A story I loved came to light several years ago when it appeared in Parade Magazine. It revolves around a class of 59 sixth-graders in East Harlem in 1981. These were "at risk" youngsters most of whom would drop out of school before graduation. If that were not bad enough, many would also likely turn to drugs and crime if they followed in the same path as those before them.

But was there a way to turn this trend around? In this case there was! It came through a promise made by a selfmade millionaire named, Eugene Lang. Mr. Lang was given

an invitation to speak to this class to see if he could inspire them to stay in school and make something of themselves. As he pondered what he might say he decided to make them a proposal. He told the class if they would stay in school and graduate, he would send them to college.

His words made a positive impact on these young people. Would you believe that nearly 90% of that class graduated from high school? One of the students who took him up on his offer was later quoted to say, "I had something to look forward to, something waiting for me. It was a golden feeling."

We never know what a word or act of encouragement might mean to someone and this story is just one of countless others that prove it. But the need for encouragement is not limited to a few; we all need it! And this is just as true in our spiritual lives as anything else.

God knows how important encouragement is to us and He sees that we receive it in a couple of ways. First, He gives us encouragement through His Word. Here are just a couple of examples. Paul wrote, "Let us not grow weary in while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart" (Galatians 6:9). He also described the "crown of righteousness" that awaits all the faithful when this life comes to an end (2 Timothy 4:7, 8). It is truly "a golden feeling" to know that there is a heavenly reward waiting on us!

Secondly, God expects us to encourage each other. Note these words: "Exhort [encourage] one another daily, while it is called 'Today,' lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin" (Hebrews 3:13).







In Alabama it is perfectly legal to record someone without their knowledge as long as one party to the conversation consents. So yes, you can record her.

Good divorce attorneys are

expensive. I realize that a lot of people if not most people live paycheck to paycheck and can't afford to write a check for \$5000 as a retainer for a really good divorce lawyer. Even if you hire someone young and inexperienced (as all lawyers were at one time) a good client that understands the issues and obtains important evidence can help make even the newest lawyer a much more effective lawyer.

Clients in a divorce know the issues and but tend to focus on the bad behavior of the other party. Courts refrain from really rewarding good versus bad behavior although someone's conduct in leading to a divorce is very important. Judges get tired of hearing about bad behavior.

What most people don't know to do is to keep really good records and obtain really good evidence. For instance, if you record your wife being abusive towards your children, you will need to make a note either on the recording or on a separate writing when the recording was made or it may not be admissible (the judge may not get to hear it).

One of the most effective pieces of evidence is a calendar with two inch squares and notes made on each day about who kept the children, where the other spouse was and what was important about that day in relation to the divorce. It is very powerful to make a calendar where the days the mother kept the children are in pink and the days where the father kept the children in blue. In days of transition, draw a line through the day and make a note of who kept the children and

If grandparents can be involved in caring for the children or other relatives such as aunts and uncles can be involved then notes of their involvement are important. Obviously, the person who shoulders the burden for school work, doctors' appointments, dental appointments, Sunday school and generally caring for the children should be the person who primarily cares for the children after the divorce. A well kept calendar gives the judge information that he or she needs to make a final decision if the parties are unable to agree.

I wish you the best of luck in this situation and keep your focus on helping your children through this difficult time.

#### **Medicare Minute**

#### "Frequently Asked Questions 3"

Many times, a person who is going on Medicare for the first time will come into our office with the understanding that Medicare will cover any and all medical procedures they have performed. Today's FAQs will address some items, services and procedures Medicare does not cover.

Does Medicare cover all medical procedures? Medicare doesn't cover everything. If you need a service that isn't covered under Medicare Part A or Part B you will have to pay for it yourself unless it's covered by a supplemental Medicare health plan or Medicaid. The phrase that Medicare uses is "medically necessary". If you have a procedure performed that is elective and not "medically necessary there is a good chance it will not be covered by Medicare. It is always a good idea to check with your healthcare provider before you have a procedure performed to assure that it is covered by Medicare.

What are some examples of items and services not covered by Medicare? Some items and services not covered by Medicare are: Long-term custodial care, most dental care, eye examinations related to prescribing glasses, dentures, cosmetic surgery, acupuncture, hearing aids and exams for fitting them and routine foot care. Also, most prescription drugs are not covered by Medicare.

Will Medicare cover me outside the U.S.? Medicare generally doesn't cover healthcare while you're traveling outside the U.S. There are, however, rare exceptions when Medicare will cover you outside the U.S. You can find these exceptions in your Medicare and You Handbook or by going to Medicare.gov. In these rare cases Medicare, may pay for ambulance transportation to a foreign hospital only with admission for medically necessary covered inpatient hospital services. You pay 20% of the Medicare approved amount, and the Part B deductibles apply.

#### **Lions Begins** Season at #1

LOUISVILLE, KY. - The UNA softball team is fresh off the preseason pick as Gulf South Conference champion as reported in last week's issue. The team is now looked upon with still greater expectations.

Following a historic run that culminated in the program's first national championship, the Lions were unanimously voted the No. 1 team in the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division II Top 25 Preseason Coaches' Poll.

UNA collected all 16 first-place votes, totaling 400 points to open the season atop the rankings. The Lions return 12 lettermen. This includes their top two pitchers from last year's squad that went 60-7 and broke multiple records at the single-game and single-season levels.

Humboldt State was last season's national runnerup and was voted No. 2 after garnering 384 points. Armstrong State, West Texas A&M, and Southern Arkansas round out the preseason top five.

Fellow Gulf South Conference teams are in the poll, Valdosta State (No. 13) and UAH (No. 23).

After receiving a handful of votes, but no ranking in the 2016 preseason poll, UNA entered the rankings at No. 8 on February 24. The Lions were ranked in the next eleven consecutive polls, climbing as high s No. 3 before reaching the Division II Women's College World Series. UNA went 5-1 at that event, defeating Humboldt State 4-1 in the final game to claim the title and earn the No. 1 ranking in the final NFCA poll of the season.

#### Miracle Worker a Top 20 Event

# **House Calls** with Dr. Barco

#### Can I Use Nose Strips Instead of **CPAP For My Sleep Apnea?**

common condition where the muscles and tissues around the area of your throat close off air from entering your lungs when you are asleep. As a result, people will often snore and even stop breathing for periods of time in their sleep. This causes folks to not have the restful sleep at night that they need and develop fatigue and sleepiness during the day. In addition, having sleep apnea puts you at risk for many conditions, including high blood pressure, atrial fibrillation and congestive heart failure. This is in part because your oxygen levels can drop when you stop breathing at night, which in turn strains your heart. If you suddenly wake up in the middle of the night feeling short of breath, it might be because your oxygen level is dropping from sleep apnea. The strain in your heart also releases a substance called ANP from the heart muscle, which in turn causes someone to urinate. So if you notice having to get up multiple times a night to go to the bathroom, you may not have sugar or prostate problems, it may in fact be that you have sleep apnea. The most common therapy used for sleep apnea is CPAP, which keeps your airway open by blowing in air at set pressures. Because some patients are uncomfortable using CPAP, they often ask about other treatments for sleep apnea. Many feel that because external nose strips like Breathe Right improve snoring, it is also treating their sleep apnea.

This question was actually researched last year by Dr. Clete Kushida and his group, where they looked at all the research studies involving nose strips and how they affect sleep apnea (reference 1). They found that nose strips did not significantly decrease how severe a person's sleep apnea was, nor did it provide people with more restful sleep

Sleep apnea is a very (which we call REM sleep). The nose strips also didn't have a major effect on how low someone's oxygen level got from their sleep apnea. Therefore, nose strips do not appear to be a good option for treating sleep apnea. That's not to say that they may not help at all. For example, there's a study that suggests that if you wear nose strips while getting CPAP therapy, that you do not require as much pressure from the CPAP device (reference 2). Not needing as much pressure makes the CPAP much more comfortable for patients. I encourage people that are having trouble with CPAP to speak to either their lung doctor or their primary care provider to discuss their options.





newspaper to print some of the "secret" parts of the TPP in 2013. The Post observed that after nearly a decade of negotiation and 19 secret meetings, the TPP had become a regional government document of a hefty 5,600 pages. "Which when finished, will govern 40% of U.S. imports and exports" and "26% of the world's trade." It will be the law of the land for the United States and 11 other countries in the Asia-Pacific region—without the input of a single member of Congress. This in violation of Article I, Section I of the U.S. Constitution that mandates that all legislative powers reside in the House and Senate and in no other body. In fact, until 2015 members of Congress had not been allowed to even the treaty whereas privileged corporations had no problem with access.

The paper continued, "The treaty has 29 chapters, dealing with everything from financial services to telecommunications to sanitary standards for food," demonstrating the wide variety of areas believed to be affected by it. But again, it is the secretive nature of it that is most offensive. Apparently TPP participants signed a confidentiality agreement

requiring them to share proposals only with 'government officials and individuals who are part of the government's domestic trade advisory process. That excluded you, the media, Congress, and me.

The Post acknowledged the agreement encompasses a broad range of regulatory and legal issues, making them a much more central part of foreign policy and even domestic lawmaking. Sure is curious. The Constitution requires the approval of your two U. S. Senators and your House member for every regulation upon you. There exists no language in the Constitution that other individual or body—especially an international body—can perform this function. Additionally, international law should not affect domestic lawmaking. You have the right to know that these three have read every rule emanating from the federal government upon you. The admission that the TPP will influence foreign policy is interesting as only the U.S. Senate may influence foreign policy as per Article II, Section Giving a more central part of foreign policy to an international agency would have virtually voided the

Constitution in this area. The Post identified 60 senators who have asked for the final agreement address currency manipulation. Senators Elizabeth Warren and Ron Wyden, both Democrats, been have been especially vocal about the Obama Administration's refusal to make draft text available. Wikileaks published the chapter on intellectual property raising many questions about copyright protections. Obviously this treaty, while billed as just a trade agreement, included music, film, books, the Internet, and appeared to restrict everything in the

that tell the untold stories of the accomplishments of black people in America, I am pleased because we are learning. Some of the stories are new to me such as the story of the women "Hidden Figures". Extraordinary. Some stories, such as Jesse Owens and Jackie Robinson, we know because these are widely known events. Some of the events in the history of African-Americans, I know because I came to a point of deep study in my collegiate years when I was deciding who I was and how I was going to be. But a great deal of what I know about the experiences of being black during the time of change comes from being there. My grandmother was "The Help" and I am the product of "The Dream". My thought is that everybody in my generation was a "first".

My oldest sister was the first in my family to graduate from college. She attended an all-black school through eighth grade. In the newly integrated school, she and my uncle were covaledictorians. After that she was number one in her class at a HBCU. She got her Master's degree from Ohio State in Community Mental Health Nursing. She orally defended her Masters comps because of her lack of nursing experience. She successfully defended her answers and graduated Cum Laude. She earned full scholarships all the way. She recently retired as the Nursing Administrator of a VA hospital after 35 years

of service. My middle sister was the first black cheerleader at our high school. She was captain her senior year. I wanted to be her. Then she to attended a HBCU and was a cheerleader there. She went on to coach that college squad for 17 years. For her coaching, she was inducted into that college's Hall of Fame. She's got young women all over the US who Manager in manufacturing, overseeing 200 people and a \$15 million budget. She now is a Capability Specialist managing the hiring and training of hundreds of workers.

My brother was the first fully scholarshipped black pitcher at the University of Tennessee at Knoxville. He had a great pitching career there and in 1979 was drafted in the third round by the Cincinnati Reds. He

As I watch all of the opted not to go pro. Killed new movies coming out me. I had invested my life to his baseball since I was six. He didn't want to live out of a suitcase. He wanted to be a family man. So he coached. He now has his Tennessee Varsity ring, a North Carolina High School basketball and baseball state championship ring and a national High School basketball championship ring from when he coached in Bermuda. He has been the Athletic Director at our local hometown college where he has been the Minority Recruiter for years. He is reverently called "Coach" by hundreds of successful young people.

And then there was me. I

was the second black person to go from first grade to 12th grade in the newly integrated schools of my hometown. My aunt who was a year older than me, was the first. Our families were among the first to opt-in. I was the first black person in our town to qualify for the gifted education program, which was huge. I became close friends with white girls. triends with white girls. I also was the first black student body president in a high school with a 1:7 black to white student ratio. The yearbook was dedicated to me. I accepted a full scholarship to Tennessee, where I met my wonderful husband. And the rest you have been reading about for

a while.

But there were a lot of families like mine with 'first" stories. It was a time of first opportunities. But we weren't the first. Madam C.J. Walker, the first female millionaire in the US, was a black woman who created black hair care products in the early 1900s. Thomas Jennings, a black man, was granted a patent for a dry cleaning machine in 1821. Chemotherapy was developed by a black woman, Dr. Jane C Wright, and her father, Dr. Lewis T Wright in the 1940s. It is good that these stories and facts are being shared call her "Mama". She is has because the more we learn been a Senior Department the less we fear and respect can grow. Interestingly. saw "Hidden Figures" with my friends, seven white women. When we left the movie there was not much to say. We got it. We already had it - understanding and respect for each other and for history. Love. That's what it's going to take. Be first to share that.

# News & Tips on the Shoals Market



#### **Organizing - Start Small**

You've probably figured out by now that decluttering and organization is a favorite topic of mine. It's not that I am a super-organized person in all aspects of life. It is simply that de-cluttering and organizing is most people's main concern when getting ready to list their house. And if it's not their concern, most of the time it should be. Many people just don't know where to start. Fortunately, organizing seems to be almost addictive. Once you've started somewhere and seen the results of your hard work, you want to see more progress and have the confidence to tackle larger projects. The important thing is to just get started.

Most experts say to start small. Choose a small, selfcontained area that can be done in a few hours, max. This area should be one that you use on a regular basis, so you can appreciate the results. For instance, the linen closet. Most homes have a space dedicated for extra towels, blankets, sheets, etc. If not, an armoire or other freestanding piece can stand in.

First, as with all other organizing projects, completely empty the space. Have a bin handy for things to donate, and a large trash can for trash.
