




Together Again

Historic OST video to open PLAC gala

The Okoboji Summer Theatre will be opening Saturday night's 60th year celebration at the Pearson Lakes Art Center with a historic video to add to what the organizers are calling, "a fun-filled evening of songs from the big band era, Broadway musicals, and classic jazz."

Former OST managing director Addison Myers is featured in the *History of Okoboji Summer Theatre* video as both interviewee and tour director across the OST campus of 20-some years ago. The video will start shortly after 7:00, Saturday night, with the musical program to follow at 7:30.

Four Stephens College students will be featured as a part of the program, along with Rob Doyen, and OST pianist Tom Andes, bassist Tim Schumacher and drummer Greg Forney. Okoboji Summer Theatre Association voucher books will also be available Saturday night...

In just one word, Saturday afternoon's *Together Again* performance by Okoboji High School alums, as a part of the Arts of St. Joseph's concert series was "wonderful," or "exceptional," — or just about any single-word accolade you can conjure up. Each of the eight involved (above, L-R: Karina Van Wyhe, Rebecca Salmen Huberg, Jessica Schable, Heath Huberg, Andrew Duncan, Andy Ryker, John Moore and accompanist Jennifer Johnson) demonstrated a talent that was first cultured and nurtured here then later with higher education that shows tremendous accomplishments recognized nationwide — accomplishments that brought the packed church (and balcony) to most enthusiastic applause. *The Battle Hymn*... finale even saw the crowd on its feet with a standing ovation — something you don't often see in church!

While there was some concern about the concert being advanced from Sunday to Saturday only a week earlier, John's father and mother told us Sunday afternoon that had the concert not been moved due to John's scheduling conflict, the long-forecast snow would probably have canceled it entirely. The further good news is that John was in Philadelphia on Sunday...

Sally Jo Ites, the vocal music director at the Spirit Lake Middle School, sent us an email Monday morning — but too late for last week's *Rambol*ing. The good news from the SLMS is that the 38 members of the *Spirit Rising Choir* earned a sixth place trophy at the March 3rd Emmetsburg Extravaganza Show Choir and Vocal Jazz Invitational.

Soloists included Hope Johnson, Adrie Stecker, Anna Fuelberth, Victoria Batistella, and Max Bower, who received the Best Male Soloist trophy.

Our belated congratulations to all involved...

This week will see *John Senn & Friends* back at Table 316 in Arnolds Park, Wednesday night, from 6 - 8:00.

And Dave Rowley will be returning to the Little Swan Lake Winery, Sunday, from 4 - 6:00 with sidekick Ryan Sather...

In case you haven't yet looked at your calendar, research director RD tells us today is March 14th — expressed as "3.14," especially if you know that it is also "Pi Day," where Pi is the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter. While the exact ratio carries more than 50 digits to the right of the decimal point, 3.14, as in March 14th, is the most common use.

Song-wise, think Don McLean's *American Pie*, *The Four Tops' I Can't Help Myself (Sugar Pie, Honey Bunch)* or going back even further, Frank Sinatra's "Pie in the sky," *High Hopes*. More recently, Nellie McKay, titled her Doris Day tribute album, *Normal As Blueberry Pie*...

Today is also "Ask A Question Day," for which RD recalls the song *Wouldn't It Be Lovely?* from *My Fair Lady*, which also has a connection to Wednesday's anniversary of its opening on Broadway in 1956 — after which the production continued for 2,714 more performances — a number totally unrelated to Pi of any kind...

Maximilian 'Max' Shulman was born in St. Paul, Minnesota, on this day in 1919. Shulman wrote or co-wrote two plays that became successful Broadway musicals — *The Tender Trap*, and *How Now Dow Jones*. *The Tender Trap* title tune, written by Sammy Cahn and Jimmy Van Heusen, was recorded by Frank Sinatra, who co-starred in the motion picture with Debbie Reynolds.

Step To The Rear, one of the big songs from *How Now*... was written by Elmer Bernstein and Carolyn Leigh, and became the title of a 1967 RCA album by Marilyn Maye — who also recorded a parody of the offering as a campaign song for Robert Ray as *Let a winner lead the way. That's Ray* — before the Des Moines attorney who became one of Iowa's longest-termed governors was elected to any public office!

RD also notes that *Bein' Green*, as in the Joe Raposo song, is easy on the right holiday — like Friday's St. Patrick's Day. In addition to being a hit for Kermit (The Frog), *Bein' Green* was recorded successfully by the likes of Frank Sinatra, Tony Bennett, Ray Charles, and Lena Horne, who did it as a duet with Kermit!

Friday is also Nat 'King' Cole's natal day. Nat recorded the song *Green Eyes* as *Aquello Ojos Verdes* in 1959 as a part of his album *A Mis Amigos*. While Nat didn't speak any foreign language, he later recorded at least one other album of Latin melodies en Espanol...

With Spring making its legitimate appearance on Monday, RD explains that it was in 1962 that Nat recorded *Spring is Here*, with the Gordon Jenkins Orchestra — not in March or April, but in August, August 13, 1962 — not unlike Mel Tormé's *Christmas Song* that was recorded on a hot summer's day in Los Angeles...

Like *Ripley's Believe It or Not*, Monday is also "Ravioli Day." And while her research shows that any stuffed pasta qualifies as ravioli, RD was only able to find one song that mentions the gustatory delight the Italians probably enjoyed first as merchants who visited China where wontons predate the mini pies.

That one song, *Pennies from Heaven*, didn't include a ravioli reference until Louis Prima parodied the lyric Johnny Burke wrote in 1936 by changing, "Trade them for a package of sunshine and flowers," to "Trade them for a package of sunshine and Ravioli!" Leave it to Louis, whose sole purpose in life and the music business was to have fun.

He would have enjoyed student life at the University of Okoboji...

When will the wall be built?

To The Editor:

President Trump issued a statement saying that contracts will soon be let to start construction of the wall to prevent illegal passage from Mexico to the United States. The proposed wall, as currently described is approximately 1000 miles long. Of that 632 miles, or 33%, is on Federal or Tribal lands, the remaining 67% or 1340 miles are owned by states or are privately owned. Most of the land is located in Texas.

To build a structure, you must have access to or ownership of the land upon which it will reside. At present, neither is available for the construction of the border wall. As we have often seen, violation of Tribal land is difficult at best and near impossible at times. The wall, as planned, will be built on U.S. soil, and sometimes is a bit of a distance from the actual border. This will cause an access problem for people owning lands that extend south of the wall. As the process would normally evolve, agreements must be negotiated with each owner or entity for access to the property needed for the wall. There is a plethora of reasons for individuals or entities refusing to make their property available. So, what happens then? A remedy previously often used by President Trump — eminent domain. This option is not a quick and easy process. It takes place through the courts, and often times, cases go on for years, as the property owner has the right of due process. It's possible that hundreds of cases will have to be tried to secure the total 1000 miles. Considering all this, it seems questionable that the wall could be built during President Trump's term of office.



Repeal of ACA Would Push Thousands of Iowans to the Brink

The Affordable Care Act has made good-quality health insurance available to thousands of Iowans who could not otherwise afford coverage. The benefits have been felt statewide, including in rural communities. In fact, according to a recent report for the Iowa Fiscal Partnership, Iowa's rural counties saw an even greater decline in the share of uninsured residents – falling from 9 percent to 5 percent – than metropolitan counties did from 2013 to 2015.

Last week, House Republican leaders presented an outline of their plan to replace the Affordable Care Act. If the ACA is repealed without an adequate replacement Iowa stands to end up even worse than before the law went into effect, with about 230,000 Iowans, including 25,000 children, losing health coverage in 2019. The proposed plan also called for a radical reconstruction of the way the Medicaid program is structured and financed. These changes would place severe fiscal pressures on Iowa and threaten patient access to care, jeopardizing the coverage of nearly 1 out of every 5 children in Dickinson County who receive coverage through Medicaid.

Repeal of the ACA could also create chaos in Iowa's health care system and the state budget. Over a 10-year period, Iowa would lose \$7.4 billion in federal funding to meet the health needs of its residents. In addition, growth in the number of uninsured residents would triple the costs of uncompensated care to \$1.2 billion annually.

Keeping our children and families healthy is key to many of the Iowa's educational and economic goals. Asthma, diabetes, even tooth decay can keep children home from school. Sick children can keep parents home from work. Healthy communities are prosperous communities, vital to Iowa's economic success.

The stakes are too high for us to hope this time will be different. Voting to repeal the ACA without a replacement plan attached is not responsible governing; it's a risky step that threatens the health of children and families.

Our elected leaders in Washington, D.C. should show responsibility and forethought by not rushing forward to repeal the Affordable Care Act before they have done the hard work to negotiate and approve a replacement plan that provides equal or better coverage for Iowans. They owe us that much.

Stepping Back in Time by Jerry and Irene Clark of the Clark Museum of Okoboji area and Iowa history – Milford, Iowa.

This photo complements last week's photo of the brick Milford Elementary School built in 1912. This picture shows the old wooden school with bell tower that was built around 1888 on the south side of town. The St. Patrick's Catholic Church and Rectory are visible to the east on the corner of 7th Street and N Avenue where Tony and Veree Lane lived.

Father Meyers purchased a two block cornfield north of town (present Catholic Church, but adjacent to main street) from R.E. Donaldson. This entire new property could be purchased by exchanging the lots

that the parish owned, including the parish house, and \$3,000 cash. The railroad tracks and trestle over the creek can be seen. The roof of the Dick Lodge home is visible among the trees (now school property). Many of the houses are now gone and many new homes have been built since. How wonderful that pictures like this can still be viewed and history kept.

View From The Bench

Big 12 Champs

I'm not going to lie, I was one of the doubters of this Iowa State team and coach Steve Prohm. The last editorial that I wrote was back in December after Iowa had just dismantled what I described as the "soft and selfish Cyclones" 78-64. The team that lost in Iowa City also showed up several times later in losses to Texas and at home to West Virginia, but something happened after that Texas loss that turned the season around for the Cyclones.

What that something is, I'm not exactly sure, but give coach Steve Prohm and this group of seniors all of the credit in the world for figuring it out. After the Texas loss it looked like the 'Clones would possibly be heading to the NIT or maybe at best sneak into the NCAA Tournament as an 11 or 12 seed, but since that loss, ISU has won 9 of their last 10 games, including the three game stretch at "Hilton South" in Kansas City that resulted in yet another Big 12 Tournament Championship. This is the Cyclones third Big 12 Tournament title in four years, an amazing accomplishment for this program that finally won a Big 8 Tournament Championship on their last try back in 1996. I could go on about critics saying that tournament championships don't matter as much as the regular season titles, but I'm only going to respond with this, if it didn't matter why does the NCAA recognize the tournament title and not the regular season title with the automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament? Tell a team from a one-bid league that won their regular season title but lost in their tournament and are left out on Selection Sunday that their regular season title means more and I'm sure they will disagree. Anyway, that's an article for another day, back to my Cyclones.

The turning point of the season appears to be when Coach Prohm inserted freshman center Solomon Young into the starting line-up after the Texas loss, as that brought an inside defensive presence that the Cyclones were sorely missing. This group also figured out that playing team defense and battling on the boards as best they can as an undersized team also would help them stay in games when their shooting was off. Another change is that the seniors appeared to have really stepped up their leadership and started to play together. I always tell my teams that the really good teams play FOR one another, not just with each other and this Cyclone team has really started to play for each other; making the extra pass, helping each other on defense, and busting their tails to not let their teammates down. None of this was going on earlier in the season, but this team has now grown up and figured it out. It definitely helps having one of the best point guards in the nation in Monte Morris running the show, but the other seniors on the team have also stepped up. Often criticized Deonte Burton has been clutch down the stretch, hitting big shot after big shot while also dunking on people and rebounding against bigger opponents; senior wings Naz Mitrou-Long and Matt Thomas have each had huge offensive games, but also have played well when their shots weren't falling and found other ways to help the team win. ISU has also gotten clutch play from their bench, something that was missing earlier in the season as Donovan Jackson has hit some huge shots and also handled the ball well, taking some of that pressure away from Morris; senior transfer Darrell Bowie had a huge Big 12 Tournament and appears to be peaking at the right time; and sophomore Nick Weiler-Babb has played to the potential that Cyclone fans were hoping for. Give Prohm and his staff credit for keeping Young and this group of bench players engaged and positive through the year when they weren't playing as much as they would like or performing as well as expected.

I am on my way to Mexico for vacation as I write this so I won't know ISU's NCAA seed until after I send this off for our 3.14 edition, but I'm hopeful the Cyclones played their way to at least a 5 seed if not maybe a 4 seed. The challenge for Iowa State is to not let a repeat of 2015 happen when they entered the Tournament as a 3 seed fresh off a Big 12 Tournament title and promptly lost to 14 seed UAB. These Cyclones hopefully learned from that team, as many of them were sophomores on that squad that apparently listened to how good they were and forgot to show up for the first round game. I'm hopeful that this year's ISU team will continue to play FOR one another during the NCAA Tournament; if they do, the Big 12 Tournament title will not be the highlight of the season as they have the potential for a deep NCAA Tournament run. Go Cyclones, we'll be watching from the beaches of Mexico!
