule or creates a danger which a reasonable person would see and avoid, they become responsible for all the harms and losses they create.

This week we will talk about some of the reasons why if someone gets hurt and blames you, the legal reason why you may not be responsible. For instance, if you own a store and there is a box in the aisle and someone trips over that box and is hurt, there may be a defense. One defense to that is that the person should have seen a box that was out in the open and obvious to anyone who was looking where they were going.

The idea here is that a person cannot contribute to their own injury. That's the defense of "contributory negligence". For instance, if you pull

out in front of someone but you didn't see them because they were going 80 mph, they are not going to be able to successfully sue you because they were breaking a rule of safety that contributed to their own harm. By the same token, if you don't know how fast you were going right after an accident, don't just guess.

Really complex rules exist for suing governmental employees. Courts were established by kings. When kings began to delegate the authority to decide disputes to judges, one rule was firmly established and that is the idea that people may sue one another but not the king. This is now known as "sovereign immunity". The idea of giving these our governmental employees immunity is to allow them freedom to use their discretion in making decisions. They do not have the discretion to break a rule. A mailman or police officer does not have the discretion to just cruise through stop signs and red lights. If they do and cause harm, they can be sued but it is still more difficult.

Another defense is that people can wait too long to bring a lawsuit and thus violate the statute of limitations.

Next week we will talk about workers compensation and the law of on-the-job injuries.

What Is The Standard For **Your Behavior?**

A few days ago I had to make a run to Lowe's. It seems that every man has to make a stop there periodically. Even if we do not buy anything, somehow walking among tools and building materials reinforces our masculinity.

On this occasion it was not what happened in the store, but in the parking lot, that gave me a lesson for the day. I drive a full-size, four-door truck, or as my wife prefers to call it, "a barge." I like it and it serves me well in a lot of ways, but parking it in certain parking spaces can

be a bit of a challenge. In the aisle of parking that I chose most of the vehicles had pulled through to the spaces actually designed to be used from the next aisle over, so I did the same. That meant that I left a parking space behind me. In addition to the size of my truck I also have a trailer hitch which adds a degree of difficulty when judging if you have pulled forward enough to allow room for the vehicle that pulls in behind you.

But rather than get out and look, I noticed that the truck parked beside me was about the same size as mine. So I lined up my door windows with it and felt that I had remedied the problem. Thus, I hopped out and went into the store and made my purchase. However, when I came back to my vehicle I saw that I had made a mistake! The truck that I used to judge my parking was badly positioned and mine looked just like it. Both of us were taking up four spaces! And no, I did not blame it on him- - I should have been more careful about what I used as a model.

This is true not only when parking, but in spiritual matters, too. I am reminded of Paul's words when dealing with some false teachers, "But they, measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise" (2 Corinthians 10:12). The principle is the same. As someone noted, "The value of a comparison depends on the standard."

If we are not careful we can find ourselves measuring our spiritual well-being by the perceived spiritual well-being of others. But this too is not wise! What is wise is to always make Jesus the standard and model of our lives! Like the author of Hebrews penned, we must "Look to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith" (Hebrews 12:2).





millions of tax dollars to those areas to help defy federal law.







Dear Ben,

First, congratulations on being debt-free and new parents. Happy New Year to you all!

In most states, the only upfront cost for an LLC is the money you pay for the initial set up. There may be a small fee for a business license and subsequent annual renewal, but that generally doesn't add up to much. Then, there's the money you pay for filing your tax return on the LLC once a year. Even if you live in a state where there are other fees to consider, as long as the cost of maintaining the LLC wasn't killing you, I'd recommend keeping it in place. You went to the trouble of opening it, and you just might use it again someday. Even if your wife is staying home with the baby, she just might be able to take on more students again as time goes by.

Just be reasonable and use common sense. If you spend \$3,000 to stay open, and you're making \$700, you'd dissolve it, right? But as long as you don't have fees that are making you cringe, I'd probably leave it in place.

HELPING HAND

Dear Dave,

My dad has been really bad with money his entire life. Any-time he would get into trouble, my grandparents would always bail him out. This time he came to my wife and I, asking for \$350 to get out of overdraft at the bank. We're trying to live on a budget and get control of our finances, and \$350 would make things kind of tight at the moment. What do you think we should do?

Dear Jeremy,

I understand feeling an obligation to help your dad. But there's a lesson here that dad needs to learn, and it's something that goes much deeper than the money or helping out a family mem-

You have to do the right thing, no matter how dad reacts to this. Right now, the right thing is taking care of your family and not putting them in jeopardy. So my answer to dad would be no. Another thing that needs to happen is for the definition of "help" to change. When you say he's been irresponsible with money his whole life, giving him \$350 won't help — and it will make you an enabler. Just handing him \$350 will actually hurt him, and it will give him the idea he can continue being dumb with money and hit you up for cash anytime.

Like I said, I understand the pull of helping out a parent. So if you feel this is something you absolute-ly must do, I would advise making the \$350 contingent on the fact that he begin and complete a financial counseling course. Be gentle when you talk to him, and let him know it hurts to see him struggling. But let him know, too, it's his responsibility to work through his debts and take care of his own finances!





County, Florida in June. In July they forced a county in California -- the fifth so far -- to follow suit. Colorado activists just submitted reférendums two for November's ballot, one of which would remit fracking control to local authorities who may be easier to persuade.

These environmentalists claim they're saving people and the planet. In fact,

they're hurting both.
Fracking has boosted local economies, created thousands of jobs, and reduced carbon emissions. Whether malicious or simply misguided, the antifracking agenda causes higher emissions and more poverty.

América's energy boom over the past decade has been astounding. United States produced more natural gas last year than ever before, 27 trillion cubic feet. That is a staggering 50% increase over ten years ago. America has surpassed Saudi Arabia and Russia to become the world's largest producer of natural gas.

Innovation in fracking is the cause of this boom. Blasting sand and water rock formations releases previously unreachable oil and natural gas reserves.

The Harvard Business observed School fracking created 2.7 million jobs and \$43 billion in economic activity in 2014. It supported 2 million jobs nationwide last year.

The average American family has saved \$1,337 from fracking through cheaper gasoline and lower energy bills.

Fracking has also lowered carbon emissions. Because natural gas is much cheaper now, electricity plants have been switching from coal to natural gas for power generation. That's good news for the environment because natural gas emits about half as much carbon dioxide as coal per kilowatt hour produced.

result? greenhouse gas emissions are now at a twenty year low.

environmentalists Yet, continue to fight fracking -- and all other fossil fuel development.

Bill McKibben, the farleft environmental guru, recently wrote, "We have to keep 80% of the fossilfuel reserves that we know about underground." Given that renewables account for less than 14% of U.S. needs, McKibben's proposal is literally a new Dark Age.

Indeed, McKibben's agenda would cause misery worldwide while he continues using fossil fuels to jet around the globe scolding the rest of us as the poorest suffer from such ideological zeal.

The world's poorest need more energy development,

not less. Over 1 billion people lack access to electricity. The majority of those are in sub-Saharan Africa and rural Asia. The World Health Organization reports four million deaths annually from air pollution caused by households cooking with fuels like wood and charcoal.

These deaths preventable. Since the Îndustrial Revolution, fossil fuels have helped grow economies developing nations. For example, China lifted 680 million people from poverty in just thirty years with help from fossil fuels.

Environmentalists' green tunnel vision ignores how fracking improves lives and reduces emissions. Federal and

regulators understand this perfectly well. That's why environmentalists continue pushing their agenda at lower levels where scare tactics may be more effective.

It's time for local officials who know better to challenge this profoundly unprogressive agenda, or at least have these brave environmentalists live under the rules they want to impose on all of us.

I had a recipe that called for a pound of cooked turkey meat, cut up. I didn't want to pay \$5.99 a pound for a slab of turkey breast from the deli, so I bought half a turkey breast (with skin and bones), roasted it, chilled it, skinned and boned it, and cut up the meat. Its starting weight was 2.74 pounds, and at \$2.19 a pound, it cost \$6. Well, by the time the juices cooked out and I removed skin, fat and bone, I had no more than 1.25 pounds of usable meat. The actual cost per pound was \$4.80. By the time I factor in my time (probably 30 minutes over two days), the electricity




