

## THE JURY **SYSTEM**

The jury decides the facts and the judge decides the law. The role of the jury is to decide based on the testimony of the witnesses as given under oath in the courtroom. That means that a jury will decide disputed facts, the simplest of which may be which car ran the light. There are as many facts to be determined as there are lawsuits. Notice that this idea of testimony in front of a jury excludes "hearsay evidence". Hearsay is a statement by someone outside of court. There are exceptions but the idea is to let both sides examine the witness in person, under oath and

with the jury present.

The judge decides what law applies to the case. When a jury hears the evidence, the judge tells the jury what the law is, based on what the lawyers

and judge decide what law applies. When the lawyers can't agree, the judge decides what to tell the jury and the lawyers can, outside the presence of the jury, put on the record (for an appellate court to review) why they disagree.

In criminal cases the prosecution whether city, state or federal, must prove that the defendant is guilty "beyond a reasonable doubt". We decided a long time ago that it's better to allow a criminal to be found not guilty than to convict an innocent person of a crime they didn't commit. Unfortunately, that happens anyway as we know from DNA evidence in cases where people were convicted that didn't commit the crime. All a jury can do is decide 'guilty" or "not guilty". In Scotland, they have what I believe is a better system where a jury can return one of three verdicts, guilty, not proven or not guilty. I think that's more accurate.

In civil cases, a jury decides the facts based on "more likely than not". That is known as a "preponderance of the evidence". Always remember that a judge sitting without a jury determines the facts by applying the different burdens of proof. That is to say that in a criminal case, a judge would have to find the evidence convincing "beyond a reasonable doubt" but in a civil case, a judge would only have to find the evidence "more likely than not" to rule in favor of a plaintiff.

It is the role of the jury to take differing testimony and determine whether it's more likely than not in a civil case or in a criminal case whether the testimony is beyond a reasonable doubt.



# **House Calls** with Dr. Barco

### Why Do People Have Trouble **Keeping Weight Off After Losing It?**

In this installment of are overweight and heavy column, I will discuss one of the biggest obstacles that people run into when losing weight- keeping it off. It's not uncommon for me to start a patient on a weight management program and for them to have great initial success. Then, after having great momentum in their weight loss, they suddenly plateau and stop losing weight. Many patients then notice that it is easier for them to gain some of that weight back. As you can imagine, that creates a lot of frustration for folks that have worked so hard to lose weight. Naturally, people want to know why this happens. The answer is that it's complicated and we as doctors don't completely understand why this happens but we do have an idea of a couple of things that are going on.

One of the changes that happens when somebody loses weight is that their muscles change in the way that they use energy and burn calories. When we

my weight management our muscles use a bunch series on the House Calls of energy in order for us to move properly and be able to do the things we do in our everyday life. As we lose weight, our muscles have less work to do and are more efficient at getting us from point A to point B. Because of this, our muscles use less energy during our day to day activities after we have lost some weight. You can imagine that as our muscles burn less calories that it gets harder to lose weight and easier to gain the weight back. The scientific term for this change in our muscles is adaptive thermogenesis. It is because of these muscle changes that it is especially important to be regularly exercising in order help keep the weight off as you will burn more calories on a given day.

The other major change that happens when we lose weight is in our hormones. When you are losing weight, your brain is tricked into thinking that it is starving and in survival mode. It has no idea that you are deliberately losing weight.

As a result, hormones and other chemicals are released that can promote weight gain. One of these hormones is a substance called ghrelin, which is made by the stomach and causes people to get hungrier as they lose weight. Another hormone that can sometimes change is your thyroid hormone, which may go down after weight loss. Having low thyroid slows down your metabolism and can mess with your weight loss plans. That's why I will commonly check thyroid hormone levels in patients who are having trouble with weight loss after initial success.

Lastly, it is important for people trying to lose weight to make sure that they are sticking with their dietary plan as it is not uncommon for folks to "cheat" a little more here and there after losing weight. For that reason, it is important to pick a dietary plan that someone can realistically stick with in the longer term. As always, consult with your primary care provider before implementing any of the advice given in this column.



## **Medicare Minute**

### "Mail, Calls and Door Knocking2"

Last week we began discussing ways that agents and companies market Medicare plans to people turning 65. We discussed the phone calls you may receive and the possibility of someone showing up unannounced at your door. This week we will look at online marketing and direct mail.

Direct mail – This is the most common way companies market their plans. When you are within 6 months of turning 65 a company will purchase a mailing list with your name and address on it. Most companies will start sending mail 6 months prior to the month you turn 65. This is because you are eligible to purchase a Medicare supplement any time during that 6 month period. In most cases direct mail is designed to initiate a response on your part. That response is to call a toll free number. You may be calling to get information but usually are connected to a sales person. If you do respond to direct mail, our advice is to never give the agent on the line your social security number until you are ready to buy. This should protect you against unknowingly signing up for a plan.

Online marketing – Occasionally we will have someone stop by our office that has gone online to research Medicare plans. Most online marketing companies will ask you to provide your phone number and/or email address to get pricing information. Once you enter this information you will immediately begin getting phone calls. This is because when you hit "send" that information goes out to 10 or more agents who have bought that lead. All the agents will begin reaching out to you within minutes.

Phone calls, direct mail, door knocking and online marketing are perfectly legal and compliant under Medicare guidelines for some plans but not others. If you have any questions concerning any of these you can contact our office for more information.
