





Dear Mount Morris Residents,

As Supervisor, I am asked daily"What exactly does our Town do?"So I would like to briefly let each of you know what your Town IS doing each and every day.

The Town is responsible for a variety of services, including roads, public safety (fire and ambulance), courts, assessment, sanitation (recycling), and recreation. As your Supervisor, I make sure that these are delivered in a cost effective and positive manner to you, the taxpayer.

The biggest challenge continues to be the maintenance and repair of the 54.22 sq. miles of town highways, bridges, and our 7 cemeteries (abandoned as well as operating). Our highway department also is responsible for the removal of snow and brush. As you can imagine this accounts for the majority of the yearly budget.

Our Town Court includes 2 justices and a clerk. This area has responsibility in criminal and civil matters as well as the handling and reporting of fines. It is closely governed by rules and regulations and the Town is responsible to see that its operation works according to these state guidelines.

While the Mount Morris Fire Department and its capable members undertake fighting and preventing fires, the Town is responsible for fire protection on a fiscal basis and must enter into a contract to provide this service to the community. As a result of this contract, the Town levies taxes to pay for this protection.

In order to provide the basis for taxation the Town must appoint an assessor of real property as well as a Board of Assessment to hear concerns on grievance day. An experienced assessor and board of review currently serve the Town.

Recycling also is a Town function and continues to offer you services of waste disposal conveniently and economically. This service covers all residents, both Town and Village, as do all of the areas that fall under the Town's municipal umbrella.

Ambulance service is another area of responsibility that the Town has. Since becoming Supervisor, this has been a top priority and I am proud of the progress we have made. Averaging over 1200 calls a year, providing certified personnel, steamlining billing practices, and updating our equipment are just a few of our accomplishments.

The Town has a Comprehensive Plan that sets forth the goals of our community. I am constantly reviewing these goals, which are designed to better our Town. Zoning, Planning and Code Enforcement help the Town to achieve these things on a fair and consistent basis. At this time, the Town is working with funding from two grants to update the Comp Plan, and we are continuously seeking grant opportunities to help us meet our long-term goals.

Special Districts may be established by the Town to serve such needs as water. The Town is presently continuing work on expansion of its current water districts. Fire, lighting, even sidewalks can be governed by the Town if it establishes such districts. The Board and myself are constantly reviewing this.

Personally, as Supervisor, the most demanding part of my job is that of chief fiscal officer. "Watching your money" is a full time job in itself and I take these duties very seriously. I am always open to your input on ways to cut costs and improve services.

At the County level I represent the Town on a much larger scale. I work to insure that tax dollars, grant money, highway appropriations, as well as emergency resources are provided to you at the highest level of efficiency.

In closing, I would like to again extend to you an invitation to stop in and let me know what areas in our community need attention and how best to achieve these goals. I am honored to continue to serve you as Supervisor. The door is always "open".




