## Ingredients

2 cups elbow macaroni, uncooked
$11 / 2$ cups cubed cooked ham
1 can condensed cream of chicken soup


1/2 cup sour cream
1/2 cup Milk
1 package (10 oz) frozen broccoli spears, cooked \& drained
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1 can French fried onions

## Directions

Prepare macaroni using pkg. directions; drain. Mix macaroni \& ham; place in $9 \times 13$ " baking dish. Blend soup, sour cream, and milk together, pouring half of mixture over the macaroni and ham.
Arrange broccoli on top. Pour remaining sauce over the broccoli and sprinkle cheddar cheese on top. Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Top with french fried onions and bake 5 minutes longer.

## CALIFORNIA HAM CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

2 lbs. ham, chopped into bite size pieces
10 oz. frozen peas and carrots
8 oz . mushroom pieces
1 pkg. Lipton onion soup mix
$31 / 2$ c. boiling water


## HAM CASSEROLES

3 c. minute rice
1 c. olives, sliced
1 c. shredded Cheddar cheese

## Directions

Mix all ingredients - reserving $1 / 4$ cup sliced olives and $1 / 4$ cup shredded cheese. Bake at 375 degrees for 20 minutes. Garnish with remaining cheese and olives, and return to oven long enough to melt cheese.

## HAM / PINEAPPLE CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

1 can (20 ounces) pineapple tidbits
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon prepared mustard
$1 / 4$ teaspoon pepper
3 cups cooked rice
2 cups cubed fully cooked ham
1 cup chopped green pepper
$1-1 / 2$ cups (6 ounces) shredded Swiss cheese, divided
1/3 cup chopped onion

## Directions

1. Drain the pineapple, reserving $1 / 2$ cup juice; set pineapple aside. In a large bowl, combine the mayonnaise, salt, mustard, pepper and reserved pineapple juice; mix well. Fold in the rice, ham,

green pepper, 1 cup of Swiss cheese, onion and pineapple.
2. Transfer to a greased 2-qt. baking dish. Cover and bake at $350^{\circ}$ for 30 minutes. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake, uncovered, for 10 minutes or until heated through and the cheese is melted. Yield: 6 servings.

## HAM \& NOODLE CASSEROLE

## Ingredients:

4 cups uncooked egg noodles 1 onion, chopped
$1 / 2$ cup sour cream
1 (10.75 ounce) can
condensed cream
of chicken soup
2 cups diced cooked ham
2 cups shredded Swiss cheese salt and pepper to taste


1/4 cup dry bread crumbs

## Directions:

1. Preheat an oven to 350 degrees $F$ ( 175 degrees
C). Grease a 2 -quart casserole.
2. Cook the egg noodles according to package directions. Drain.
3. Stir the noodles, onion, sour cream, chicken soup, ham, and Swiss cheese together in a large bowl. Season with salt and pepper. Spoon into the prepared casserole. Sprinkle the top with bread crumbs.

4. Bake in the preheated oven until the casserole is bubbling and the bread crumbs have browned, about 40 minutes

## HAM ASPARAGUS CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

1 can (10 1/2 ounces) condensed Cream of Asparagus Soup
1/2 cup milk
1/4 teaspoon onion powder
1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
$1 / 1 / 2$ cups cooked cut asparagus
$11 / 2$ cups cubed cooked ham
2 1/4 cups rotini (spiral) pasta, cooked and drained (about 4 cups)
1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese or Swiss cheese (about 4 ounces)

## Directions

1 Heat the oven to $400^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.
2 Stir the soup, milk, onion powder, black pepper, asparagus, ham, pasta and $1 / 2$ cup cheese in an $11 \times 7 \times 2$-inch baking dish.
3 Bake for 25 minutes or until the ham mixture is hot and bubbling. Stir the ham mixture. Sprinkle with the remaining cheese.
4 Bake for 5 minutes or until the cheese is melted.

Stand for something. Good role models are objective and fair. Furthermore, they have the strength of their convictions. They believe what they say and say what they believe. Mark Twain may have said it best, "Action speaks louder than words but not nearly as often."
Walk the talk. Ensure that your words and actions are consistent.
Integrity matters. Good role models are open, honest, and trustworthy. Make sure to finish what you start and follow through on commitments.
Be respectful. Treat others as you want to be treated.
Believe in yourself. Be confident in who you are and what you represent. But balance that confidence with a dose of humility.
Hold people accountable. Don't accept bad behavior. Speak up against abuses. If you don't condemn poor behavior, then you're a co-conspirator. Life isn't a spectator sport.
