**ROASTED SALMON WITH POMEGRANATE BUTTER SAUCE**

The pomegranate butter sauce is a red variation of the classic French "beurre blanc," which literally translated means "white butter." One important tip: Slowly incorporate the butter over very low heat so it softens into a creamy emulsion with the acidic base. If the heat is too high, the butter will simply melt.

- 1 (2-pound) center-cut salmon fillet, with skin
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- Pomegranate Butter Sauce:
  - 1/2 cup bottled pomegranate juice
  - 1/4 cup good-quality balsamic vinegar
  - 1/4 cup orange juice
  - 2 tablespoons honey
  - 2 tablespoons minced shallots
  - 1/2 teaspoon chopped fresh rosemary or 1/4 teaspoon crumbled dried rosemary
  - tablespoons (1 stick) unsalted butter, chilled, cut into 8 equal portions
  - 1 teaspoon salt
  - 1 teaspoon freshly ground pepper

- Heat oven to 400 F. Lightly oil a large, rimmed baking sheet.
- Run your fingers over the cut side of the salmon, feeling for any pin bones. If necessary, pull out bones with sterilized tweezers. Season salmon on both sides with the salt and pepper. Place the salmon on baking sheet, flesh side up. Cut the salmon vertically into 6 equal portions, but do not separate the pieces. (This makes the salmon easier to serve after cooking.)
- Roast until the salmon shows just a hint of bright pink when prodded in the center of the fillet at one of the cuts with the tip of a knife, 12 to 15 minutes.
- Meanwhile, make the butter sauce. Bring the pomegranate juice, balsamic vinegar, orange juice, honey, shallots, rosemary, salt and pepper to a boil in a non-reactive medium saucepan over high heat. Cook until liquid is reduced to 1/4 cup, about 8 minutes. Reduce heat to very low.
- Remove pan from heat and whisk in the tablespoon of butter. Whisk until the butter softens into a creamy texture, occasionally returning pan to the heat to keep it warm, but not hot. Repeat with the remaining butter, one tablespoon at a time. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Don't bother to try to keep the sauce piping hot; it will be heated by the warmth of the salmon.
- Remove skin and any fat from the salmon and discard. Serve the salmon on individual dinner plates, and spoon the sauce on top. Serve immediately. Makes 6 servings.

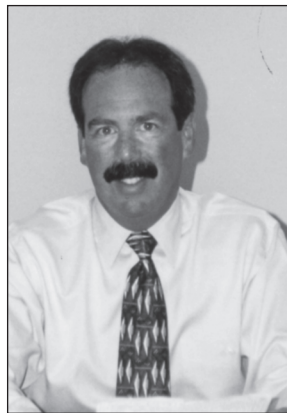

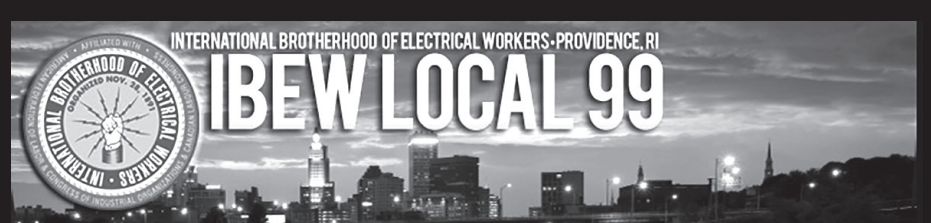

At 62, he's made 80 films and starred in four TV series: "Oz" (1997-2003), "Law & Order" (1997-2010), "The Closer" (2005-2012) and his own NBC series, "Growing Up Fisher" (2014), playing a blind man. He's also the TV spokesman for Farmers Insurance. Then along came "Whiplash," for which he won the best-supporting actor Oscar.

Now, in addition to Farmers Insurance commercials and the current releases of "La La Land" and "Patriot's Day," Simmons has seven films awaiting release in 2017: "Renegades," with **Sullivan Stapleton** (of "Blindspot") and **Charlie Bewley** (vampire Demetri in "The Twilight" saga), out Feb. 3; "All Nighter" (top billed), with **Emile Hirsch**, opening March 17; "The Snowman," with **Michael Fassbender**, out Oct. 13; "The Justice League," coming Nov. 17; and "The Bachelors" (top-billed), as well as "Bastards," with **Owen Wilson** and **Glenn Close**; and "I'm Not Here" (top-billed), with **Sebastian Stan** ("Captain America") and **Mandy Moore**. Simmons has been married for 20 years to **Michelle Schumacher** and has two children.

**Debbie Reynolds** (who died Dec. 28) was one of the last stars of The Golden Age of MGM musicals. "That's Entertainment" (1974) and the sequels "2" (1976) and "3" (1994) paid tribute to the glorious musicals of MGM. I knew her very well, and she was a handful, always wanting to run the show, but worth the trouble because she knew her stuff.

Debbie was only 19 when she starred with **Gene Kelly** and **Donald O'Connor** in the 1952 classic "Singin' in the Rain." Some of her other great films were: "The Tender Trap" (1955), with **Frank Sinatra**; "Tammy and the Bachelor" (1957); "The Rat Patrol" (1960), with **Tony Curtis**; and "The Unsinkable Molly Brown," which

earned her a best-actress Oscar nomination. "The Singing Nun" (1966) and "In and Out" (1997), with **Tom Selleck**, were two of her best later films. Her last film was playing **Liberace's** mother with **Michael Douglas** in HBO's "Behind the Candelabra."

The last remaining MGM musical film stars are **Arlene Dahl** (92), "Three Little Words" (1950); **Angela Lansbury** (91), "The Harvey Girls" and "Till the Clouds Roll By" (both in 1946); **Ann Blyth** (88), "Kismet" (1955); **Jane Powell** (87), "Seven Brides for Seven Brothers" (1954); **Leslie Caron** (86), "Lili" (1953) and "Gigi" (1958); and **Margaret O'Brien** (80), "Meet Me in St. Louis" (1944).

When I ran alongside Debbie's vintage convertible down Fifth Avenue enroute to the New York premiere of "The Unsinkable Molly Brown," I was touched when she said, "Take a rest, come sit with me in the car." When I told her I couldn't shoot her from there, she chided, "That's what I had in mind, the flashes are blinding me!"

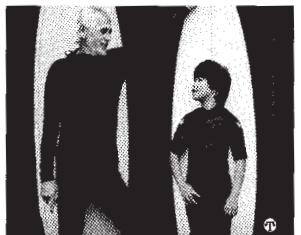

## Donna's Day Creative family fun

### Bake Valentine's Sugar Cookies

Make a special memory with preschoolers this winter ... bake cookies! If you didn't get around to cookie baking and decorating over the December holidays, Valentine's Day — with its hearts in all shapes and sizes — might be the perfect (and a more relaxing) time of year to get your hands in the dough.

This easy sugar cookie recipe uses powdered sugar rather than granulated sugar in the dough, producing a melt-in-your-mouth cookie. It's a family favorite whether we eat them plain or decorated with a few swirls of icing.

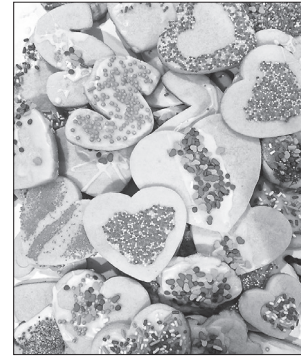
#### VALENTINE SUGAR COOKIES

- (Makes 5 dozen cookies)
- 1 cup unsalted butter, room temperature
  - 1 cup powdered sugar, plus more for rolling
  - 1 large egg
  - 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
  - 1 teaspoon almond extract
  - 2½ cups all-purpose flour
  - 1/2 teaspoon salt
  - Granulated sugar (optional)
  - Assorted candies, sprinkles or icing for decorating (optional)

1. Cream the butter in the bowl of an electric mixer. Add the powdered sugar and start the machine slowly; when the sugar has been incorporated, turn up speed and beat until light and fluffy. Blend in egg, vanilla and almond extract.
2. In another bowl, sift together the flour and salt; add it gradually to the batter. Mix on low until dough comes

together. Divide the dough in half, shape into flat disks, cover and chill at least 1 hour.

3. Heat oven to 375 F. Line baking sheets with parchment. Remove one dough disk from the refrigerator, roll out 1/8 inch thick on a board dusted with powdered sugar, and cut with a 2-1/2-inch heart-shaped cookie cutter. (If dough sticks to it, dip in flour, shake off excess, then cut dough). Place the hearts on prepared baking sheets. Repeat with second disk.
4. Sprinkle hearts with granulated sugar, if you wish.
5. Bake 8-10 minutes or until very light brown on edges. Cool on wire racks before serving or decorating.



Makes 5 dozen 2-1/2-inch heart-shaped cookies.

Tip for young bakers: Collect vintage cookie cutters with small handles on top to make it easier to cut dough.

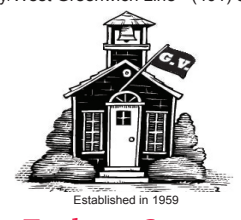

**Pointers For Parents**

**When Should Your Child Visit The Orthodontist?**

(NAPS)—While there's no "exact age" for a child to begin orthodontic treatment, there are a few things to consider.

Suggests Dr. DeWayne B. McCamish, president of the American Association of Orthodontists (AAO), "Somewhere between the seventh and eighth birthdays is generally when a child should visit an orthodontist. If a parent is concerned about something they observe, it's quite alright to bring in an even younger child.

"The orthodontist assesses the 'bite'—meaning how the teeth come together. There is a wealth of information we can gather just from watching how a child brings the teeth together. Some problems reveal themselves at an early age, and some of these problems can be addressed while a child still has some baby teeth."

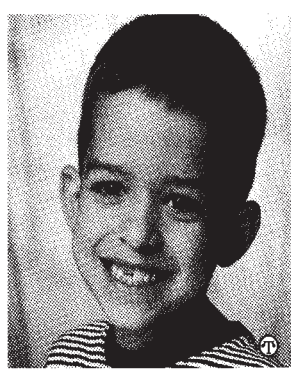
**What To Watch For**

- These signs suggest you should consult an orthodontist:
- Early or late loss of baby teeth;
- Difficulty in chewing or biting;
- Mouth breathing;
- Thumb sucking;
- Crowding, misplaced or blocked-out teeth;
- Jaws that shift or make sounds;
- Speech difficulties;
- Biting the cheek or tongue;
- Teeth that meet abnormally, or don't meet at all;
- Facial features that are out of proportion to each other;
- Jaws that are too far forward or too far back;
- Grinding or clenching the teeth.

Most children begin orthodontic treatment between the ages of 9 and 14.

**Benefits of Early Evaluation**

A check-up with an orthodontist while some baby teeth are still present can be beneficial for youngsters and their parents. "If we determine that treatment will be needed, an early check-up

allows the orthodontist to recommend the most appropriate treatment at the most appropriate time. We can also talk with parents about budgeting for treatment, based on their individual circumstances. Orthodontists routinely offer a variety of payment plans, and parents can look into benefits to reduce their out-of-pocket expenditures such as insurance, flexible spending accounts and health savings accounts," according to Dr. McCamish. Many AAO members offer low-cost or complimentary initial consultations and a referral to an orthodontist is not necessary.

Orthodontists first graduate from dental school, and then go on for an additional two-to-three academic years of study at an accredited orthodontic residency program to become orthodontists. 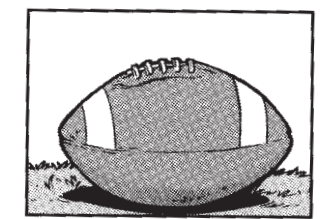
**DEAR KAREN:** Keep searching for Morris, and don't listen to your uncle, who is parroting an old observation that dates back to when cats were generally outdoor pets or working mousers.

Morris sounds like an indoor cat and could be in trouble if he's unfamiliar with the outdoors. Is he a regular escape artist, or is this his first time getting out? Here are a few things to do:

- Contact nearby animal shelters. Describe Morris' identifying features, such as color or stripes or any fur markings. Do this as quickly as possible, because many shelters euthanize strays after a set number of days have passed.
- Contact your veterinarian and any nearby vets to find out if Morris was brought in. If he is wearing a collar and ID tag, a kind stranger may bring him there.
- Search nearby woods and wild areas, calling Morris by name.
- Place a dish of cat food and water outside the door, on the chance that he is nearby and will get hungry.
- Post flyers throughout the neighborhood and around town with Morris' description, and a contact number or email.



THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Feb. 14, 278 A.D., Valentine, a priest in Rome, is executed for defying Emperor Claudius II and performing marriages in secret. Claudius believed that Roman men were unwilling to join his army because of their attachment to their families, and banned all marriages. Today, we celebrate Feb. 14 as Valentine's Day.
- On Feb. 13, 1633, Italian philosopher, astronomer and mathematician Galileo Galilei arrives in Rome to face charges of heresy for advocating that the Earth revolves around the Sun. Galileo remained under house arrest until his death in 1642.
- On Feb. 19, 1777, the Continental Congress votes to promote five men to major general, but overlooks Benedict Arnold, who felt slighted and threatened to resign. In 1780, Arnold became the most famous traitor in American history when he offered to hand over West Point to the British.
- On Feb. 16, 1894, gunslinger John Wesley Hardin is pardoned after spending 15 years in a Texas prison for murder. Hardin was reputed to have shot and killed a man just for snoring and had probably killed at least 40 people.
- On Feb. 17, 1904, Giacomo Puccini's opera "Madame Butterfly" premieres in Milan, Italy. The audience responded with hissing and yelling. Four months later, a reworked "Madame Butterfly" opened to applause, repeated encores and 10 curtain calls.
- On Feb. 15, 1965, a new Canadian national flag is raised in the capital of Ottawa. In 1964, the Canadian Parliament had voted to adopt a new design, a white background with a stylized 11-point red maple leaf in its center.
- On Feb. 18, 2001, NASCAR driver Dale Earnhardt Sr. dies at age of 49 in a last-lap crash at the Daytona 500. While vying for third place in his famous black No. 3 Chevrolet, Earnhardt collided with another car, then crashed into a wall.
