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
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



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### SOUTHWESTERN TURKEY SOUP

### Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups shredded cooked turkey
- 4 cups vegetable broth
- 1 (28 ounce) can whole peeled tomatoes
- 1 (4 ounce) can chopped green chile peppers
- 2 roma (plum) tomatoes, chopped
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed

1 tablespoon lime juice

1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper 1/2 teaspoon ground cumin



salt and pepper to taste 1 avocado - peeled, pitted and diced

1/2 teaspoon dried cilantro

1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese

### Directions

In a large pot over medium heat, combine turkey, broth, canned tomatoes, green chiles, fresh tomatoes, onion, garlic, and lime juice. Season with cayenne, cumin, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat, and simmer 15 to 20 minutes. Stir in avocado and cilantro, and simmer 15 to 20 minutes, until slightly thickened. Spoon into serving bowls, and top with shredded cheese.

### Ingredients

2 cups frozen peas and carrots 2 cups frozen green beans 1 cup sliced celery 2/3 cup butter 2/3 cup chopped onion

- 2/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon celery seed
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/2 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- 1 3/4 cups chicken broth
- 1 1/3 cups milk

4 cups cubed cooked turkey meat - light and dark meat mixed

4 (9 inch) unbaked pie crusts

### Directions

Preheat an oven to 425°.

Place the peas and carrots, green beans, and celery into a saucepan; cover with water, bring to a boil, and simmer over medium-low heat until the celery is tender, about 8 minutes. Drain the vegetables in a colander set in the sink, and set aside.

Melt the butter in a saucepan over medium heat, and cook the onion until translucent, about 5 minutes. Stir in 2/3 cup of flour, salt, black pepper, celery seed, onion powder, and Italian seasoning; slowly whisk in the chicken broth and milk until the mixture comes to a simmer and thickens. Remove from heat; stir the cooked vegetables and turkey meat into the filling until well combined.

Fit 2 pie crusts into the bottom of 2 9-inch pie dishes. Spoon half the filling into each pie crust, then top each pie with another crust. Pinch and roll the top and bottom crusts together at the edge of each pie to seal, and cut several small slits into the top of the pies with a sharp knife to release steam.



# What to do with laftover



Bake in the preheated oven until the crusts are golden brown and the filling is bubbly, 30 to 35 minutes. If the crusts are browning too quickly, cover the pies with aluminum foil after about 15 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes before serving.

### GRILLED TURKEY FLORENTINE SANDWICHES

### Ingredients

1 cup fresh mushrooms, sliced

2 tablespoons butter 1 cup fresh baby spinach 4 slices peppered bacon, cooked



4 ounces turkey breast, sliced 4 slices provolone cheese 4 slices buttermilk bread 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder butter for spreading on bread

### Directions

In a small skillet, melt 1 tablespoon butter over medium-low heat. Add mushrooms and saute until tender and slightly browned, about 5 minutes. Spread butter evenly on one side of each bread slice and sprinkle evenly with garlic powder. Layer one slice of cheese on the unbuttered side of 2 bread slices, then add the turkey, mushrooms, spinach, and bacon, dividing ingredients evenly between both sandwiches. Top each sandwich with remaining cheese slices and the bread, leaving buttered side out.



# Aunt T's Kîtchen

Melt remaining 1 tablespoon butter in a large skillet and carefully transfer sandwiches to skillet. Grill sandwiches on both sides until cheese is melted, spinach is slightly wilted, and bread is toasted to golden-brown. Slice sandwich in half and serve immediately.

# Dr. Gaunt Asks... Did You Know? "Your Hometown Dentist"

Dear Readers,

### Welcome to another installment of "What in the World"!

Have you ever had one of those places on the road that you regularly travel that just keeps getting a pot-hole? It is frustrating to say the least. It seems that no matter how many times it's filled, it just keeps coming back as if if has a major problem with you keeping coffee off your clothes on the way to work in the morning! Well I've had a similar situation with patients who come in with the question: "What in the world is going on with my lower front teeth?" What they are referring to is a common sight on the tops of the lower teeth where the edges have worn down into a kind of 'pothole' that is darkly stained and sometimes chipped and broken. After a number of years and depending on the person's bite or habits like grinding, the hard, protective enamel is worn through to the softer dentin layer. When this layer of the tooth is exposed, it can take on stain very quickly and without the protection of the enamel it can wear down into a concave shape that no longer resembles the original form of those teeth. I've often seen where the enamel will chip and break around the 'pot-hole' and require a larger filling or a crown! Sounds like the growing pot-hole in the road, huh? The good news is that we have great bonded fillings that can add that surface back to your teeth, and if done early enough, will save the wear and tear on the teeth, and keep them looking healthy!

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
