A few years ago, I was honored to be selected to be part of the Go Red for Women photo- and printad campaign for the American Heart Association. There's a common misconception that anything described as healthy is lacking in flavor and satisfaction. To add insult to injury, there's also an assumption that healthy foods are unaffordable. The truth is, there are plenty of creative ways to make a tasty, heart-healthy dish.
This heart-healthy recipe uses a lean pork tenderloin and Asian sauces to create a flavorful and easy-to-prepare dinner dish. Use any leftover pork and salad inside of a whole-wheat tortilla to create a wrap for lunch.

Asian-Style Pork Tenderlion With SesameGinger Dressing tablespoons light soy sauce 1/2 teaspoon Sriracha sauce
1/2 cup bottled light sesameginger dressing, divided (1 pound) pork tenderloin (8 to 10-ounce) package of raw carrot and cabbage cole slaw mix
large yellow bell pepper, cut into strips
green onions, roots removed and discarded, white and green parts thinly sliced green parts thinly sticed
cloves garlic, minced cup chopped fresh herbs: cilantro, parsley or basil 1/4 cup chopped almonds

1. Heat oven to 450 F . Whisk together soy sauce, Sriracha sauce and $1 / 4$ cup dressing in a large shallow dish or zip-top plastic freezer bag; add pork, turning to coat. Cover or seal, and refrigerate for 10 minutes, turning once.

Meanwhile, combine coleslaw mix, bell pepper, onions, garlic, herbs and the remaining $1 / 4$ cup dressing. Cover and refrigerate until ready to serve.
3. Remove pork from marinade and discard marinade. Place pork on a lightly greased aluminum foil-lined baking sheet.
4. Bake at 450 F for 20 to 25 minutes or until done. Remove from oven, and let stand 5 minutes before slicing. The pork should be slightly pink in the center.
Toss slaw with the almonds and serve with the sliced pork tenderloin. Makes 2 to 3 servings.

## Growing papaya

To grow good papayas you will need frost-free climate, lots of sunlight, water and very good soil. Cut a papaya in half scrape out the seeds, and sow them in the location you've chosen. Some will be "male" (long, thin stalks with several small blooms) or "female" (single bloms, bigger, and very close to the trunk); you only need one male for every $10-15$ female plants. They flower at about 3 feet tall. You may be picking the first ripe fruit within 10 months. Source: www.tropicalpermaculturecom

Don't Fear the Check Engine Light
(NAPS)-Although the check engine light may look scary lit up on the dashboard, you don't need to panic. Aglowing check engine light doesn't mean you have to immediately pull the car to the side of the road; it does mean you should get the car checked out as soon as possible.
"Motorists should not get spooked when the check engine light comes on" says Rich White, executive direc tor Car Care Council the tor, Car Care "Be the source for the "Be Car Care Aware" campaign promoting regular vehicle care, main tenance and repair. "When illuminated, the check engine light usually means that a vehicle system, such as the ignition, fuel injection or emission control, is not operating properly."

Possible Problems
Some common malfunctions that can cause the light to illuminate include a faulty oxygen sensor, mass air flow sensor, or spark plugs and wires. If the light flashes, the condition is more critical and must be checked immediately to prevent severe damage, which may include catalytic converter problems.
"Even if the vehicle appears to be running normally, ignoring the warning light could result in more costly repairs, adds whit. At the very least, the light could be alerting you to an engine problem that is negatively impacting fuel economy and costing you money.


A "check engine" light coming on doesn't mean you have to stop driving immediately but you should get it looked at very soon.

Service and Solutions When scheduling service, make sure the repair shop that examines your vehicle has professional technicians who are trained and certified in OBDII diagnosis and repair. The technician will connect your vehicle's computer system to a diagnostic scan tool, which will provide trouble codes indicating why the check engine light was activated. While the diagnostic tool is connected, the technician can analyze data streams such as the idle speed, throttle response, engine temperature, fuel system pressure, manifold vacuum, exhaust emission levels and many other key indicators. Once the problem is identified and the repair is made the car's computer is reset

## What To Do When Disaster Strikes

(NAPS)-Every year in the U.S., FEMA reports, about 100 disasters, natural and man-made, occur-but there are steps you can take to proare steps you can take to proif any ever occurs to you. These seven hints can help:

Before A Disaster

1. Develop a family communications plan. Everyone should know whom to reach and how.
2. Make an emergency kit. It should include enough food, water and other supfood, water and other sup-
plies to last at least 72 hours. plies to last at least 72 hours. operated radio and enough batteries for both. Include a supply of any medications you take. Have cash on hand. 3. Sign up for emergency alerts with the weather service.

After A Disaster
4. If you've been evacuated from your home, inspect it before re-entering. Walk carefully around the outside and check for loose power lines, gas leaks and structural damage.
5. Do not enter if:

- You smell gas.
- Floodwaters remain around the building.
- Your home was damaged by fire and the authorities have not declared it safe.

6. Watch out for animals, especially poisonous snakes. Use a stick to poke through debris.
7. One silver lining is that damage, destruction or loss of your property resulting from such events that insurance doesn't pay for may be deductible on your tax return. The experts at the National Association of Enrolled Agents (NAEA) suggest you photograph and inventory any prop-
