Preparing For Kindergarten



Kindergarten. The next big frontier for your child. While kindergarten might seem like a long way off in February, early kindergarten registration is right around the corner -- March 10 to be exact. There are some things you can start doing now to help prepare your child for school in the fall.

- Teach your child to say his/her first and last names, address and phone number
- Encourage your child to dress themselves (it helps if clothing is easy to put on and take off)
- Teach your child to use the bathroom and wash their hands
- Visit your child's kindergarten classroom with your child and meet the teacher(s)
- Read books about going to school to your child and allow time for questions

In order to register for kindergarten on March 10, make sure you have:

- your child's birth certificate
- and an up to date record of their immunizations.

In addition, you'll need a kindergarten registration form, which can be picked from the school your child will be attending or the school board office in Danville (341 Main Street, Suite 100) or in Chatham (39 Bank Street).

If you are not sure which school zone you live in, call Danville Public School's administrative office at 799-6400, or Pittsylvania County Public School's administrative office at 432-2761.

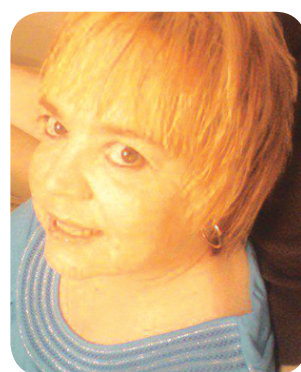

Protect Your Kids at Home

Every year, more than 2,200 children die from injuries that occur at home, according to estimates from Safe Kids Worldwide. While every parent knows that accidents can and do happen, there are many areas of the home where some preventive steps can help reduce the risk.

Go throughout your home to check for these common risk factors and implement corrective actions based on advice from the experts at Safe Kids.

Kitchen

- Although it may be tempting to hold a fussy child while working in the kitchen, a safer alternative is a high chair where they can see all the action but be safely out of harm's way. Place the chair or seat on the floor to avoid possible toppling from atop a counter or furniture, and use the provided straps as instructed to prevent falls and strangulation hazards.
- Keep pan handles turned inward, out of reach of little hands, and before opening the oven door, ensure little ones are a safe distance away, putting your own body between the child and the oven so you can prevent any sudden lunges.
- Use the rear burners when possible and keep dishes filled with hot food out of reach on counters or table tops.

Bathroom

- Always check the water temperature before placing a child in the bathtub. Remember that small children cannot tolerate the same level of heat that many adults enjoy.
- Use a minimal amount of water in the tub, as drowning can occur in as little as a couple of inches. Drain the tub as soon as you are finished.
- Reduce access to other water sources by closing toilet lids and keeping bathroom and laundry room doors closed.
- Immediately unplug and store items such as hair dryers, curling irons and straight irons, which can retain heat long after being turned off and pose an added strangulation danger with dangling cords.
- Keep medication out of reach and always use the intended dosing devices. Common kitchen spoons vary greatly, so using these to measure a medication may be imprecise and result in over or under medicating.

Living Areas

- Prevent window falls and injuries by installing window guards and stops. Remember that windows located upstairs should have an emergency release in case of fire.
- Eliminate dangling cords from blinds, either by hooking cords out of reach or using an alternative window covering.
- When possible, place heavy items on low, sturdy furniture and use safety brackets, braces and wall straps to attach furniture and large items like TVs to the wall to prevent tipping.

Stairs

- Use safety gates at the top and bottom of staircases to prevent falls.
- Ensure gates are securely attached on both sides and review manufacturer instructions to verify gates are constructed for their intended use. For example, not all gates are intended for use at the top of stairs and may give way under pressure.

Pantry/Garage

- Products containing harmful chemicals, such as cleaners, should be stored out of reach, but also out of sight to avoid temptation.
- Keep products in their original containers, which include instructions for proper use and guidance on what to do if ingested, rubbed in eyes, etc. This also helps ensure items are not mistaken for something else and used dangerously.

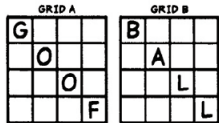

ASIAN-STYLE PORK TENDERLION WITH SESAME-GINGER DRESSING

Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons light soy sauce
- 1 teaspoon Sriracha sauce
- 1/2 cup bottled light sesame-ginger dressing, divided
- 1 (1 pound) pork tenderloin
- 1 (8 to 10-ounce) package of raw carrot and cabbage coleslaw mix
- 1 large yellow bell pepper, cut into strips
- 3 green onions, roots removed and discarded, white and green parts thinly sliced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 cup chopped fresh herbs: cilantro, parsley or basil
- 1/4 cup chopped almonds

Directions

1. Heat oven to 450 F. Whisk together soy sauce, Sriracha sauce and 1/4 cup dressing in a large shallow dish or zip-top plastic freezer bag; add pork, turning to coat. Cover or seal, and refrigerate for 10 minutes, turning once.
2. Meanwhile, combine coleslaw mix, bell pepper, onions, garlic, herbs and the remaining 1/4 cup dressing. Cover and refrigerate until ready to serve.
3. Remove pork from marinade and discard marinade. Place pork on a lightly greased aluminum foil-lined baking sheet.
4. Bake at 450 F for 20 to 25 minutes or until done. Remove from oven, and let stand 5 minutes before slicing. The pork should be slightly pink in the center.

Toss slaw with the almonds and serve with the sliced pork tenderloin. Makes 2 to 3 servings.

How to Bathe a Cat in 6 Fun-Filled Steps

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My 3-year-old cat "Zuzu" loves to go outside and roll around in everything. She comes back in covered with burrs, or mud, or whatever funk she happens upon. I'm not sure why she does this -- isn't that something dogs are known for? Thankfully, she rarely has fleas, since I give her a monthly flea treatment. But she hates baths. How can I keep Zuzu clean? -- Wit's End in St. Paul, Minnesota

DEAR WIT'S END: Before we get into the science of cat bathing, I have to ask: Has Zuzu been spayed? If not, that could be playing a role in her, um, adventurousness. Otherwise, try to limit her exploration to the yard if possible.

Now, to the dreaded cat bath. This is rarely fun for cats or owners. Fortunately, most cats rarely need a bath; too-frequent baths can dry their skin, which can lead to bigger problems.

Here's how:

- 1) Use a sink or a large container, rather than a bathtub. Fill it with just a couple of inches of lukewarm to cool water.
- 2) Place a harness and leash on the cat if controlling her will be a problem. Then carry the cat to the sink, giving it lots of praise.
- 3) Carefully wet the cat up to its neck and add a small amount of perfume-free pet shampoo. Use a damp cloth to wipe its head and neck.
- 4) Dry the cat with a clean towel, give it a treat, and remove the leash and harness.
- 5) Let the cat be mad at you for a while.
- 6) Clean and bandage the scratches on your hands and arms.
