

Warm Up With Baked Black Bean Dip

A good appetizer brings everyone together whether you've just come in out of the chill from an afternoon of sledding or you're gathering around the TV for a raucous Super Bowl party.

This Baked Black Bean dip definitely fits the bill. It's a crowd favorite every time I serve it at home or when I bring it with a bag of tortilla chips to a potluck. It's both chunky and creamy, with a yummy chipotle flavor that keeps you dipping for more.

BAKED BLACK BEAN DIP

Serves 12

large onion, diced

1. Heat oven to 400 F. Grease a 1-1/2 quart baking dish. (I use a souffle-style baking dish.)

2. Heat oil in a 12-inch skillet over medium high heat. Add onion, reduce heat to medium and season with salt. Cook, stirring occasionally, until the onions are soft, about 4 minutes.

3. Add garlic, chili powder and pepper; stir and cook one minute.

4. Loosely chop the chipotle chilies in adobo. Add to the skillet along with 3 tablespoons adobo sauce, one can of black beans and the water. Bring to a boil and simmer four minutes, stirring occasionally.

> 5. Transfer to a mixing bowl. Add vinegar. Use an immersion blender to process mixture until smooth. (Or, use a food processor and transfer to mixing bowl.)

6. Add the second can of drained beans, tomatoes, corn and grated Mexican style cheese. Stir well. Transfer to baking dish. Sprinkle grated Monterey Jack cheese on top. 7. Bake 15-20 min-

utes or until bubbly and cheese melts.

8. Top with cilantro. Serve warm with tortilla chips for scooping.

Tip: Freeze leftovers. Thaw and reheat with a fresh sprinkling of cheese on top.







Eight Hot Tips For Battery Care

(NAPSA)—More automobile batteries fail in the heat than in the extreme cold, and hot-weather conditions can cause more stress on a pattery than frigid temperatures With temperatures at their annual highs, motorists can protect and care for that part of the vehicle a driver depends on most every day.

Battery temperatures under the hood of an automobile can reach 175 to 200 degrees in extreme conditions, affecting the corrosion factor within the battery. The extreme heat can make the acid and the fluid inside the battery expand, which can cause it to start leaking, and that leads to battery failure in the long run. It's important for motorists to take the necessary precaution of getting their vehicle battery checked on a regular basis, especially before taking off on family

it's time to replace the case 3. Clean the connections by removing any corrosion, lead oxidation, paint or rust from the top of the battery with a scouring pad or brass brush. Make sure to brush the corrosion away from the

4. If the battery has removable filler caps, open the caps and check the water level in each cell.

5. Make sure the plates are at least half covered. This prevents sulfation and reduces the possibility of an internal battery explosion.

6. If the water level is low, add distilled water (avoid tap water) until the plates are covered.
7. Avoid overfilling, especially

in hot weather, because the heat can cause the solution inside to expand and overflow.

8. Have the battery and electrical system professionally tested every three to six months, especially before heading out on a trip.





Is Your Pet Ready for Air Travel?

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I just read the letter from a reader who's been asked to return a cat to its original owner. I hope that if they send the cat back, they don't send it by air! Animals are put in the airplane's baggage compartment, which is not heated. I recently was on a plane with a seat display showing the outside temperature as 70 below zero. — Sarah S., via email

DEAR SARAH: I'll probably hear otherwise from a few readers, but transporting pets on aircraft is fairly safe, and they are not exposed to sub-zero temperatures while in the cargo hold. Of course, we've all heard about pets that were injured or died while being transported, so I looked into this claim.

According to Pets Express, one of several companies that specialize in transporting animals via commercial aircraft, "Air travel is as safe for pets as it is for people. Your pet will travel in a special cargo compartment [which is] both climate controlled and pressurized for your pet's safety and comfort. It is on the same air circulation system as the cabin.

That said, traveling as cargo is not for every dog and cat. Pets that are elderly, easily stressed or have existing medical conditions can be at risk of developing health problems or even dying during transport. Many airlines prohibit certain breeds - particularly brachycephalic animals that have restricted breathing such as Bulldogs or Chow Chows, and even Burmese cats.

Over the past decade, many if not all U.S. airlines have allowed smaller pets and service animals to travel in the cabin with their owners. There's usually a \$100-\$200 fee, and pets must be transported in a sturdy carrier that fits under the seat.
