YOU SKIPPED ONE!

Dear Dave,

My husband and I heard about your plan, but we're not sure what to do next. We have between \$400,000 and \$500,000 in a 401(k) for retirement, but we don't have any other savings. We're both *in our forties, and the only debt* we have is our house, so what should we do about Baby Steps 4 and 6?

Mary

Dear Mary,

Overall, you two have done a great job with your money. Let's go over the Baby Steps you mentioned. Baby Step 4 is putting 15 percent of your income into Roth IRAs and pre-tax retirement plans. Baby Step 6 is paying off your home early.

The thing that worries me is you've completely skipped Baby Step 3, which is having three to six months of expenses in an emergency fund. This is money set aside strictly for emergencies. The problem right now is if you have a real emergency, you may have to cash out your 401(k). If you do that, you're going to be penalized 10 percent, plus your tax rate. That's a real kick in the teeth just because you didn't do things in the right order.

advice is temporarily stop your 401(k) contributions until you get a fully funded emergency fund in place. By temporarily, I mean six to eight months at most. That way, you'll be covered when life happens without having make a big dent in your retirement savings! -Dave

graduated from college with \$20,000 in student loan debt. Her boyfriend graduated, too, and he has over \$100,000 in student loan debt. They want to get married, so she's looking for a job. He wants to go to graduate school, and take out more loans to remain a fulltime student. The idea of even more debt hanging over their heads really bothers her. Do you have any advice?

Denise

Dear Denise,

You don't throw away a great, potentially lifelong, relationship just because of debt. Things like laziness, dishonesty, and irresponsible behavior are deal breakers, though. Those are flaws that usually don't go away.

I'm glad she's looking for a job, but her boyfriend needs to be working, too. There's no excuse for either of them being full-time students with more than \$120,000 in combined student loan debt hanging over their heads. Lots of people hold down real jobs, save money, and further their educations on a part-time basis.

If she were my niece, would encourage her to have an open and honest discussion with her boyfriend about their future, and how he plans on paying for graduate school. She also needs to be very real about her feelings in this situation. If, after that, he still wants to just borrow more money and not work outside of school, then she might have a difficult decision ahead.

However, if he realizes how damaging additional debt could be to their and he's relationship, willing to work while continuing his education, I think their future together looks much brighter.







The Kidneys and How They Work

Where are the kidneys and why do we need kidneys?

The kidneys are a pair of bean-shaped organs, each about the size of your fist. They are located near the spine, below the rib cage, one on each side.

Your kidneys keep the blood clean and chemically balanced.

The kidneys filter 200 quarts of blood and produce 2 quarts of waste products and water each day. Wastes in the blood come mostly from the breakdown of food and beverages. If the kidneys did not remove these wastes, they would build up in the blood and damage the body.

The removal of wastes and water occurs in tiny structures in the kidneys called **nephrons**.

Your kidney has about a million nephrons. The nephron consists of a blood filtering component, the **glomerulus**, that keeps proteins and cells in the bloodstream and allows fluid and wastes to pass through. It is connected to a long cylindrical tube known as a tubule. A complicated chemical exchange takes place in the tubule, as waste materials and water pass along it to become urine.

The wastes and water become urine, which flows to the bladder through tubes called **ureters**. The bladder stores urine until releasing it through urination.

What are signs of kidney disease?

Many people with kidney disease do not feel sick, but may have abnormalities of one or more blood and urine tests. In other occasions, a number of signs and symptoms may develop. A few are listed below.

- Presence of blood and/or protein in the urine
- Elevation of chemicals in the blood that the kidney should remove, such as creatinine and blood urea nitrogen (also known as BUN)
- High blood pressure Swelling of hands or feet Need to urinate more often, or less often Fatigue, loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting

What causes kidney disease?

Although the cause of a kidney disease is often not known, there are many known causes such as:

- A variety of infections Immune disorders where the body attacks some of its own tissues Toxic injury due to medicines or illicit drugs use
- Abnormalities in kidney development which are particularly common in children

However, the most common causes of kidney disease are two potentially controllable diseases: diabetes and high blood pressure.

to veto, one might question why it was not good enough for President Donald Trump to sign in 2017.

Fast forward to today's proposal to replace Obamacare, and it does not do all of these things.

The bill does appear to end the individual and employer mandates. However, it replaces the individual mandate with

a "continuous coverage" penalty that insurance companies can charge, something Sen. Rand Paul (R-Ky.) warned about.

Sen. Paul was correct as it turned out. As reported by Kaiser Health News, the "continuous coverage" penalty "increases premiums for people who buy insurance if they have gone sixty-three consecutive days without a policy during the past twelve months. Their premiums would rise by 30% and that surcharge would last for a year."

So, the Republican plan to lower premiums is to increase them?

Even if you had only lapsed coverage for, say, 64 days — one day more than the provision's cutoff — you would owe the increased premiums for an entire year. Like the individual mandate, those who may be least able to afford health coverage are the ones who are penalized for not keeping coverage. This would apply to those who lose their jobs and are out of the health care market for a while. And unlike the individual mandate, there is no hardship exemption.

Does that make sense?
"The continuo

continuous coverage provision alone should be reason enough for Republicans to go back to the drawing board with this bill," Americans for Limited Government President, Rick Manning, said in a statement.

"Republicans promised to end the tyranny of the individual mandate. Instead, House Speaker Paul Ryan has made it worse by punishing those who lose their coverage because they lost their job or discontinued it because premiums got too high. This massive increase increase has the perverse effect of making it harder to

get health insurance for those who drop for whatever reason, by hiking premiums of those who attempt reenter the insurance market

by 30% as a matter of law. This is unbelievably bad," Manning explained.

"The House needs to stop what they are doing this instant and start over," Manning exclaimed.

There are other problems. The bill doesn't eliminate the additional federal funding for Medicaid expansion that was enacted in Obamacare.

Making matters worse, no one apparently checked with the Senate parliamentarian Elizabeth MacDonough to see if the insurance regulations — ordering basic plans to cover more than they might otherwise could be included in the budget reconciliation bill, according to Sen. Mike Lee speaking with the Washington Examiner's Philip Klein.

'What I understood her to say is there's no reason why an Obamacare repeal bill could not have provisions repealing the health insurance regulations," Lee said in the interview.

According to the story, "Lee also said that the parliamentarian told him it wasn't until after the unveiling of the House bill that any Republican even asked her about the possibility of repealing regulations with a simple majority."

Consider that. The whole reason House Republicans have been told they could not address the insurance regulations is because the Senate budget rules would not allow it.

But did anyone ever check? MacDonough has been there for over five years now.

Perhaps Ryan's plan to repeal 85% of Obamacare via reconciliation in 2012 was actually too low.

The legislation appears to replace exchange plan subsidies with a regime of tax credits

— which will cost \$70

billion a year once fully implemented, according to the Congressional Budget Office. The exchanges themselves remain in place. The plan also subsidizes a national, catastrophic-only

insurance plan.
Yet, if the plan had contemplated eliminating insurance regulations and, say, going across state lines to buy insurance, would anyone be talking about new federal subsidies for health insurance?

In other words, it would appear the entire new scheme of health insurance has been designed based on what Ryan thought he could get through on reconciliation. The plan tacitly acknowledges that costs will not be coming down, and so envisions subsidies via tax credits.


This is the problem. Because Ryan Republican leaders are constraining themselves to what they think can be accomplished under Senate reconciliation budget rules, they are delivering a mutant national health care system. Just pass the bill you want, and if the Senate parliamentarian objects, overrule her the same way they plan on overriding any filibuster on Neil Gorsuch for the Supreme Court.

Enough with the excuses. If Senate rules prevent good legislation from being proposed, then override those rules.

Medicare Minute

"Annual Wellness Visit"

Medicare wants you to be as healthy as possible. Because of this, Medicare offers you the opportunity to receive many of your preventive screenings and tests at no out-of-pocket cost to you. If you are in the first 12 months of starting your Part B, these benefits are called "Welcome to Medicare" visits. If you have had Part B for more than 12 months, they're called

must be followed for you to receive these benefits at no cost. The first thing to know is, **you only receive one "Wellness" visit per year.** If you go to a specialist, and they code your visit as a "Wellness" visit, you cannot go to your primary care physician and receive another "Wellness" visit. It is your responsibility to know how your visit is coded. If you do not want a visit to a specialist or primary care physician coded as a "Wellness" visit you must speak up.

Wellness" visits. There are, however, a couple of rules that

The second, and maybe the most important, thing to know is; for a visit to be coded as a "Wellness" visit it must be for preventive services only. Your "Medicare and You Handbook" states; "If you doctor or other health care provider performs additional tests or services during the same visit that aren't covered under this preventive benefit, you may have to pay coinsurance, and the Part B deductible may apply." In other words, if you are having a medical issue and go to your doctor and discuss this issue, you probably will not be able to use your "Wellness" visit and must pay your copay or coinsurance. "Wellness" visits are for preventive screenings and tests only!!

If you go to your primary care physician or specialist, and they "break the news" to you that a visit is not eligible to be coded as "Wellness", please be patient with your provider. It's not that they do not want to help you; it's that Medicare will not approve it.




