





A group of local professionals aims to unite young business leaders across the county.

As more and more young married couples and recent college graduates flock back to the Manchester area, there's an increased need for them to have a platform to meet others, both for personal and professional purposes. Enter: Coffee County Young Professionals.

CCYP was founded upon four core principles—building professional networks, developing leadership skills, serving the community and promoting local business—with the intention to unite those across Coffee County by designating a representative for each pillar and tying in key events that support the mantra. Founder Kaitlyn McAdams, manager at Coffee County Funeral Chapel, "put things in motion," Kevin Jones says, before bringing in him and a handful of others last spring to take over where she left off.

McAdams' idea for such a group

came about after the Manchester Area Chamber of Commerce's inaugural Coffee County 2020 - Positioning for growth in December 2015. She identified a need to bring together locals on a more intimate level and established the organization, which is open to anyone between the ages 20 - 40 who is active in the business community.

"With the Downtown Movement, it's been great seeing so much interest in bettering the community. We want to be part of that. We want young people to take pride in their town," Jones, interim president, says. "We're trying to offer them something to do and provide an organization you'd find in a bigger city—which we're capable of doing if more locals get involved. We've got the vision and the leadership if we can just get people to come along with us."

In its first year, CCYP held four events, which rotated locations

between Tullahoma and Manchester everymonth in the hopes of engaging both communities. The first afterhours event at Ole Shed Brewing Company in April brought out more than 60 young professionals with follow-up mixers at West Main Brick Oven, One22West and Beans Creek Winery drawing anywhere from 35 to 60 attendees.

On Feb. 23, 2017 CCYP will have the chance to take the stage and tell others more about their vision as part of the YP Summit, a half-day event with panels and breakout sessions that will be held at Manchester Coffee County Conference Center and sponsored by CCYP, Emerging Leaders, and the chambers of commerce in both Manchester and Tullahoma.

In 2017, Jones says the group also is aiming for a networking event every other month—for a total of six CCYP-branded events—in addition to the summit and other conferences and local events the organization will support. He also wants CCYP to have a stronger presence in the community service arena. His real focus at the moment, though, is simply getting the word out so that people know the group exists.

"The challenge for us right now is we need more hands on deck, and that's what we're really working toward now: bringing more people in and filling key leadership roles," Jones, says.





Currently, there are no dues—though Jones says that may change in the future as eventually CCYP is going to need funds to accomplish their goals—and all events are free to attend.

"Before we start charging anyone anything, I want us to be established enough to make sure we're offering a benefit or value to members," Jones says.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

A progressive work-based learning program allows local high school students to gain a leg up in the manufacturing world.

"THE BOTTOM LINE is trying to get kids to grow and become young adults. This is building for their future. It's helping build better workers and better community leaders."

As the workforce continues to get more competitive, Coffee County Central High School aims to prepare its students for employment in the real world, as evidenced by an innovative new partnership with Manchester-based manufacturer VIAM.

"The VIAM experience," as they're calling it, launched in July as the brainchild of Richard Skipper, CCCHS Career and Technical Education Director, with the first cell of 11 students beginning at the company a few weeks before school was back in session. Thanks to word of mouth, news of the program spread, and a handful of others joined by the end of the first quarter.

VIAM has been supplying the automotive industry with custom

design floor, trunk and cargo mats for 33 years, and participating students work at the plant after school from Monday through Thursday, learn core skills of the workplace and even get compensated for their time. There are requirements—such as attendance and a minimum grade point average—that participants must meet, the most important of which is being on track to graduate.

"We're looking to develop a careerready student," Skipper says. "In the past, it might have been the college student or the vocational student, but what we've come to realize is it's really the career-ready student. That could mean four years of college or two years of college or some type of certification while they're in high



school that's going to give them a leg up after they graduate. What we want to do is offer as many real-life challenges and links to what they're studying in school."

Though VIAM CEO Keith Hayes was taking a gamble when he agreed to take the students on as employees, Skipper says it's a win-win partnership, as VIAM will have the ability to sculpt and recruit potential long-term employees in a time when the state unemployment rate is hovering around 4.5 percent and demand for workers exceeds supply.

Work-based learning isn't exactly a new concept—there are now 9,000 students state-wide enrolled in similar programs, CCCHS Principal Dr. Joey Vaughn says. But what VIAM and the high school are doing is unique.

"The innovation with VIAM is that we're putting our students in a manufacturing setting as seniors in high school. Up to this point, workers had to be 18 years old in order to work. The partnership with VIAM allows our 17-year-old seniors to gain work experience," he says.

CCCHS has long offered other work-based learning programs, as well, including service learning, CNA in health sciences, and basic co-op aligning with programs like culinary arts or marketing; in fact, 48 of the 477 Class of 2017 graduates are participating in work-based learning, in addition

to another 60 Capstone students. Skipper explains that the department of education recently redefined work-based learning "so that it needs to align with students' programs of study and so that it's actually leading to some kind of post-secondary opportunity," hence the perfect time to try out something new like the VIAM Experience.

As with any first-time, out-of-the-box endeavor, Skipper says he anticipated some bumps in the road due to the nature of the partnership, but so far has been pleasantly surprised at how smoothly everything has run.

"We're blueprinting this because it's brand new, and I've been waiting for the shoe to fall because everything had been so positive, but it hasn't," Skipper says. "I think that's because VIAM without my students is set up for the employees to be successful, from the benefits they offer to the audits they do among their workers. A lot of things that were required for my students to go out there, VIAM already had in place."

Dr. Vaughn adds, "Anytime you bring new workers into a program, there is a learning curve, but I can't say enough about the support Richard and Keith have given to this program and to our school. The VIAM partnership has given

the student participants a work experience that can't be replicated in a classroom."

Students are treated like any other employee, Skipper says, with work attendance mandatory, and while they don't receive health insurance, they do enjoy a bevy of other incentives, such as access to a doctor, chiropractor, weight room and fitness facility on site. Skipper will continue to welcome new participants each guarter, and once students complete the 15 standards of the work-based learning program, they leave with what he calls "an upper hand:" work time to put on their resumes, a portfolio of assignments and safety trainings, and a manufacturing certification from VIAM.


And while it may seem challenging for a teenager to juggle working and studying at the same time, Dr. Vaughn believes it's been beneficial to both their study and work ethic.


"The key is communication between all of the individuals. In order to go to work our students have to be present at school and remain on track to graduate," he says. "It has been a huge incentive for some of them to complete their education because work-based learning allows them to come to school as well as work and make money."

It helps that the school keeps close tabs on the students' performance, both in class and at work. Skipper adds that Hayes has incentivized attendance by increasing their \$10.50 hourly salary by a dollar an hour after they've been at work every day for 90 days.

"If a student doesn't come to school, they're not allowed to go to work that day. Our purpose is to promote attendance at school and at work," he says. "But since we've incorporated this, the students we have in play right now, their attendance is upside-down compared to what it was their first couple years in school. It's because there are requirements, there are expectations."

CONTROL SHIFT

Following extended transition process that began in the second quarter of last year, National Aerospace Solutions, LLC (NAS) assumed oversight of Arnold Engineering Development Complex's (AEDC) unmatched set of 32 different aeronautical test facilities used in the evaluation of flight testing and weapons systems for the Department of Defense and other customers. The oversight authority awarded with the contract is immense and governs large sub-sections of the United States' defense capabilities in the world of flight and ballistic missiles.

Established by Bechtel, the largest construction and civil engineering company in the United States with a storied history of working on massive, government grade projects like nuclear power plants and capping flaming wells in Kuwait, the limited liability company NAS officially took control of the Test Operations

and Sustainment (TOS) contract in 2016. This performance contract is technically valid for one year but has seven one-year extension options and a total value of approximately \$1.5 billion over its eight-year lifespan.

NAS LLC, which now employs more than 1,400 people, was established by Bechtel, Sierra Lobo, Inc., and GP Strategies for the sole purpose of this TOS contract. It was selected in 2015 by the United States Air Force but was significantly delayed from assuming an operational role by legal challenges to the original award decision. The U.S. Court of Federal Claims denied that protest in March and informed NAS to proceed with a 90-day transition plan beginning in April.

The contract includes operation of all wind tunnels, rocket and turbine engine test cells, ballistic ranges, specialized chambers and other testing units. It also includes technology innovation, facilities management

and capital improvement projects at the extensive national security complex.

NAS took over the contract for the base after Aerospace Testing Alliance's (ATA) contract was not renewed amid a major restructuring, initiated by the previous commander, that split the primary vendor for the base into six separate contracts, and companies executing these contracts were reorganized. Resulting in the layoff and rehire of almost 1,500 employees under new employment terms, the restructuring of management and other suppliers at the base occurred in part due to budget tightening backlash over the years from sequestration of available funds.

Throughout the year, small business events were held for owners interested in contracting opportunities with NAS LLC. These events will continue throughout 2017.

"We recognize the value that a diverse supply chain system brings to our business," Dave Porter, acquisitions manager for NAS, says in a press release. "We want to maximize opportunities for small businesses in the region. They will be partners in our success."

AEDC is a big draw for employment in Manchester and Middle Tennessee as a whole. Last year, 2,266 people were employed by the base, with direct payments on local wages for base employees exceeding \$244 million. Additionally, \$100 million was paid out to more than 4,000 retired Tennesseans in 2015.



Manchester harnesses the impact

Tennessee's tourism sector had already experienced a blockbuster 2015, and 2016 was no different for the state and—by extension—its rural communities like Manchester. Direct expenditures by tourists in Tennessee exceeded an all-time high of \$18.4 billion in 2015, and this trend only looks to grow as the economy improves, various civic groups tap into the hunger for a strong community, and the country as a whole continues to turn inward to places like Tennessee for affordable vacations and a quality lifestyle.

Coffee County ranked 21 out of 95 in the state for travel receipts in 2015 with a healthy 4.7 percent growth in tourism dollars spent locally, according to a Tennessee Department of Tourist Development report released in August 2016.

According to Alderman Ryan French, current tax collection reports for Manchester are up 10 percent quarter after quarter, with the city on track to break \$9 million in collections in 2016.

"All of our efforts are focused on impact—how can we drive dollars into local eateries, shops, venues, attractions, and hotels? Every stop for lunch, every tank of gas and every hotel stay adds up to big bucks for our community," he says.

Much of the city's revenue comes from tourism dollars with hotels, restaurants and special events in particular driving people to stay in the area.

The Manchester Tourism Commission, building on its successful implementation of the grant funding to revitalize the historic downtown in 2012, embarked upon a threephase, five-year strategy designed to focus on strengthening some core metrics required for success of a small town. Much of this effort is tailored to increase and capitalize on regional tourism through events, business engagement, and improving



of a rise in state-wide tourism.

the city's forward-facing reputation and marketing campaigns to reinvigorate the community. According to the numbers and scheduled events, these efforts seem to be paying off.

Over the last three years, according to French, the Tourism Commission has recruited and scheduled 14 youth basketball tournaments, with seven of those events scheduled for spring 2017. This translates into more economic activity and, in turn, larger cash flow to reinvest back into the community.

The vision for the future is driven in large part by continued and ongoing communication with area attractions and regional players.

"Our primary focus with attractions will be to continue our relationship-building efforts. How can we be an asset for attractions, venues, destinations, and even other communities?" French poses. "Tourism for Coffee County is very much a regional effort. We absorb impact from Jack Daniel's, George Dickel, Old Stone Fort, Beechcraft Heritage Museum,

the South Jackson Civic Center, the Manchester Coffee County Conference Center, Beans Creek Winery, Mountain Goat Trails, Tims Ford Lake, Cumberland Caverns and so much more. The better our relationships are with these entities, the better communications we will have and the more consistent our collective efforts, the more impact we can have."

GOING

A growing grassroots effort continues to shake up and improve—downtown Manchester's commercial district.

Ellen Briggs Fletcher was always a lover of preservation. Raised in an early 1900s home near the square in Manchester, she left town to pursue a bachelor's degree in agriculture education from Middle Tennessee State University, then promptly returned to her roots, eventually bearing two children and marrying a traveling musician who also hailed from Manchester.

Before her youngest, now almost 3, was born, Ellen began to get antsy. She saw a need for a space in Manchester where farmers and makers alike could come together and sell their wares and, in 2012, launched The Community Market, which invites local vendors to set up booths on the courthouse lawn every Saturday from May through October. In the past, Fletcher has only charged vendors \$5\$ to participate, running the market for the good of the city, not for personal or financial gain.

But that was just the beginning.

Like any budding social entrepreneur, Fletcher wanted to scale her efforts—and over time, she pieced together just the group to do that. In May of last year,

Fletcher teamed up with Allison Jarrell Dotson, owner of High Cotton Vintage Home Furnishings, to continue the beautification of the courthouse square by raising funds for landscaping. The result was Panbalou, a well attended pancake and bluegrass breakfast that brought in nearly \$4,000.

"Overall, it was such a success. Renee Holt at the Mercantile did the food and beverages, and we had tables set up all over the streets around the square," Fletcher recalls, adding that a second Panbalou is slated for the same time this year. "That kind of got the ball rolling [for the Downtown Movement]."

Thanks to Fletcher and Dotson's activism, a first phase of landscaping is currently in the works—an \$11,000 effort in partnership with the tourism commission that includes all planting and mulching of city property around the square and is scheduled for completion this spring— and the women have plans for more fundraisers to support additional phases.

Over the summer, Fletcher also became chummy with John Mancini, a California native who has lived in Manchester since 1999 and had just opened a restaurant, West Main Brick Oven, on the square. She immediately drew Mancini into her circle of change-makers, and he'd prove to be an important catalyst she needed to grow the downtown market.

"John's energy is insane. It's inspiring," Fletcher says. "He wanted to invest because he sees the big picture, and instead of just becoming a market vendor, he went one step further by buying us some radio promotion."

On the way to McMinnville to do their radio spot, Mancini suggested Fletcher make their advertisement more about an event than just the market itself. The result was Market Mayhem, which may have been planned on the fly as a way to get listeners excited to come out to the market, but turned out to be a very successful event in August: a vibrant street fair with live music, games and contests, face-painting and balloon animals, a dunking booth of local politicians and firemen, food and more.

Very quickly, Mancini and Fletcher—along with Dotson, Holt and her husband, Jeff—saw what an impact these free local events were having on the community morale and vowed to make them a regular occurrence. Up next was La Bella

Serata ("The Beautiful Evening"), an art walk in September that wove its way through the shops in the historic district and brought out more than 500 locals who wanted to see exactly what this square evolution is all about.

Meanwhile, the city also was chosen as a recipient of a Tennessee Downtown grant, one of 12 communities selected to participate in the fifth round since the program's inception in 2010. Affiliated with the Tennessee Main Street program, the community improvement initiative targets towns throughout the state who aim to revitalize their commercial districts. and each member is awarded with a \$15,000 grant to complete a downtown improvement project after finishing Main Street Four-Point Approach training. Being chosen to participate in the Tennessee Downtown project likely will also open Manchester up for more grants and funding opportunities down the road.

"Iknow for a fact within four or five years, we'll have \$200,000 to \$300,000 worth of grants coming in," Mancini says. "This is the perfect town for it. Rutherford County and all of Nashville and Murfreesboro are

expanding this way. We're right on the interstate. We have Bonnaroo. The idea is to co-op everyone in the town to work on it together."

A steering committee headed up by Roger Guess was established to help direct the funds, and last fall four of its members—Mancini, Fletcher, Steve West, owner of the new Church @117 event venue on the square, and Terri Hudson, executive director of the Manchester Area Chamber of Commerce—attended a workshop up in Gallatin to learn how to best utilize the money and market a downtown movement to create community interest.

"That meeting was very cool because we got to really see the vision of what's possible. Gallatin's square is beautiful compared to what it was 20 years ago, and that's going to be us in 10 years," Mancini says. "To me, the vision for the downtown is really the vision for the whole town, but I think revitalizing the downtown is where it all starts."

He adds that over the next five years, the committee hopes to see all the facades on the square completely redone, the landscaping completed including the addition of hanging baskets, and the beginning of implementing a plan to spread throughout the rest of the historic district beyond just the square.

"The cool thing about the Main Street and Downtown programs is that they're really economic development programs for your town. Sure, it makes it pretty, gives you a much better look, but all that is just to generate business," he explains. "And it's a win-win because it generates tax dollars. Any town that gets involved has a huge tax increase—it's success after success all around the state. I think we can get at least the square area looking like Gallatin or even Franklin, and I can't see why any of the business owners would have a problem with that."

For 2017, the Downtown Movement has plenty of events on the horizon "to get people used to coming to the square," Mancini says, like the return of the Music Tree Festival and a big barbeque festival to precede Bonnaroo in June—all of which are broadcast on the group's Facebook page (www. facebook.com/DowntownManchester)—and at the moment its heavy hitters also are focused on engaging the community and igniting a similar passion as they have developed themselves.

"Change takes a lot of people. It takes cooperation. It takes working together," Fletcher says. "The reason I do these things is for the betterment of the future. When I think about the future, I think about my kids. When I was a senior in high school, I thought: 'I am getting out of here and I'm never coming back.' That's a horrible thought. I want my kids to grow up wanting to stay here—or at least move back home eventually—and to realize what a great place it is.



OLD STONE FORT STATE PARK

The Old Stone Fort is a 2000 year-old American Indian ceremonial site. It consists of mounds and walls that combine with cliffs and rivers to form an enclosure measuring 1-1/4 miles around. The 50-acre hilltop enclosure mound site is believed to have served as a central ceremonial gathering place for some 500 years. It has been identified as, perhaps, the most spectacularly sited sacred area of its period in the United States and the largest and most complex hilltop enclosure in the south. Settlers tended to name such enclosures "forts."

At the narrow neck of land between the two rivers there is a set of parallel mound walls oriented to within one degree of the summer solstice sunrise. It was typical of ancient societies to recognize this significant farthest north sunrise and to hold reenactments of creation myths at such times. Mound sites such as the 50-acre Old Stone Fort provided

modified landscapes for ceremonies that may have represented in some way the culture's concept of their place in the cosmos and a separation of the sacred and mundane or pure and impure.

This State Archaeological Park is dedicated to the preservation, protection, study and interpretation to the public of this significant survival of ancient culture. The park offers educational and entertaining which increase programs, understanding of the Old Stone Fort, archaeology, and Native American cultures. The museum includes exhibits that orientate the visitor to the Old Stone Fort and its setting, the hilltop enclosure mound site's broader significance and the culture of its builders.

The 876-acre park also offers a variety of activities including fishing, camping and hiking.

AREA LAKES

There are 3 Area Lakes Within Minutes of Manchester: Tims Ford Lake, Normandy Reservoir and Woods Reservoir.

Tims Ford was impounded in 1970 when the Tennessee Valley Authority built a hydro-electric dam across the Elk River. The 10,700-acre lake is one of the most picturesque in

Tennessee and is regarded as one of the top bass fishing and recreational lakes in the Southeast. The lakes deep clear water has made it famous for those in search of smallmouth bass. In addition the lake hosts excellent populations of largemouth bass, Kentucky bass, Rockfish, hybrids, crappie and catfish.

Normandy Lake was impounded in 1976. The lake offers a number of public boat ramps, and campgrounds. Not only does Normandy Lake provide countless hours of on the water recreation in addition it provides the water supply for Manchester and surrounding areas.

Normandy Lake covering 3,160 acres offers anglers superb fishing opportunities. The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency and the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Agency regularly stock rainbow trout in the Duck River below Normandy Dam. The lake boasts sizable populations of largemouth bass, smallmouth bass and is one of the top spots to tangle with the feisty Kentucky bass. In recent years thanks to a very successful stocking program by the TWRA walleye have taken the spotlight from late spring through summer as

a preferred quarry by many anglers. Crappie anglers fish the lake year round.

Some areas around the lake have been designated as wildlife refuges by the Tennessee Valley Authority. These are public use areas that attract deer, turkey and small game hunters. Consult any Normandy Lake map to locate these special areas. Fishing and hunting aside the lake offers remarkable scenery, abundant wildlife, miles of uninhabited shoreline and billowing waterfalls.

Woods Reservoir was the only recreational lake in the area for decades. Impounded in 1952 by the Air Force as a water supply for Arnold Air Force base the lake soon became Middle Tennessee's favorite outdoors recreation site.

Woods Reservoir could be described as two lakes in one. The lower end below Morris Ferry Bridge on Highway 127 is open with sharp points that drop off into the river channel. The area above

the bridge is very similar to many river run lakes. Here Woods Reservoir narrows. Boaters discover that once out of the main channel the lake exhibits large flats and shallow coves with an abundance of cane grass. The tiny 4,000 acre lake is considered one of the best crappie lakes in the south offering year around activity. Bass anglers find an abundance of both largemouth and smallmouth bass. Another favorite quarry for visiting anglers is catfish. The lake is loaded with them.

The lake is very popular with duck hunters also. During duck season the lake is off limits to anglers in some sections on certain days of the week. The lower end near the dam is a designated wildlife reserve area which is closed to all boat traffic several weeks each winter. Check the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency Hunting Guide for details. Both hunting and fishing guides are available at area license dealers and on the web at www.state.tn.us/twra.
