What do you think? --Dorothy, North Canton, Ohio A: According to "Hopalong Cassidy Collectibles" by Joseph J. Caro, there were two types of Hoppy cameras made, and both are extremely collectible. The camera is an all-metal Brownie that takes 120 size film, with a top strap and metal plate featuring the images of Hopalong Cassidy and his horse, Topper. The only attachment was a special flash that was sold separately. Without the original box, your camera is worth about \$250. I have seen this camera sell for more at auction.

Q: I have a number of serving dishes in the Candlewick pattern. Tell me what you know about this glass. -- Frances, Rio Rancho, New Mexico

A: Candlewick glass was made by the Imperial Glass Company from 1936 until October 1982. According to "Glass A-Z" by David Shotwell and published by Krause Books, the pattern, known as Imperial's No. 400, identified the plain glassware that was molded with beading around the rims and bases or stems of most of the pieces the company produced. For values, I suggest you contact antique dealers in your area.

Q: I have written to you three times and you never answer my request. I have a brand-new fishing reel that has never been used. It has a nice design and I have never seen anything like it. Thanks for answering or go to hell. --George, Albuquerque, New Mexico A: Because of the volume of letters and email

"Is Militant Christianity Truly Christian?"

The song many of us learned in youth will never be fully expunged from our minds, no matter how long we live.

"Onward Christian

soldiers, marching as to war, with the cross of Jesus, going on before, Christ the royal master leads against the foe, forward into battle see his banners go, onward Christian soldiers marching as to war, with the cross of Jesus, going on before."

I could easily segue from that song into a stirring rendition of, "I'm In The Lord's Army," but I shall refrain from so doing. These songs and others like them give us a mental picture of armor bedecked Christians marching side-by-side with weapons of war held at the ready. But when I view the commonly accepted portrait of today's Christianity, it begs the very question of whether militant Christianity is truly Christian to begin with.

Judge not. Love everyone. Be meek and gentle. Be silent. These and other phrases like them echo not just toward Christendom but also from it. And all of them have one thing in common; they are merely one side of the coin that is true Christianity. But if one ever flips the coin over to examine the other side as well, a far more balanced picture of Christianity emerges.

Speaking prophetically of Christ, Isaiah 53:7 says, 'He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth." But the other

chapter eighteen. Jesus answered the high priest in a way that those standing around viewed as disrespectful. One of

men there hit Jesus, and rebuked him for what he said. But, far from being silent, verse twentythree tells us that Jesus immediately responded 'If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me?

Jesus took children up in his arms. He also flipped over a few tables. He said the meek would inherit the earth. He also very un-meekly called the king a fox, an animal that was as ill regarded as a weasel in our day. He was regarded as the friend of sinners, yet he pointedly rebuked sinners for things like adultery, fornication, and more, and even rebuked entire cities by name. In John 14:27 he said "my peace I give unto you," yet in Matthew 10:34 he said, "Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword." In John 13:35 he said, "By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." But in Matthew 18 he instructed that if a fellow Christian did wrong and would not get right he was to be regarded as "a heathen man and a publican."

Ecclesiastes 3:1 brings some reconciliation to these seemingly disparate things. It says, "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven." Verse eight tells us that there is "a time of war, and a time of peace."

side of the coin is in John There most certainly is a time for Christians to be meek and silent. There are also times for Christians to be vocal and militant. Not self-serving or self-aggrandizing, but good soldiers of Christ as Paul instructed Timothy to be. The good news for the world in this is that according to 2 Corinthians 10:4 "the weapons of our warfare are not carnal." Real Christians are never in

bombing, murdering, terrorizing, cursing business, or even in the business of "shock value rudeness". We are, though, to be in the business of standing up loudly and boldly and taking a stand for God and righteousness. Isaiah 58:1 says, "Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.

Jesus came to win souls. But he did not do so by constantly telling everyone how wonderful special and amazing they are. He did so by saying things like "except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish" (Luke 13:3,5) and by warning that one day he would say
