The Unchangeable God

Now on the TV game shows teachers proudly announce that they are living with someone they are not married to. Homosexual teachers and scout leaders proudly announce that they are married to someone of the same gender.

The Bible which is the Word of God, tells us: The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God stands forever...Forever, O LORD, your word is settled in heaven. 




is now available for use on ambulances in the Florence and Lauderdale County area.

Specialized EMS technology for bariatric patients is becoming increasingly necessary. Alabama ranked second in the country for adult obesity in a study

released in 2016 by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation.

We are seeing an increased need for specialized bariatric equipment for patient comfort and employee safety," Hargett said.

The Transafe ramp will protect our employees from back injuries due to overexertion which are prevalent in our industry."

Shoals Ambulance currently uses the Stryker bariatric stretcher which uses motorized technology to raise and lower the stretcher. This minimizes the effort required by EMTs and paramedics. The Transafe ramp will use a motorized track to load the bariatric stretcher into the ambulance allowing for an easier and more dignified transport process.





If I die and have credit card bills is my family responsible for those bills?

Fred, Russellville, AL



If it is just your credit card and no one else signed to be responsible for it then your family would not be responsible for payment.

However, if you leave an estate and an estate is opened so that property can be transferred or valued or any of the other reasons why an estate is opened, then the estate would be responsible for payment of the outstanding balance on the credit card.

Credit card companies almost always file claims against estates. Theoretically even if an estate wasn't established by your

heirs, a large creditor could file an estate so that they could then file a claim.

So the short answer is no your family is not responsible for the credit card bill but the correct answer is that if you leave an estate, the amount of the credit card debt would be paid from the estate.



Blood Pressure and Your Health

What is blood pressure?

Blood pressure is the force of blood moving through your arteries. Arteries are the blood vessels that carry blood from your heart to the rest of your body. The top number measures the force of blood in your

What do blood pressure numbers measure? Blood pressure is measured with 2 numbers.

What is a "good" blood pressure reading?

Blood pressure lower than or equal to 120/80 is ideal.

For people with diabetes or kidney disease, blood pressure lower than 130/80 is good. Lower than 120/80 is ideal.

What is high blood pressure?

High blood pressure is when your blood pressure is usually higher than it should be. It is also called hypertension. It's like a car tire with too much air in it. If the tire pressure is not lowered, there is risk for tire damage. If your high blood pressure is not lowered, there is risk for damage to your eyes, brain, heart, blood vessels, and kidneys.

Everyday Steps For Healthy Blood Pressure

- 1. Follow a healthy eating plan.
- 2. Get to and stay at a healthy weight.
- 3. Eat less salt.
- 4. Exercise.
- 5. Stop Smoking

Medicare Minute "Durable Medical Equipment"

Durable Medical Equipment are items such as walkers, wheelchairs, and hospital beds that are used in the home. Medicare will cover certain durable medical equipment only if your physician prescribes it. To be prescribed the durable medical equipment must be: durable, or reusable, used for a medical purpose, and primarily used at home. Durable medical equipment is covered under Medicare Part B.

Some examples of items that qualify as durable medical equipment are, but not limited to: Oxygen equipment and supplies, walkers, wheelchairs, hospital beds, infusion supplies, and patient lifts. Remember, these items should be used primarily at home. If you are residing in a nursing home or hospital, and that facility is providing you with Medicare covered care, it may not be considered your home. If you are staying in a skilled nursing facility, that facility will usually provide the durable medical equipment you need.

If you need durable medical equipment, make sure your doctor and durable medical equipment supplier are enrolled in Medicare. If you doctor or supplier is not enrolled, Medicare will not pay the claims they submit. Without any type of supplemental insurance, you typically will be responsible for 20% of the Medicare approved amount. Also, if you are on a Medicare Advantage Plan you may have copays or

One last thing. There are companies out there that will place outbound calls to Medicare beneficiaries offering to send you durable medical equipment or other items for free. A lady told us just last week this happened to her. The company offered to send her a knee brace at no cost. She didn't need the knee brace but they wanted to send it anyway. These companies will send you the item, then bill Medicare. Remember, nothing is free!! Someone is always paying.





Tuesday April 4, 2017 will mark the 40th anniversary of the crash of Southern Flight 242 that departed from Muscle Shoals Airport. Twenty of our friends and family members from the Shoals area boarded that plane for the short hop to the Huntsville airport.

Sixty more passengers were added to Flight 242 there to travel to their destination of Atlanta, Georgia. There were four crew on board including the pilot, co-pilot, and two flight attendants.

The plane flew into a thunderstorm that contained large hailstones that cracked the windshield of the DC- 9. Ultimately, the storm caused the shutdown of both engines after they ingested large amounts of hail and rain. After trying to restart the engines and failing, the plane became a huge glider. The pilots were desperately trying to find an airport near enough to make an emergency landing. Unfortunately, there was not one close enough and they attempted to land the plane on a two-lane highway (Hwy Spur 92) in New Hope, Georgia.

The plane hit a utility pole, a car, and a gas station before breaking apart and ending up among several trees. Only two passengers from Muscle Shoals, eighteen from Huntsville and both flight attendants survived the crash. In addition to all the other passengers. In addition to all the other passengers who didn't survive, nine New Hope residents also lost their lives.

Let's not forget the families of the victims that lost their lives on that tragic day in New Hope, Georgia so many years ago.



Most people don't even answer their phones if they do not know the number, but it's the interruptions all during the day that can unnerve even the most placid of personalities. According to ABC News, there were 859,090 complaints registered just for debt collection efforts. Imposters and Scams

Coming in 2nd with the highest complaint volume would be imposter scams. The most popular imposter scam in recent months has been a con artist posing as a government agent or a "fake IRS agent". In these scams the con artist contacts a taxpayer advising that they have been audited by the IRS and that they now owe money. If the victim does not pay immediately, they are told that they may face imprisonment, deportation or being involved in a court case. Please be aware that the IRS will NEVER contact you by phone demanding payments. If you do owe the IRS money, you will receive written correspondence from the IRS advising of amounts owed, payment options or collection efforts for defaulted amounts owed. It will be up to the taxpayer to contact the IRS to make payment arrangements, or, if ignored, the IRS may garnish bank accounts or wages. However, notice of levying against such property will be given in writing prior to such action being taken. **Identity** Theft

Rounding out the top three on the list would be identity theft. One very common identity theft problem occurs when someone's information is used to commit a fraud, such as filing a fake tax return in order to steal the tax refund. Certainly a more familiar identity theft problem would be using someone's information for credit card fraud. Other Complaints

Some of the less popular scams that still received numerous complaints are: a) sweepstakes, b) lotteries and prizes, c) shop at home/catalog sales and d) credit bureaus, (information furnishers and report users). Some things to take home from this list are always be very careful when giving out personal information on the phone to anyone. In the times that we live in, there are many people looking to make a fast buckfrom you. Before sharing information, it is prudent to google the phone number and the name of the business. You may also contact your local Better Business Bureau, state attorney general's office or the Federal Trade Commission for additional information that may be helpful as well as information regarding current scams. 





Garment Add-Ons

There was a recent news article that caught my attention concerning the small pocket in jeans that is placed just above the front pocket. I have always known one to be there on various pairs I have worn through the years, but I never stopped to consider *why* it is there. About the only thing I have ever used it for was change, but I stopped because it was too hard to get out!

The article stated that original purpose for the little pocket was not for change, but for a pocket watch. Of course, the days of pocket watches have for the most part

come and gone, but the clothing industry continues to hang on to the pocket as a kind of "fashion statement." So, in case you didn't know—now you do!

When I read the article I was reminded of a garment add-on that God commanded of His people during the Old Testament era. It served a very significant purpose and had nothing to do with a fashion statement. Here is what the Lord commanded through Moses: "Speak to the children of Israel: tell them to make tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and to put a blue thread in the tassels of the corners. And you shall have the tassel, that you may look upon it and remember all the commandments of the Lord and do them, and that you may not follow the harlotry to which your own heart and your own eyes are inclined, and that you may remember and do all My commandments and be holy for your God. I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the Lord your God" (Numbers 15:38-41).

It is interesting to think that every time the Israelites put on their garments and saw these tassels or felt the tassels brush up against them throughout the day that they would be reminded who they were and what God expected of them. In the New Testament era we do not have any such directive for tassels on our clothing. However, the command to follow the Lord's ways and "be holy" for Him has never changed (cf. 1 Peter 1:15, 16).

Hence, may all who "put on Christ" (Galatians 3:27) still be ever mindful of who we are and what the Lord expects of us. Christianity was never designed to be a "fashion statement" in this world; it is always functional and has purpose. In case you didn't know —now you do!

proposed, the moaning begins. If the pull backs are going to be impactful and responsible, some cuts will invariably be made in areas many of us hold dear.

Such is the case with the president's proposed budget for next year which could directly impact the Shoals.

A group of officials from the Shoals recently visited Alabama officials in Washington DC reiterating the importance of those federal funds slated for reduction or elimination. Community Development Block Grant Economic Admin Development Administration, and the Appalachian Regional Commission are all slated for cuts or complete Each has elimination. provided significant matching funds for water, sewer, digital, and structural upgrades in recent years.

Another national program to which we have grown locally-fond is Essential Air Services (EAS). The million dollar plus annual funding for the Northwest Alabama Regional Airport does not appear to be in jeopardy in this budget cycle, but it has been on life-support here Senators several times. and representatives have resuscitated it based on promises that we just need a couple of more years and a good carrier to reach one thousand boardings a month- which would engage greater federal funding. We need the local service to maintain respect and to have a seat at the table in any retail/industrial opportunities. Yet, we can't seem to support an airport on our own. Indeed, no carrier is interested without that ESA supplement. That is called dependency. Dependency on anyone outside of ourselves is a bad position to be in.

When the modern welfare state was created fifty years Courier President ' ago, Lyndon Johnson said,

"The days of the dole in this country are numbered."

Thať was ten trillion dollars ago. With hands out from all directions, rederal expansion is the rule rather than the exception. Which programs should be a federal responsibility and which should fall to state and local communities?

Wallet Hub 2016 data ranks Alabama as the 4th most dependent state when it comes to federal dollars returned based on federal taxes paid. We certainly take more than our share. We seem to voice approval for tighter government in elections, but we continue to want more federal dollars from the dwindling pot. Furthermore, we are anything but proactive with regard to increasing the flow of state and local revenue, and solving some of our own financial problems.

THE HEADLINES WERE FILLED LAST WEEK with the news that Congress passed a law that allows Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to sell your browsing habits to the highest bidder. Is this really something to be concerned about? Maybe,

but it's probably too early to tell. The president still has to sign it into law. Richard Shelby and Luther Strange both voted "YEA" for this, by the way.

ISPs have to "know" your browsing history. That's just part of how the Internet works. When you type an internet address into your browser, such as www. CourierJournal.net, that text leaves your computer and goes straight to the ISP's computer, then travels to the "backbone" of

and reaches the courierjournal. net website. The website then delivers its content to your ISP, and finally to your computer. All of this back-and-forth communication is logged in a file at the ISP. That means every website you visit, every file you download, every video you watch, can be logged by your ISP. To advertisers, that kind of data looks exactly like a huge, juicy hunk of Prime Rib.

SELLING YOU OUT?

It is important to remember that you have no privacy any more, anyway. Amazon, your credit card company, Google,

your cell phone company, all know more about you than you do. This act is just one more erosion of the imaginary wall of privacy that we pretend exists.

Fortunately, this new rule has some checks and balances. The first is your own inherent right to privacy. An ISP that would sell your personal data to another individual would almost certainly run into huge problems with the state and even federal attorney generals.

Some are afraid this will allow a government agency to peek into your private life. Maybe but the new law does require that the ISP

get your permission before they put you up for sale. I suppose the local police department could then potentially purchase someone's browsing history but that would probably get them into some hot Constitutional waters. Besides, it's far easier and cheaper for them to simply obtain a warrant or subpoena.

There are individuals who think they might be able to purchase someone else's browser history, perhaps even their congressman's or the president. Up until last week, that would have required a court order but now, theoretically at least, this could happen. However, ISPs already have their own internal privacy policies that they place on themselves. I know, the fox watching the henhouse, but they do exist and reputable ISPs do enforce them because they hate bad publicity.

But this measure absolutely will

allow ISPs to sell certain types of data that other online businesses have enjoyed for a long time. If Pizza Hut wants to contact everyone in Florence that has visited Domino's Pizza website, that's possible now. If you're concerned about this, I can't blame you. The best way to combat this is to contact your lawmakers.







How Can You Tell How Bad My COPD Is?

commonly asked questions One question I often get asked by patients is how bad their COPD The question is not straightforward because there are different ways to say "how bad something is" in COPD. For example, how how advanced your COPD is. how much the COPD is keeping you from doing your regular everyday activities. Another way to describe how advanced COPD is in somebody is by calculating how likely their COPD is going to take their life in a given period of time. I do feel that it is important that both life down the road. One way the physician and patient know all three of these things, as it gives us a great overall idea of how we can manage their COPD.

I will first talk about how the testing that we usually use is called spirometry and most COPD patients are familiar with this. As part of pulmonary function testing, patients are asked attached to a computer as quickly as possible to get all their breath out. What the computer measures is how much air you were able to get out in that short period of time. The physician is especially interested in how much air you can get out in that first second (we call that the FEV1). The lower that FEV1 number is, the more advanced you COPD. In fact, there is a staging system called the GOLD staging system that can tell you what stage your COPD is based on how that FEV1 number looks. Stage 1 is considered the earliest stage, while stage 4 is considered the worst stage.

I mentioned that we can also look to see how the

This week on House Calls, COPD is affecting somebody I continue my series on physically and their ability to do everyday activities. One regarding the lung disease way that we do this is through questionnaires where patients rate how much shortness of breath they have doing certain activities. Another way we check this is by physically seeing how much exercise a patient with COPD can do, especially walking. We call bad somebody's lung function this test a 6-minute walk test, is can be one way to describe where a patient walks back and forth on a level floor. How However, so is documenting much distance the patient walks during that time and their symptoms are recorded as part of the test. The less a patient can walk during the test, the worse their exercise capacity is.

Finally, we can also determine how likely the COPD is to take someone's to do this is by calculating something called a BODE index. A BODE index is a combined measurement of a patient's FEV1 score on pulmonary function we measure lung function test, their result on a six-in patients with COPD. The minute walk test, the score of a questionnaire on their breathing symptoms and their body-mass index (a measurement of your weight compared to your height). The score of this BODE index to breathe out into a device calculates how likely the COPD will take someone's life within the next 52 months (a little over 4 years). This information can be very helpful to both patient and doctor. As always, please consult with your primary provider health before implementing any advice given in this column.







Mapes to the HOF

It's true that most members that are sports Hall of Fame inductees come from the ranks of coaches, football, basketball and baseball athletes. It's always refreshing when an athlete outside the realm of those attributes get their due recognition. Such was the case a few weeks ago when Chris Mapes was inducted into the 2017 class of the Lauderdale County Sports Hall of Fame.

Mapes became a world wide class swimmer during his athletic career. He joined the Florence Swim Team at the age of 13 in 1966. For four years, he combined his talents with the Bradshaw and Florence swim teams.

Mapes held numerous records in the breaststroke competition in the state, southeast and in the nation. In 1970 he was listed by the United States Amateur Athletics Union among those swimming the 10 best times

nationally in two events.

He posted the best time in the 110-yard breaststroke and second best time in the 220-yard breaststroke. In addition to those honors, Mapes was selected to the 1971 high school All-American swim team. After high school, Mapes signed a scholarship with North Carolina State and continued his success with the Wolfpack.

Mapes broke Atlantic Coast Conference records in the 100 and 200 yards breaststroke. He was named an All-American his freshman and junior years at North Carolina State. His ultimate recognition for his outstanding swimming career came a few weeks ago when he became a member of the 2017 Lauderdale County Sports Hall of Fame.
