



Do Very Low Calorie Diets Work and Are They Safe?



According to NW-SCC advantage of two different Adult Education Director, Tara Branscome, the new nontraditional high school diplomaisalreadysparking a tremendous amount of interest in the community. "We are getting inquiries on the new diploma from our area schools and people throughout the community constantly," said Branscome. "I believe this is a great initiative by the state and can be a tremendous opportunity for so many people to make a better life for them and their family.

The new diploma was rolled out by the state at the end of 2016. The NW-Adult Education Department currently has 50 students actively seeking the diploma and has had thirteen students complete the new diploma requirements.

Students must be 17 years old to be eligible for the nontraditional diploma and must have attended

pathways to the new diploma. The diploma is available to students who earned all 24 credits but failed one or more portions of the high school exit exam, OR to students who earned at least ten credits, but not all 24. The steps for any student

interested in obtaining the nontraditional high school diploma are these: 1) Contact the Alabama igh school they last

attended,

Complete transcript request for the nontraditional diploma program, and

Notify the school they plan to pursue a nontraditional diploma. The school will then send an official transcript and transcript audit form to NW-SCC.



Medicare Minute

"Frequently Asked Questions 5"

Some of the most frequently asked questions we get from people under the age of 65 concerns the relationship between the Marketplace (Obamacare) and Medicare. There seems to be a great deal of confusion about how these two insurance programs work. Here are this week's

Will my Marketplace insurance end automatically when I become eligible at age 65 for Medicare? The short answer to this question is "no". You must go to healthcare.gov or contact your Marketplace insurance carrier to cancel your

Can I keep my Marketplace plan after I become eligible for Medicare? Yes, you can keep your Marketplace plan after becoming eligible for Medicare. This will not, however, exempt you from enrolling into Medicare Part A and Part B during your initial enrollment period. If you delay your enrollment into Part B, or Part A if you must pay a premium for it, you may be assessed a late enrollment penalty if you decide to sign up after the initial enrollment period.

I am receiving a tax credit to help pay for my Marketplace plan. Will I continue to receive this tax credit once I become Medicare eligible? This is a tricky one. Once your Medicare Part A coverage starts, you won't be eligible for a premium tax credit for a Marketplace plan. If you kept your Marketplace plan, you'd have to pay full price.

Can you give me an example of losing my tax credit? Let's say you are on a Marketplace plan that has a premium of \$1,100 per month. You have a tax credit of \$1,000 per month which means you would pay a monthly premium of \$100 per month for your plan. Once your Medicare Part A begins the \$1,000 tax credit goes away and you would have to pay the full premium of \$1,100 per month.



My insurance company told me they wouldn't pay anything for my mother's injuries because of the "guest statute". What are they talking about and why won't they pay for my mother's injuries when it was my

Ask the Attorney is sponsored by local attorneys, McCutcheon & Hamner, PC, as a service to the residents of NW Alabama.

This guest passenger statute came about as a result of insurance companies trying to not pay claims. The statute was purportedly enacted to protect drivers who picked up a hitchhiker from being sued by the hitchhiker if they had an accident and the hitchhiker was injured.

In 30 years of handling car wreck cases, I have never heard of or read about a case where a hitchhiker tried to sue a driver for having an accident

where they were injured.
The "Guest Passenger Statute" states as follows: "The owner, operator or person responsible for the operation of a motor vehicle shall not be liable for loss or damage arising from injuries to or death of a guest while being transported without payment thereof, unless such injuries or death are caused by the willful or wanton misconduct of such operator, owner, or person responsible for the operation of said motor

On February 3, 2017, the Supreme Court of Alabama rendered a decision in Hurst v. Sneed that addressed the Guest Passenger Statute. The Court restated the rule that if furnishing a ride promotes both the benefit of the rider and driver, or if the rider accompanies the driver at the request of the driver, for the purpose of having the rider render a benefit or service on a trip that is primarily for the objective of the driver then the rider is a passenger for hire and not a

The Supreme Court stated that at one end of the spectrum is the hitchhiker and at the other end is someone who pays the driver for transportation. A person who pays is not a guest. Between these two extremes you have to look at the present and former relationships between the driver and passenger, to bring into proper focus the true status of the parties at the time of the accident.

If the ride is to benefit both parties, they are probably a passenger. I think that carpooling where rides are swapped rather than gas money is outside of the guest statute. Minor children aren't subject to the guest statute as they have no right to decline the ride. So the question becomes, did your mother pay for gas, was she going to buy lunch, or did she help buy the car in exchange for you providing transportation? Be sure and talk to a lawyer before you talk to the insurance company.







Hall of Fame Inductees

There were ten inductees that went into the Lauderdale County Sports Hall of Fame in 2016. Arlee Snoddy came from Lauderdale County High School and Danny Hendrix represented Coffee High School. Snoddy was an all-everything performer for the Tigers. He started for the junior varsity as a sixth grader in 1941 and played for the varsity from 1942-1948.

He played quarterback, halfback and fullback and was a punter on the football team. One of his punts traveled 85 yards against Vina in 1947. Snoddy averaged nearly 50 yards per punt in his career. In basketball, he played forward and was a natural leader on the team.

He signed a football scholarship with Alabama, spending one year with the Crimson Tide before transferring to Florence State Teachers College. Lions head coach Hal Self called Snoddy "the best kicker he had ever seen." He went on to play semipro football in Huntsville.

In the 70's, wrestling was not offered at most area schools. But Danny Hendrix helped put Coffee High School's wrestling program on the Hendrix won a State Championship during his senior season in 1972-73. He produced a 20-1 season record during the year in the 105-pound class.

He was voted Most Outstanding Wrestler in the TVC tournament. Wrestler During his four-year career, Hendrix posted a 37-5 dual record and a 69-20 overall Hendrix was voted honorable mention All-American in 1973 by Scholastic Wrestling News magazine.



at justification that is not totally accurate.

The media is the same way. They have been used to dictating ground rules based on a sliding scale of which public official is at issue. If they object to a position, they fly into progressive justifications that often attach more emotion and comparisons than fact or merit.

The media is in full scale attack-mode on Trump.

It is fueling this insane impeachment` rhetoric, wanting to find fault with every aspect of Trump as President, as a U.S. citizen, and as a human being. To some the fact that he is even alive is a hateful, unconstitutional abuse of power.

The media's credibility was debatable long before came on the Trump scene. In large part, that questionable credibility questionable during the Obama years is what fueled Trump's path to the Oval Office. They never questioned Obama's blatant overstep of authority, his late-night signatures, all his failed challenges before the Supreme Court-including a few stunning 9-0 rebukes, his 100+ meetings with IRS officials while the agency openly targeting conservative groups, his searing hatred for Israel, his whereabouts the night of Benghazi, and so on.

We know Trump tends to be provocative and hyperbolic whenever possible. He loves the attention. And the media calls him on every point, giving him even more attention. But who calls them out? Other media outlets? Hardly ever, if at all.

Bogus left-leaning stories began surfacing the night of the election transgendered

with a barb or some effort committed suicide when faced with the election results. No bodies and no evidence ever surfaced.

• Hysteria ensued when a November 22 report in New York Magazine claimed that a group of prominent computer scientists and election lawyers had evidence that election results in Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, and Michigan could have been hacked. Even though the piece was found to be patently false, the mission was accomplished. The viral nature of social media carried it to millions, immediately discrediting Trump's election win in the minds of many.

• On the day of Trump's inauguration CNN claimed Nancy Sinatra was not happy that the President and first lady's inaugural dance would be to Frank Sinatra's, "My Way." Nancy Sinatra had never said anything. CNN later updated the article without explaining the mistake.

• Many major media outlets ran a story about Trump turning off his tape recorder when he spoke to Putin recently. It was a blatant lie. Buzzfeed was the organization that blew the whistle on that.

• *Time* reporter Zeke Miller wrote that a bust of Martin Luther King Jr. had been removed from the White House on inauguration day. However, Miller never asked anyone at the White House for confirmation. He just assumed it had been removed because he didn't see it. It had not been.

• A Fox affiliate in Detroit on January 31 reported, "A local business owner who flew to Iraq to bring his mother back home to the US for medical treatment said she was blocked from returning home under President Trump's ban on with a report that several immigration and travel teens from seven predominately

Muslim nations. He said that while she was waiting for approval to fly home, she died from an illness." The original article was published, shared, reshared and so on over a million times. However, the man had lied about when his mother died and the Fox affiliate never attempted to confirm or disprove the man's account. They just ran with it.

• On February 2, the Associated Press tweeted: "BREAKING: House votes to roll back Obama rule on background checks for gun ownership." That was retweeted initially 12,000 times. Major outlets ran with it further sensationalized as a lead story. However, all of it was a baseless quagmire that needlessly dragged in a frenzied host of mental health and civil rights organizations before it was debunked.

These and at least a dozen more have since been described as unconfirmed, over-hyped, or altered.

No, they were lies that were spread through social media and news avenues without confirmation or substantiation. Hysterics prevailed and opinions cemented misleading information.

We have entered a new realm with Trump where the national media is now at the precipice of complete intellectual dishonesty. In any other professional field, such gross negligence would lead to massive termination.

Celebrities and high profile athletes are hurling presidential insults like candy tossed on a parade route. So many of the major outlets like the New York Times, CNN, Time Magazine and others employ writers who live on social media and throw out distastefullypartisan distortions about Trump, his wife, or his intentions on their feeds. Those often mirror what appears on air, in print, and online as part of what is supposed to be fact-based

That said, Trump needs to put a lid on his Twitter

account for a while. He's not a kid killing time between classes. He also needs to work from factbased, specific figures when he is trying to make a point or establish a position.

The media meanwhile needs to accurately report what is happening in our world, not what is trending on social media. seem to admire European





How to Put the Brakes on Pet Car Sickness

With winter travel in high gear many of us plan on hitting the road with our pooches for a little winter fun. However, for some fourlegged family members, road trips can mean upset tummies.

Queasiness in the car is not just a human problem. Dogs and puppies do sometimes experience motion sickness on car Unfortunately, rides. car sickness can make any kind of pet travel a distressing ordeal for both dogs and their families.

Čar sickness doesn't have to be a serious or lasting problem for • your pet. With the right treatment, it can be mitigated, or even stopped altogether.

There are several causes of car sickness in dogs and puppies. The most common include:

IMMATURE EARS.

In puppies, the ear structures that regulate aren't fully balance developed, which can cause them to be extra sensitive motion to sickness. Many dogs will outgrow car sickness as they age.

STRESS.

If traveling in the car has only led to unpleasant experiences for your dog -- to vet exams, for example -- he may literally be worried sick about the journey.

SELF-CONDITIONING.

If your dog experienced nausea on his first car rides as a puppy, he may associate car rides with illness, and expect to get sick in the car.

Car sickness doesn't look like you might expect it to in dogs, and you might not even realize that this is the challenge you're • dealing with. Here are some symptoms to look

- Inactivity/lethargy
- Restlessness
- Excessive/repetitive yawning
- Whining/crying Hyper-salivation
- (drooling) Vomiting

If your dog is suffering from sickness, car symptoms will typically disappear within a few minutes after the car comes to a stop

Fortunately, there are a number of different methods available to help prevent and/or treat canine car sickness.

1. INCREASE ITS **COMFORT LEVEL**

Turn your dog so that he faces forward. Motion sickness is

ability to process movement. The less blurring movement he sees out the window, the better he might feel.

- Keep your dog as close to the front seat as possible (but not in the front seat). The farther back in the car you go, the more you sense motion.
- Opening the windows a crack. This brings in fresh air, which is soothing, and helps reduce air pressure.
- Avoid feeding your dog for a few hours before a car trip.
- Transport him in a travel crate. A crate will limit his view to the outside, and will help to keep any sickness he may have confined to a small
- space. Keep the temperature low. Heat, humidity and stuffiness can exacerbate car sickness.
- Distract him. Toys, soothing music, or just hearing you speak may help calm and distract a high-strung dog.
- Take frequent breaks. Getting out for fresh air or to stretch your legs can help him feel better periodically.
- Exercise before your car ride.

2. RECONDITIONING

For dogs who have negative associations with riding in cars, reconditioning could be the answer. Reconditioning does take time and patience, but it really can help relax your

- Drive in a different vehicle. Your dog might associate a specific vehicle with
- unpleasant memories. Take short car trips to places your dog enjoys. This will replace negative associations positive ones.
- Gradually acclimate your dog to the car. Start by sitting with your dog in the car while the engine is off each day for a few days. When he seems comfortable, let it idle. Once he is used to that, drive slowly around the block. Gradually progress to longer and longer trips until your dog seems comfortable driving anywhere.
- Offer your dog treats, or offer him a special toy that's just for car rides. This will make the car a fun and rewarding place to be.

3. MEDICATION

While motion sickness related to the brain's can be helped in natural

ways for some dogs, there are cases in which medications is the only option. There are both over-the-counter and prescription medications available, including:

drugs: Anti-nausea and reduce nausea vomiting.

Antihistamines: lessen motion sickness, reduce drooling, and calm nerves.

Phenothiazine: reduces vomiting and helps sedate the dog.

Caution: Always discuss any medications you plan to give your pet with your veterinarian to ensure that your dog is healthy enough to take them, will be given the correct dosage, and won't suffer any adverse effects.

4. HOLISTIC **APPROACH**

Holistic treatments are another way to go for dog parents. They really can be effective, and are worth trying. Some common holistic choices include:

- Ginger. Ginger is used to treat nausea. Try giving your dog ginger snap cookies or ginger pills at least 30 minutes before travel.
- Peppermint, châmomile horehound naturally help calm the stomach and nerves of your dog. These are available in pills and teas.
- Massage can help sooth and relax your pet before you travel.
- other medications, always holistic discuss any remedies you plan to give your pet with your vet to ensure that it's appropriate and the dosage is correct.

In short, with some patience, training, or the right medications or holistic treatments, you and your dog will be able to ride safely and happily together anywhere you need to go!
