GINGER PEAR CHUTNEY

Ingredients

- 10 cups peeled chopped pears
- 4 cups granulated sugar
- 1 cup seedless raisin
- 1 cup finely chopped crystallized ginger
- 3 cups cider vinegar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground allspice
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves

Directions

In large preserving kettle or Dutch oven, combine all ingredients and bring to a boil, stirring frequently.

Reduce heat and simmer, uncovered, for about 1 1/2 hours, continuing to stir occasionally.

Remove from heat and pour into hot, sterilized jars, leaving 1/8 inch head space. Add lids and rings and process jars in a boiling water bath in a canner for 15 minutes. Take the canner off the heat and let water stop boiling before removing jars. Carefully remove jars and let sit. As they cool, the jars will seal themselves with a"pop". Store in cool, dry, dark place.

COLORFUL APRICOT CHUTNEY

Ingredients

3 large sweet red peppers, diced

- 12 ounces dried apricots, diced
- 1 cup raisins
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 large onion, finely chopped



CHUTTNEY

3/4 cup cider or red wine vinegar

5 garlic cloves, minced

1-1/2 teaspoons salt

1-1/2 teaspoons crushed red pepper flakes

1/4 teaspoon ground ginger

1/4 teaspoon ground cumin

1/4 teaspoon ground mustard

Directions

1. In a large heavy saucepan, combine all ingredients; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, uncovered, for 25-30 minutes or until thickened, stirring occasionally. Cover and refrigerate.

2. Serve as an accompaniment to pork or chicken. Chutney may be stored in the refrigerator for up to 1 month. Yield: 4 cups.

PEACH CHUTNEY

Ingredients

5 lbs firm peaches, peeled and chopped

1 lemon

1 2/3 cups golden raisins

1 (8 ounce) packages chopped dates

2 cups white vinegar

3 cups sugar

1/2 cup chopped pecans

1/2 cup crystallized ginger

1 teaspoon ground ginger

1/2 teaspoon ground allspice

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon ground cloves

Directions

Place peaches in a big non reactive saucepan. Cut lemon into fourths, then thinly slice.



CHUNINIEN

Add lemon slices, raisins, dates, and vinegar to peaches; bring to a boil over medium heat.

Decrease heat, and simmer 5 minutes or until peaches are soft, stirring occasionally.

Add sugar; return to a boil.

Decrease heat and simmer 15 minutes or until mixture is thickened, stirring occasionally.

Add in pecans and remaining ingredients; cook 5 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Pack chutney into hot jars, filling to ½ inch from top.

Remove air bubbles; wipe jar rims.

Cover at once with metal lids and screw on bands. Process in boiling water bath 10 minutes.

Serve with chicken or pork; store in refrigerator after opening. Yield 8 half-pints.

CRANBERRY CHUTNEY

Ingredients

4 (16-ounce) cans jellied whole-berry cranberry sauce 1 cup firmly packed light brown sugar 1 cup chopped dates 1 cup currants or raisins

1 cup slivered almonds 1 cup apple cider vinegar 1/8 cup minced crystallized ginger 1 teaspoon ground allspice

Directions

Combine all ingredients in a large Dutch oven. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly; reduce heat, and simmer, stirring occasionally, 30 minutes.



Pack chutney into hot sterilized jars, filling to 1/2 inch from top; remove air bubbles, and wipe jar rims. Cover at once with metal lids, and screw on bands. Process in boiling water bath 5 minutes. Yields 5 pints.

JEWELED PEPPER CHUTNEY

Ingredients


8 large sweet red peppers, seeded and cut into 1/4 inch cubes 4 jalapeño peppers, finely chopped 8 cloves garlic minced 2 1/2 cups cider vinegar 2 cups firmly packed brown sugar 2 cups sugar 2 cups golden raisins 1 (2 oz.) jar crystallized ginger, finely chopped

Directions


Combine all ingredients in a large Dutch oven; Bring to a boil. Reduce heat, and simmer uncovered, stirring occasionally, 1 hour and 45 minutes. Pack hot mixture in to hot sterilized half pint jars, filling to 1/2 inch from top. Remove air bubbles, and wipe jar rims. Cover at once with metal lids and screw on bands. Process in boiling water bath 10 minutes. Cool on wire racks. Yield 6 half pints.












What in the World?

Did you see that there was an alligator caught from Lake Eufaula that was over 900 pounds! Yikes, I was just in the lake myself that weekend!

Speaking of What in the World, I thought I would start a series that identifies some conditions and other findings in my world that may be informative or helpful to you. This month I'll keep it simple. In fact, many of you probably already know the answer from a long past article of mine or your own dentist has told you.

I get the question almost weekly about a crown that they have that has dark edges at the gumline. Usually it's a crown that they've had for many years and they are afraid that the tooth has "died" and turned dark. Or the patient suspects that it's a cavity that accounts for the color. While both of these causes are a possibility, most of the time it is a metal based crown that has a porcelain covering. The metal of these crowns can either be visible, or it is casting a shadow into the root surface that makes it appear dark. These days, we have great all-porcelain options that help to avoid the presence of the dark crown edges. Exceptions where metal based crowns are used include crowns that are holding partials, or

perhaps some bridges that are replacing a long span of missing teeth.
