
Fairgrounds was torn down in 2008, the plan was to raise funds and quickly replace it.

The second-seeded Mercs just couldn't pull it off. "We didn't have a good game and their defense was very intense," said Wahlin.







\$100,000 from a gift from the Hallett Charitable Trusts. Additional funding from Crow Wing County or the city of Crosby to overcome the shortfall is needed.

Crow Wing contributes more than \$509,000 in tax dollars each year to KRLS, the minimum contribution required by state law.

Crow Wing County Board Chairman Doug Houge informed the KRLS board the

county would not increase its contribution.

Except for Crosby, residents in Crow Wing County are eligible for all KRLS amenities and services. Unless they purchase a library card, Crosby residents are excluded from KRLS use, because they do not contribute to the county's library fund. Crosby's residents instead pay city taxes that support the JFHML, which is available for use by anyone in the state.

donations and set-aside reserve funds held by various agencies, they have \$30,000 in the bank toward their goal. If they reach \$55,000 or more raised this summer they can

start by building the shell. Baumann said the plan is to build the horse barn in stages, starting with the shell. The metal pole-building barn will have a grass floor, a small indoor arena for shows and 50 portable horse stalls. It will measure 60 by 150-feet with 16-ft sidewalls. Baumann plans to build the whole thing

teers and materials and is working with Cedarbrook Lumber and Hometown Lumber on the plans.

Outside, there is an existing horse arena with bleachers to the north at the fairgrounds. The covered cattle-showing area and sheep and goat barns will be relocated to the south side of the cattle

barn when the horse barn project starts taking shape.

"Now, you have to truck your horse home every night or tie them up at the fairgrounds - it's not secure and not an ideal situation," said Baumann in an interview.

The horse show and county fair season is busy now and Baumann said plans are to incorporate more shows, expanding into Western Heritage and a 4-H Buckle Series.

"We have 70 members in our Young Riders Club, of which about 50 have their own horses and others use a friend's or relative's horse," noted Baumann. "We have a really strong horse culture in the area. We really want to see this succeed – to support our kids and our community."




