Local Leadership Team Completes Community Health Assessment

Mount Morris: The Livingston County Community Health Assessment Leadership Team, a coalition of health professionals, community volunteers, and local leaders, recently conducted a Community Health Assessment of Livingston County and created a Community Health Improvement Plan. The Livingston County Department of Health, Noyes Health, the Genesee Valley Health Partnership, and S2AY coordinated the process by implementing Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnerships (MAPP), which is a community-driven strategic planning process for improving community health.

"Strong communities require strong leadership and guidance by hospitals, health departments, community members and stakeholders", stated Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director.


Patty Piper, Noyes Community Outreach Director, added, "Noyes Health has a very positive and collaborative working relationship with the Livingston County Department of Health. This helps us effectively define the strategies that our area health and human service agencies will support and provide to help improve the health and wellbeing of the communities we serve."

Livingston County priorities that were identified through the community health assessment were chronic disease prevention, substance abuse prevention and mental health promotion, and fall prevention among seniors. As detailed in the CHIP, strategies to address chronic diseases include evidence based activities such as Stanford approved curriculums to include Chronic Disease Self-Management Programs, implementation of healthy policies/practices in schools and worksites, Healthy Lifestyle Program, working to increase opportunities for physical activity in the community, and working to increase the number of farmers markets. Strategies under "Promote Mental Health and Prevent Substance Abuse" include, building the capacity of the Suicide Prevention Task Force, implementing evidence based health messages and trainings, pursuing additional Social Host Laws in towns/villages, implementing evidence based interventions based on the Prevention Needs Assessment data, increasing access by co-locating behavior health into primary care, implementing best practices for anti-bullying/non-violence programming in schools, and coordinating mental, emotional, behavioral (MEB) and chronic disease efforts. To address the third priority, falls among seniors, evidence based strategies will include: Home Safe Home, Tia Chi and Matter of Balance. The evidence based interventions/strategies were selected by sub committees which focus on the specific issues, which included: Chronic Disease, Fall Prevention, and Healthy Communities That Care committees.


