





### A Shepherd's Heart – The Great Exchange

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord." – Romans 6:23 (HCSB)

Exchange is a word that we hear often. It's also a word that we use in many different situations. For example: we sometimes exchange



A few years ago we held our annual D'NOW for our student ministry. I had the honor to preach/teach during the large group worship rallies during this event. The study chosen this particular year was entitled, "Exchange: Gaining through Giving Up." During the course of the weekend, we talked about exchanging death for life; exchanging self for Christ; exchanging hate for love; and exchanging comfort for calling. As we discussed various Scripture passages concerning each of these exchanges, this truth became evident rather quickly: The life that we are called to live as Christ followers is indeed a life that is only gained through giving up. A life received only through surrender. A life of exchanging our sin debt, for the pardon offered by our Savior.

I mentioned earlier that we often exchange gifts with others at Christmas. When I think back over all the Christmases in my life (and I have experienced 57 of them now), I can never remember refusing to accept a gift that was given to me. What about you? The sad reality is that not everyone can say that concerning the gift that God has given to all who would receive. You know the gift I'm talking about, don't you? The gift of eternal life through His only-begotten Son whose name is Jesus. (John 3:16; Romans 6:23) In order to experience the exchange, you must accept the gift that God gives to you freely. Do you know Christ personally? Have you made the exchange? You can exchange death for life; self for Christ; hate for love; and comfort for calling today by receiving the gift of God.





# Green Bay outlasts Cowboys in playoffs

He led the AFL in field goal percentage in both 1962 and 1963. The former Ole Miss Rebel scored 272 points and intercepted five passes in his career. He played on three teams that played for the AFL Championships and was a member of the 1963 AFL Champs. Blair was sad about the Chargers' move to L.A. "As you know, the team came to San Diego in 1961 because of the attendance in L.A. I was very fortunate to be a member of the first San Diego team. The fans were great then and now. I hate the move. It's all about money.'

Others even in L.A. are not sure why the Chargers moved. Los Angeles Times sports reporter Bill Plaschke wrote, "Every relationship is built on honesty, so the San Diego Chargers should hear this as their moving vans are chugging up Interstate 5 on their noble mission of greed. We. Don't. Want. You."

My son Brett, who lives in San Diego and is a Chargers season ticket holder, shared his view that a lot of Southern Californians have on the move. "I will miss Sundays at the Q and the sight of Chargers flags around town. The Chargers did not make San Diego a world-class city though. The brilliant and talented people make San Diego a world-class city. At the end of the day, we did not lose a whole lot. The mayor and the city council can now focus on more ways to attract new businesses and enhance our tourism industry."





Former Major League Baseball standout pitcher Ben McDonald has been announced as the keynote speaker at the 14th Annual Southern Miss Dugout Club Banquet in the Thad Cochran Center, Saturday, Feb. 11. During his three-year career collegiate baseball career, he helped the Tigers to two College World Series appearances and was a member of the 1988 US Olympic Gold Medal squad in the Seoul games. After finishing with a 14-4 record for the Tigers in 1989 that included a 3.49 ERA and a SEC record 202 strikeouts, McDonald

McDonald, a College Baseball Hall of Fame inductee in 2008, currently provides
