To Register To Vote You Must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen.

- Be a resident of the county for at least 30 days before the election.
- Not claim the right to vote elsewhere.
- Not be in jail or on parole for a felony conviction.

You need to re-register if:

- You move out of the County.
- Change your name.
- Change your party enrollment.
- Move within the County.

Voting in Primary Elections

You must be enrolled in one of the 8 recognized parties (i.e., Democratic, Republican, Conservative, Green, Working Families, Independence, Women's Equality and Reform) and there must be a primary in the party in which you are enrolled.

Indicating your choice of party enrollment

Use the same form as you do to register to vote. ***Note: If you are already registered and are filing a change of enrollment, the change will not take effect until after the next November General Election.**



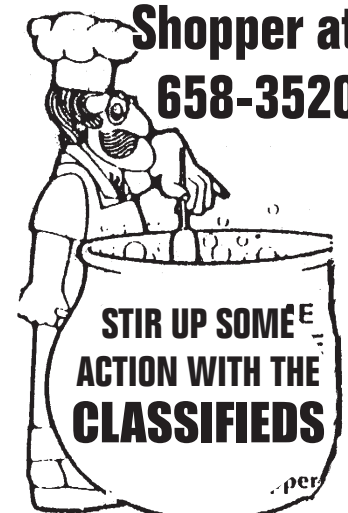

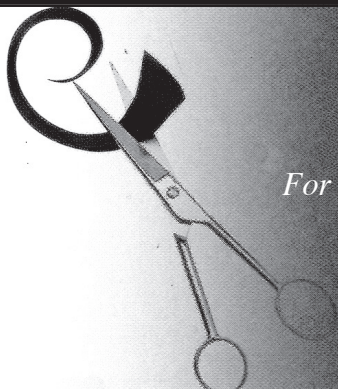

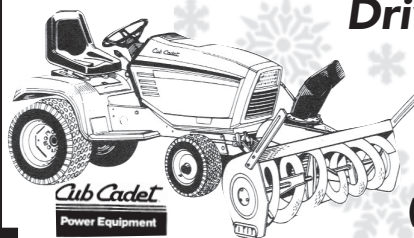
