

NY Main Street Grants

The NYS Office of Homes and Community Renewal awarded Livingston County Development \$500,000 in December of 2014 through the NY Main Street Program. These funds were used to renovate a total of 17 buildings in the villages of Mount Morris, Dansville and Geneseo. Owners of the renovated properties contributed nearly \$600,000 in matching funds for a total investment of over \$1 million.


"This was the first time the NY Main Street Program awarded funds that could be used in 3 different communities at once. We are unique in NYS because of the Downtown Partnership program that encompasses the entire county," commented Louise Wadsworth, Downtown Coordinator for Livingston County. "No other county has a dedicated position for downtown revitalization. To date we have completed 8 NY Main Street building renovation grants in 6 downtowns with a combined economic impact of over \$6 million in 78 projects."

Many of the projects involved dramatic changes to storefronts which included new signage, lighting, paint, windows and awnings. Before and after photos are included to demonstrate the immense changes these projects had on the businesses. 11 residential units were also improved including four newly created apartments in previously unused space.

In 2015, Livingston County was awarded \$500,000 in New York Main Street Grant funding for the Villages of Caledonia and Livonia. By the end of this year, 11 projects will be completed (4 in Livonia and 7 in Caledonia) contributing almost \$1 million of investment into these downtown districts. The Villages of Avon and Leicester will be applying for Main Street funding in this year's Consolidated Funding Application.




Since 2011, the Livingston County Industrial Development Agency (IDA) has funded the Sign and Façade Improvement Grant program for downtown districts throughout the county. To date over \$370,000 has been invested in this program which has helped to leverage approximately \$890,000 in private investment. 116 projects have been completed in nine downtowns for a total investment of \$1.2 million.



"Every time we can improve a storefront with new signage, awning or lights, we bring renewed excitement to the downtown. Often these improvements inspire more investment in the downtown or bring new business and shoppers to the area", said Louise Wadsworth.
