

### **Grand Opening of Magnolia State Bank Downtown Laurel Branch**

"It is great to see his vision finally come to fruition," exclaimed Kris Mangum, CEO of Magnolia State Bank, speaking of former Magnolia State Bank President/ CEO Thomas Brown, who passed away in March of 2016.

Ten years ago Mr. Brown was introduced

to the beautiful building in downtown Laurel that was once a department store named Carter-Heidi then later became known as Effird's before the building was remodeled and turned into an astoundingly beautiful office building with dark mahogany wood and chandeliers throughout.

Thursday morning, March 2, Laurel

Mayor Johnny Magee, other local government officials, members of the Chamber of Commerce and EDA, family and friends joined Barbara Brown - Chairman of the Board, Lillous Ann Shoemaker - President, Mangum, Drew Brown Downtown Laurel President, Mike McClellan - Senior Vice President, and employees of Magnolia State Bank for a Grand Opening Ceremony and Building Dedication.

The honorable Judge Charles Pickering, retired federal judge of the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals, led the Building Dedication ceremony outlining Mr. Brown's history and vision for Magnolia State Bank. Pickering said that Mr. Brown was told if he purchased the building he would have "the most beautiful bank lobby in Mississippi."

Four years ago Mr. Brown finally pur-

chased the building and Thursday was a bittersweet moment for all associated with the bank and everyone who knew Mr. Brown.

Mayor Magee said several years ago he and a group of people from Laurel traveled to Washington D.C. to gather information to start the now Laurel Main Street organization which is dedicated to revitalizing Downtown Laurel. "There were naysayers who said Laurel was dead, gone, a waste. With the opening of Magnolia State Bank, it shows that Downtown is not dead, but thriving," stated Magee.

The main branch of Magnolia State Bank is still located in Bay Springs. The three-story Downtown Laurel Branch building with its central location will also





### **Family pet rescued** from puppy mill

I recently adopted a foster dog named Claire, a Cocker Spaniel estimated to be about 10 years old. Before being

rescued, she was used to breed puppies for a puppy mill. She spent those 10 years of her life in a cage. Even today, she doesn't feel comfortable unless she is enclosed in a pen. She has a crate in my house where I leave the door open so she can come out when she wants, which after several months she is finally starting to do.



She lives in our family room. It also gives her a view of the kitchen and our bedroom, so she can keep an eye on us at all times. She'll briefly venture out and visit us, but I've discovered if her crate is moved or the door shut, she panics. I want to make her as comfortable as possible, but it's sad to see a dog who has known nothing but a life in a cage need to stay in one to feel secure.

She also spent those puppy mill years scratching her ears until they've calcified. She has long-term yeast infections in her ears that we're trying to treat, but a veterinarian has suggested the only remedy is to remove the entire ear canal, which costs thousands of dollars.

When she could no longer produce puppies, the breeder abandoned her to the streets. At some point, she was hit by a car. Maybe that's another reason why she's so terrified of being out of the security of a cage. After fending for herself on the streets, her leg, which was broken in several places, healed on its own, and she still walks with a limp. The vet says it would be better to let it stay like it is than to break it in all those places and reset it.

When she was found by a good Samaritan and taken to a veterinarian, she was recognized, due to congenital defects, possibly due to inbreeding, as belonging to a certain puppy breeder.

This puppy breeder lives in Laurel. She makes money by breeding puppies, and when the dogs are older and no longer useful to her, she discards them around Jones County.

SCAR also has a white Cocker Spaniel around the same age that was discarded around the same time. She is both blind and deaf, and she is filled with yeast. Another nearby animal rescue has a blond Cocker Spaniel male of that age that was discarded. We also have another breed of dog from this breeder that spent the first month it was with one of our fosters cowering in a corner, terrified of people and other animals.

In an ideal world, everyone would adopt animals that already need homes rather than encouraging breeders by buying their dogs, but if you do purchase from a breeder, please know who you are buying from. I don't mean know them by the face they share with the public; I mean know their true selves, the ones revealed by the way they treat their animals.

Make sure you get to see where the animals are kept. If they aren't showing you, it's because there's something to hide. It was determined that Claire and the other animals mentioned were fed twice a week. They weren't pets. They weren't socialized. They were tools to make money for the breeder. Their comfort or needs weren't important to this woman. Please remember giving her your money encourages her to continue her behavior.

Ask to see the "retired" dogs. Are they kept as loyal pets after their years of constant breeding? If they aren't, then why would you give your money to someone who thinks so little of the animals you're paying so much for?

As soon as we have people willing to testify, we'll gladly press charges against breeders who don't provide adequate food or shelter to their animals, or when we can provide witnesses to their abandonment. The public's help is always needed if we are to end animal cruelty. (Southern Cross Animal Rescue is a non-profit animal rescue located on Highway 184 West. 

The kickoff event will consist of musical selections from Hattiesburg High School's Chamber Orchestra and an anniversary address from former East Sixth Street USO Hostess Vermell Jackson.

"Commemorating 75 years of service in Hattiesburg is an exciting milestone for the USO. These events will celebrate the 1940s and give guests the opportunity to experience a glimpse of how life was when the USO was established," Latoya Norman, general manager of the AAMHM, said.

Other celebratory events will be held March 23-25. On Thursday, March 23, the USO will host an open house at 10 a.m. for area high school students. Following the open house, the USO will show the PBS documentary "USO: For the Troops" at 11 a.m. This documentary will give viewers a behind-the-scenes look at how United Service Organizations keep service members connected to home, service and family. These are both free events.

On Friday, March 24, the first Miss East Sixth Street USO Pageant will be at 7 p.m. with an anniversary social following at 8 p.m. The pageant will feature five female contestants competing for a scholarship for the 2017-2018 school year. As with every other celebration during this week, the pageant will be inspired by 1940s attire and etiquette. Admission to both of these events is \$10. Seating is limited, so those wishing to pre-purchase tickets should contact the USO to secure tickets.

On Saturday March 25, the USO will host a 1940s Community Day and Mississippi Bicentennial Celebration event from noon to 4 p.m.

It is currently the only surviving restored USO built exclusively for African American soldiers and in 2003 was placed on the National Register of Historic Places. More than 150 years of African American military history is on display in the Museum.



## Job hunting students unaware of top hiring sector

(Family Features) A national survey reports that students getting ready to enter the workforce are often overlooking one of the top hiring sectors - agriculture.

The research, sponsored by the America's Farmers Grow Ag Leaders program, found that agriculture is not being considered by many high school and college students, despite it being one of the country's major industries. In fact, only 3 percent of students recognize the agriculture industry as a top hiring sector.

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, employers have nearly 60,000 job openings in agriculture annually, but only approximately 35,000 students with the proper training and education to fill these jobs each year.

Part of the awareness gap may be attributed to a lack of understanding of the varied job prospects and technology focus in the agriculture industry. Fewer than one in five students (19 percent) students surveyed felt they understood the career opportunities in agriculture, and only one in three students (35 percent) described agriculture as a technology-driven industry.

However, today's agriculture industry offers a wide array of career paths for individuals with interest in technology, science, education, agronomy and business - among other fields. From agriculture economists and agronomists, to crop consultants, food scientists and engineers, experts in multiple fields - especially in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) areas are needed to drive innovations growers need to feed the world's growing population.

To help close this gap, the America's Farmers Grow Ag Leaders program, sponsored by the Monsanto Fund, awards scholarships to help develop the next generation of agriculture leaders. Students looking to pursue higher education in an agriculture-related field of study from a two- or four-year program or trade school are eligible to apply for a \$1,500 scholarship until Feb. 1, 2017.

"The field of agriculture provides many exciting and important career opportunities for today's students, and we feel it's important to support youth who are pursuing their studies in this growing and dynamic industry," said Al Mitchell, Monsanto Fund president.





In Matthew 10. we find some interesting details concerning



the way in which Jesus was preparing His disciples for the ministry they had been set apart to accomplish. He begins first by giving them instructions for their service then He reveals to them that He is asking them to go down a hard road. "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves;" stated Jesus, as he warned them of the difficulties they would face as they went about serving in His Name.

While carrying on with this task, she soon realized a greater need than the firing of a cannon as she was overwhelmed by the effect the heat and thirst was having on the men. As a result, she changed her course of action; instead of firing the cannon, she began to bring pitchers of water to the troops and gave water to the men on both sides of the conflict. Because of her actions, she was given the nickname, Molly Pitcher. The point of this illustration is to remind us of what Jesus had revealed to His disciples, that even the smallest task that we do as service to others in His Name will be rewarded. I trust that as we walk through life, that we would begin to see the thirst that exists in lives of those we encounter and willing give a cup of cold water, "Living water" in Jesus' Name to them. If we do, we can rest assured that there will be a reward for our service.
