

Finally, VA Steps Up on Camp Lejeune Water

The Department of Veterans Affairs finally is publishing a list of eight presumptive diseases associated with the tainted water at Camp Lejeune. No, really. Back in 2015, this column reported that the VA was "looking at the possibility of maybe establishing some presumptives," and in 2016, that officials were "thinking about adding eight new presumptives" and opened the floor for comments. Meanwhile, it was treating veterans with any of 15 illnesses caused by drinking water laced with fuel and dry-cleaning fluid, but without any disability payments. Now a presumption of service connection has been established and the VA will provide disability benefits for eight diseases: adult leukemia; aplastic anemia and other myelodysplastic syndromes; bladder cancer; kidney cancer; liver cancer; multiple myeloma; non-Hodgkin's lymphoma; and Parkinson's disease. No word yet about the other seven illnesses the VA has been treating, such as breast cancer, esophageal cancer, leukemia and hepatic steatosis. To qualify, a servicemember would have to have been stationed at Camp Lejeune for a minimum of 30 days between Aug. 1, 1953 and Dec. 31, 1987. Former reservists and Guard members fall under this ruling. The 30 days can be consecutive or non-consecutive. The new rule will take effect either 60 days after being published in the Federal Register or after a 60-day Congressional Review, whichever is later. For more information, go online to www.publihealth.va.gov/exposures/camp-lejeune. Scroll down for information on the 15 illnesses that also impacted families. Also see www.federalregister.gov and search for "Diseases Associated With Exposure to Contaminants in the Water Supply at Camp Lejeune." Note especially the comments section with all the info the VA chose not to use. If you have an illness that might be connected to your time at Camp Lejeune, tell your doctor about this list of illnesses and file a VA claim.

"The Worst Game Of Hide And Seek Ever"

"Fat dog can move!" That was the primary thought bouncing around in my mind like a pinball as I went racing through the woods behind my house a few days ago. The "fat dog" in question is my faithful mutt of questionable lineage, Riley.

I had been working non-stop, wide open from early that morning: hospital visits in distant cities, calls on members, and much time at the desk preparing for Sunday. And so, late in the afternoon, I decided to take a walk in the woods behind our house to clear my head. On a whim I decided to take the dogs with me, Echo the Labrador (appropriately nicknamed "Chewy") and old, decrepit, fat Riley.

Now, Riley has been on a shock collar for a while, since he likes to wander. So I removed the collar and put him on a leash for our walk. Once we had gotten pretty far back in the woods I decided to let him off the leash and see if he would A) stay nearby, or B) come when I called.

As you have guessed from my opening sentence, the answer was C) neither of the above. Probably 500 yards (30 ticks, 22 briar gashes, 3 near coronaries) later, I caught him. Exhausted and perturbed, I cut

through the woods and came straight home.

Pretty quickly the home phone rang, and I had to go on another pastoral call. I took my wife's cell phone since I could not find mine and, sure that it was in my office somewhere, I asked her to find it for me while I was gone.

I got back very late. When I arrived, Dana called me to the computer screen and showed me two blue dots. She said, "See this dot? This is us, here in the house. See this other dot? That is your phone, way out in the woods somewhere..."

45 minutes, in the dark. That is how long it took me to track and retrieve it. I am fairly certain I uttered several "Christian equivalency curse words" at Riley (Rotten, unsanctified, Philistine of a dog...) along the way. But I found the phone. It was too important for me not to.

And, as is so often the case, when my heart rate had slowed, and my nerves calmed, the Lord seemed to whisper for me to pay attention, and think in bigger terms.

We expend the greatest efforts on the things that matter most to us.

I went running after a dog, and then trekking

through the woods in the dark to retrieve a phone. I wonder, does our fellowship with the Lord rate so high with all of us, or any of us? Psalm 42:1 says, "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God."

Panting for God. Thirsting for him like a deer thirsts after a stream of clear water. Oh, what anguish smites my heart as I realize that so very often Christians, myself included, do not have that type of desire for the God who gave himself for us on the cross of Calvary. Even worse, we probably do not even recognize that failure.

I said earlier, "We expend the greatest efforts on the things that matter most to us." That is a pretty good test for us to determine what our priorities are. What do we expend our greatest efforts on? Money? Possessions? Physical health? Popularity? Entertainment? Where does God fit on the list?

We have all eternity to enjoy heaven. We only have a little time to show God by our efforts and pursuit of him that he means more to us than anything else.

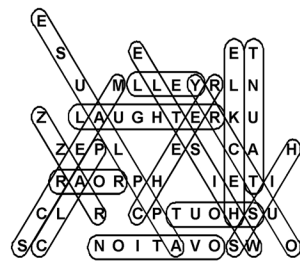

Stemless Daisy

Q: I have inherited a sugar shaker that has been identified as a piece of Stemless Daisy. What can you tell me about it? -- Betty, Portsmouth, Virginia

A: Stemless Daisy -- sometimes known as Cosmos pottery -- is pattern glass that was produced from roughly 1895 until 1915 by the Consolidated Lamp and Glass Company. Almost all of the pieces I have seen are made of milk glass, but there are exceptions. The relief-molded flowers are generally on a finely crosscut background and painted in soft colors, including blue, pink and yellow. Your sugar shaker is considered rare, and depending on its condition could be worth as much as \$650.

Q: In 1937, I received a composition and stuffed cloth doll of Mickey Mouse. It is marked "knickerbocker" and is about 12" tall and in excellent condition. A neighbor has offered me \$250 for it, but I wanted to check with you first. -- Arthur, Austin, TX

A: I found your doll referenced in the "Official Hake's Price Guide to Character Toys" by Ted Hake and published by House of Collectibles. According to Hake, if your doll is truly in excellent condition it could be worth as much as \$1,200.

Q: I have seven Daguerreotype pictures. They are in fairly good condition, but no cases. What would be the average price if I want to sell them? -- Mildred, Laurel, Indiana

A: It really depends on the images. Most of the Daguerreotypes I have seen in antique shops have been priced in the \$30 to \$50 range. If any of your pictures show children with toys, men in Civil War-era uniforms, or other than studio poses, they could be worth much more.

Q: I have a set of Heston National Finals Rodeo belt buckles issued in 1975 and 2016. The buckles are mint and have never been worn. How much are they worth? --Wade, Orton, Minnesota

A: I contacted a rodeo memorabilia collector who thought your buckles would be valued in the \$15 to \$25 range. This was confirmed when I checked eBay and found dozens of Heston rodeo buckles, mostly offered for \$15 and \$20 each.

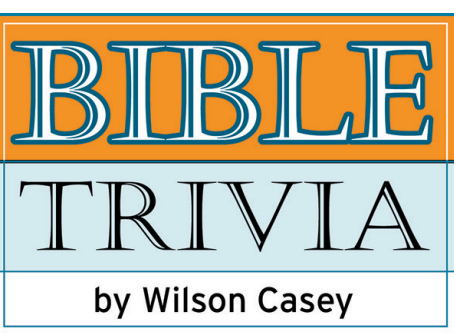

In January 2017, Centra Lynchburg General Hospital once again received full Atrial Fibrillation Accreditation status from the Society of Cardiovascular Patient Care (SCPC) making it the only hospital in Virginia to currently attain this distinction.

The Centra Stroobants Cardiovascular Center has demonstrated its expertise and commitment to quality patient care by meeting or exceeding a wide set of stringent criteria and undergoing a comprehensive review by an accreditation review specialist from the SCPC. Centra's guideline-driven and systematic approach to patient evaluation and management allows physicians to reduce time to treatment and to identify high-risk patients in an effort to decrease their length of stay in the emergency department and the hospital.

Joan Deal, practice director of the Centra Medical Group Stroobants Cardiovascular Center outpatient facility, spoke positively about the recent accreditation and stated that "this accomplishment emphasizes our commitment to expert care for our patients." The center has maintained a steady commitment to grow the "Afib Center" within the outpatient division of the practice, and plans to collaborate with local primary care providers to raise community awareness about the signs and symptoms of atrial fibrillation. The Stroobants Cardiovascular Center will also continue to participate in local health fairs and provide educational materials about afib.

Nearly 3 million people in the United States have atrial fibrillation and as the population ages, the numbers continue to increase rapidly. Afib is the most common cardiac arrhythmia, and can lead to strokes and death. SCPC's goal is to help facilities evaluate and manage the atrial fibrillation patient more effectively, improve patient outcomes, and educate patients and healthcare providers to more efficiently care for this disease.

"I am very proud of the work our group has put forward to achieve this accreditation," says Matthew Sackett, M.D., electrophysiology specialist at Centra Medical Group Stroobants Cardiovascular Center. "Atrial fibrillation is a significant issue in our population and these efforts will help prevent hospitalizations, strokes and guide overall better management of atrial fibrillation within our community. This accomplishment highlights Centra's dedication to medical care that exceeds national standards."

There are several factors measured in both the outpatient and inpatient settings such as collaboration between the emergency department and emergency medical services, assessments and treatments of patients presenting with atrial fibrillation, competency of staff, patient education and community outreach.

"In a time where medical care is changing so rapidly, it is vital to have one consistent standard by which these patients are managed in the emergency department." Tom Forsberg, M.D., emergency room physician, added, "We have worked side-by-side with our cardiology colleagues to build a system that will not only help patients, but decrease their risk of stroke down the road."

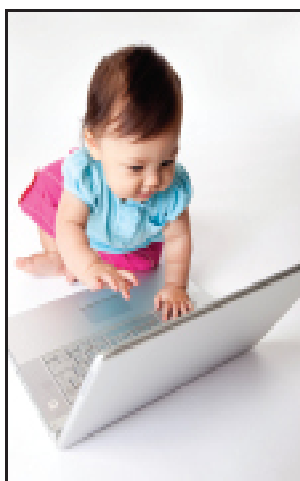

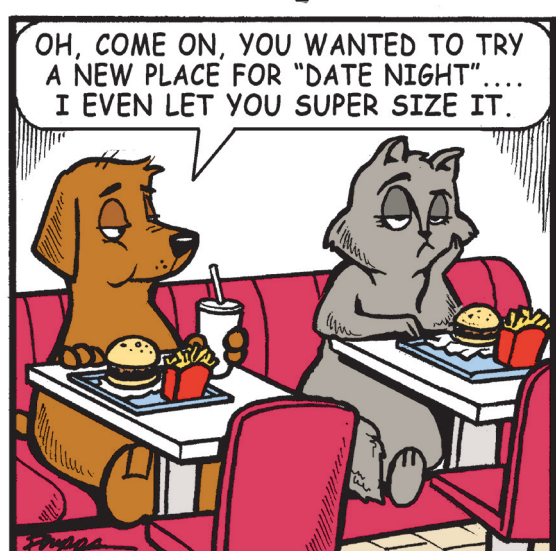
