

Making The Best Use Of Time

On Daylight Savings Time eve, I went through our house and garage and reset all the clocks an hour forward. I thought it would be a simple task until I realized how many clocks and watches that involved. If I counted correctly, there were 15 and that did not include the ones that automatically reset themselves. Suffice it to say, if we are ever late getting somewhere, we cannot blame it on letting the time slip up on us!

The Bible makes note of time in various passages. One that comes to mind for our consideration here is, "Look

carefully then how you walk, not as unwise, but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil" (Ephesians 5:15). It would benefit us all to evaluate ourselves periodically to see if we are making the best use of our time.

Those who have taken the time to study how we spend the days of our lives on this earth say, that if a person lives to be 75 years old, there are some predictable statistics. Here are a few of those: we will spend 3 solid years (24 hours a day) acquiring an education; we will spend 7 years eating (some more than others); we will spend 14 years working (again night and day); 5 more years will be spent talking (no comment); 5 years will be spent riding in transportation; 24 years of our life will be spent in sleep; 1 year we will either be sick or recovering from an illness; 3 years will be spent in reading; and 12 years of our life will be spent in recreation (watching TV, fishing, golfing, shopping, etc.).

While none of the things in the above list are intrinsically bad, most of them could be bad if we did not practice them with priority. For example, if we choose recreation over family responsibilities, then we have not chosen wisely (cf. Proverbs 22:6). Or, if we choose to sleep in on Sunday morning rather than worship God, then we again have failed to make the best use of our time (cf. Hebrews 10:25).

God has always expected His people to prioritize their lives beginning with Him (cf. Exodus 20:2; Deuteronomy 6:4). Jesus made this truth crystal clear when He commanded: "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness..." (Matthew 6:33,

Does God top your priority list? If not, "it is time to seek the Lord" (Hosea 10:12). There could be no better way to spend your time right now!



The repair process took just under two months from start to finish. It involved replacing and reinforcing paneling around and on the stage. The loading ramp and snake channel have also been replaced. "The stage was structurally sound," said Bruce Crowden who handles maintenance at the Hall of Fame. "Most of the decay was superficial, thankfully. We've also had it painted with a weather-

resistant mix."

The restoration was done under the guidance of the Hall of Fame's skilled volunteers and the Tuscumbia Utilities Department. "Larry Lewis and J.R. Jones have been instrumental in making this go smoothly," Griffin added.

The paint was donated by the Muscle Shoals Lowe's home improvement store and was applied by James and Anthony Speegle.

ASK THE ATTORNEY



Thomas McCutcheon

Ask the Attorney is sponsored by local attorneys, McCutcheon & Hamner, PC, as a service to the residents of NW Alabama.

My dad was in a car accident and the other driver was working for a business and was working at the time of the accident. The accident report indicates that the driver had insurance but we found out it had expired. I think that the business should be responsible for my dad's car and his hospital bill.

Brad, Florence, AL

If the driver was at work for the business at the time of the accident, the business will be probably be liable (responsible) for both the property damage and the personal injury to your father.

This presumes that the other driver was at fault in the accident. Before the business is liable, the driver has to have been negligent in some way that caused the accident such as a rear end collision or failing to yield the right of way. If he was not at fault, then his employer is not responsible.

We are talking about an area of law called agency and we think about a relationship where the employee was performing duties incident to their job, but the law also will find an employer responsible if the employer supplied the vehicle or the employee was acting in furtherance of the employer's interest.

The law does not require that the employee was specifically authorized to engage in that particular activity but that those activities were generally within the employee's authority. In other words, if it is customary for the driver to eat lunch while doing their job while on the job and the driver was going to lunch, the employer should be responsible.

The idea behind the law imposing liability on the employer is that the employer is generally in the best position to insure that their work is performed in a safe manner. Therefore, the negligent acts of an employee while in the line and scope of their employment are both the responsibility of the negligent employee and the company they were working for at the time of the accident. If the other driver was at work when this accident happened, the company that he worked for should have to pay for the harm that he caused.



on them. As least many of my Facebook friends are doing so.

Look, I hate to break it to you but you're just not that interesting. Nobody is watching you through your TV or microwave oven. No one has hacked your phone to follow your every move. That just doesn't happen. Unless you're a bad guy, of course.

The details of these hacks have not been released but we do know some things. First off, Samsung TVs: The hack involves physically inserting a USB thumb drive into the back of the TV that installs a bit of

software that gives the TV a fake "off" status. The screen looks dark but the TV is actually still on. Some Samsung TVs come with a built-in microphone for video conferencing that allows the CIA to listen to your conversations. Details are scarce for the iPhone hack but what you need to know is this: Every operating system from iPhone to Android to Windows is always going

The bottom line is that unless vou are a very interesting person that Kussians, CIA, MI5 all want to know more about, you're pretty darn safe from being spied upon using these methods. So feel free to turn your TV back on.





I'm Interested in Taking the Diet Pill Phentermine For Weight Loss. What Do I Need To Know Before Starting It?

While my preference is to take phentermine or any always to attempt weight loss other weight loss medication exercise, medication can sometimes be a useful tool to help with weight management. It's important to note that not everybody is a good candidate for phentermine. For starters, I pay close attention to body mass index (BMI) in somebody interested in attempting this therapy. Patients with a high BMI might benefit from this medication. When your BMI is less than 27, the risk usually outweighs the benefits of the medicine. But determining whether a patient can take it safely doesn't end with BMI. I also pay close attention to whether they have medical conditions that make it more dangerous to take the medicine, especially because this medicine can stimulate your cardiovascular system. Anybody with a history of heart disease, including previous heart attack, congestive heart failure, heart valve disease and abnormal heart rhythms (like atrial fibrillation) should avoid this medicine. If they have the condition of high blood pressure, the blood pressure must be under good control before this medicine can be started. Somebody who takes thyroid medicine for low thyroid function must also have well-controlled thyroid hormone levels before safely prescribing this medicine. These are just some of the things I pay attention to before giving the okay to begin phentermine.

Once the medication is started, there must also be close monitoring of the patient. First and foremost, we monitor to make sure that the patient is losing weight on the medicine. After all, there is no sense

in my patients through diet if it is not helping one to shed pounds. Second, we pay close attention to how the medicine is affecting the blood pressure and heart rate. If either blood pressure or heart rate is high, this is grounds to either reduce the dosage or stop the medicine altogether. The medicine is also known to potentially cause certain side effects, so I ask the patient about this at every visit. Some of the most common side effects are jitteriness, insomnia, palpitations and headaches. As long as the medicine is contributing to adequate weight loss, the blood pressure and heart rate are under good control and there are no significant side effects, the medicine can usually be safely continued. One last point on phentermine is that it's effects are typically temporary. In other words, the effectiveness of this medication subsides and eventually disappears after a few months. Therefore, this therapy is not one that is used long-term for weight loss. That is why it's so important to make sure that there is a good foundation of proper dieting and exercise. If one relies only on the medicine to lose weight, they can expect to gain the weight back once the phentermine effects wear off.

If you are interested in starting on this or any other medication to assist in weight loss, it is extremely important to consult with your primary care provider to see if this is a safe option for you.





Medicare Minute

"Part B Drugs"

When we think of prescription drugs and Medicare, we usually think of Medicare Part D. Medicare Part D is a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan that is purchased from a private insurance company. Some drugs, however, are covered under Medicare Part B.

According to Medicare.gov "Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) doesn't cover most prescription drugs used at home, but it does cover a limited number of outpatient prescription drugs under limited conditions. Generally, drugs covered under Part B are drugs you would not usually give to yourself, like those you get at a doctor's office or hospital outpatient setting."

So what does this mean and why does it matter? It means, in most cases, if you are prescribed a drug by your doctor and go to your pharmacy to pick up the prescription, it is covered under Medicare Part D. But, if you are given the drug at your doctor's office or in a hospital outpatient setting it could be filed under Medicare Part B. It matters because if your prescription is filed under Medicare Part D you may have a copay and may have to meet a deductible. Filing under Medicare Part D could also, if the drug is expensive, expose you to the "Coverage Gap" or "Donut Hole." If the drug is covered under Medicare Part B you may not have any out of pocket cost. This, of course, depends on the Medicare health plan you have to supplement Medicare.

Some of the most common drugs that can be covered under Medicare Part B are: Drugs used with an item of durable medical equipment such as an infusion pump or drugs given by a nebulizer, injectable and infused drugs given by a licensed medical provider, and vaccinations such as the flu shot. There are many other drugs covered under Medicare Part B. These are the most common. If you want to know if a particular drug you are taking can be filed under Part B ask your medical provider or you can come by our office.

"Because my part of Oklahoma is so flat, you can just see forever. Everything is affected by the sky and what is happening in the sky," she said. "I began to take a real interest in the vastness of the space. I began to study clouds and what started their formation and what they were able to cause as far as weather is concerned."

Reed received her BFA at the Memphis College of Art and began working at the college the year she graduated in 1956. After taking a leave of absence to study in Europe, Reed returned in 1962 as a Professor and held that rank from 1962 to 1995. Since retiring from teaching in 1996, Reed served two terms on the Memphis College of Art's Board of Trustees.

There have been reports that some snakes may have their mouths sewn shut so they can be manhandled by the public and used as photo props.

These sick spectacles are nothing more than cash grabs. Rattlesnake roundups are barbaric and should be outlawed.

AND CREDITORS QUESTIONS

Dear Dave,

We were very late on one of our credit card bills, The collection company has offered us three or four different payment options. Does the original creditor accept the agreement, too, if we accept one of the

collection agency's options? Anonymous

Dear Anonymous,

In most situations of this type, the collection agency owns the debt outright or they're directly representing the original creditor. It's pretty much standard operating procedure when someone has defaulted on a loan.

My advice would be to accept the deal they've offered that makes the most sense for you and your current financial situation. It'll ding your credit report, and show a settlement on the defaulted credit card, but that's not the end of the world. There's already a mark against you for it being turned over to collections.

If you want to keep things like this from happening in the future, you need to get control of your finances. Stop playing with credit cards!

The Obamacare plan forced participation to avoid federal fines. The proposed law returns choice back into the picture - without our heads being at Federal gunpoint. Americans can decide if health insurance is something that they want. It's no different than purchasing cancer, disability, or life insurance. We weigh the risks and rewards and make a choice we have to live with. Sometimes our choices are prudent and well-reasoned. Sometimes they are self-serving with minimal forethought. It's a choice. Some will also choose not to take health insurance when some subsidy levels are reduced. That is borderline stupidity, but it is a far cry from 'Trump, the butcher' taking our healthcare away. Those are just more half-truths and supposed facts. What happens if someone who is uninsured has a medical emergency? That may be up for debate, based on how Trump campaigned on getting rid of ObamaCare. His proposal is little more than ObamaCare2 with a few tweaks.

It's interesting how some nationalized healthcare proponents refer to health coverage as a right, while others proponents want participation to be mandatory. Logically, it is one or the other. It can't be both.

premise healthcare being a right or an entitlement is straight out of the Marxist Once again, handbook. they have sold millions of people on the premise of a socialist philosophy which translates to "minimal responsibility." Publicly subsidized healthcare coverage is no more of



pool, a car, or a windmill. Neither should it be mandatory.

As has been stated in this space many times, I am always open to helping those who are deserving. I'd say most reasonable people are. That would include subsidizing a modest degree of health coverage. However, people don't qualify as 'deserving' simply because they exist.

Honorably discharged veterans should head the list with medical care as needed. Medicare and Medicaid recipients and the disabled could be in the next several tiers depending on various factors. However, those supporting the system should be the primary recipients of the most detailed care.

There are far too many stories about subsidized Obamacare patients having NO premiums, prescription costs, office copays, knee replacement surgeries and therapy covered with no copay and no deductible,

Meanwhile purchasing insurance on their own or taking part in company-sponsored plans that are paid in full often have insurance premiums \$800-\$1,000/month, \$50 office copays, surgery

a right than is owning a deductibles and copays into the thousands and an annual out of pocket ceiling of \$6,000-\$10,000.

THAT is simply out of bounds and defies logic... unless one has a skewed view of economics.

Insurance should not cover every pill or expense, but neither should it cost the contributors and subsidizers through the nose. Those who pick up the tab should have the greatest degree of coverage, period.

Those who pick up very little of their own tab should receive adequate preventative and treatment care. However they should also have some restrictions, limitations and requirements. few dollars out of pocket in any situation keeps us all mindful of the fact that NOTHING is free.

Bottom line: To keep everyone cognizant of economic realities, every covered able-bodied person MUST have some skin in the game in all areas of life, however small. That includes things like income taxes, housing, utilities, food, transportation... and yes, healthcare insurance.

As with most situations, when people say they can't afford to have it, they actually can't afford NOT to have it. That's another topic for another time.




