**Josephine and JJ Palermo
with son Vinnie**

Over a hundred years, ago a wonderful man was born in an upstairs bedroom at 29 Grove Street, Mount Morris to Sicilian Immigrants, Vincent and Francesca Palermo. At that time no one would imagine that he would die in the same home he was born in. He was fortunate to live his whole life in the same home with the exception of his service to our country. JJ Palermo died 100 years, 4 months and 4 days after his birth. He left an impact on us all.

Many have heard or read the book "The Greatest Generation" by Tom Brokaw. You would swear this book was written about JJ. We all could learn so much from JJ. If there were more people like JJ, the world would be a better place.

JJ, as most of us called him, acquired that name when he began school at Saint Patrick's Catholic School. He had a first cousin named Joseph Palermo in the same class as him. So, to avoid confusion, the Nuns (as we all know, you don't mess with the Nuns) renamed our Joseph as JJ and his cousin as JC. Those nick names stuck with each of them the rest of their lives.

These two Josephs were not just cousins. In fact, they were more like best friends their entire lives. His wife Josie, of course, usually called him "J" a great deal of the time.

After High School, JJ worked in the canning factory along with his father and brothers. When JJ was younger, his father saw him pick up one 16" brick up at a time. He finally said to JJ, "God gave you two hands and 2 arms." He wanted JJ carrying 2 bricks at a time.

From 1940 to 1945, JJ served his country in the Army. I will forever be grateful to you JJ as you helped give me, and us all here, what we have today, our freedom. JJ served in the Big Red 1 1st Infantry Division and traveled overseas and back on the Queen Mary. He, of course, enjoyed his Bass Beer. He was very fortunate to have this beer many years later as his son Vinnie found it for him. On JJ's uniform, he has 7 bars signifying the 7 major battles in which he fought. During the Battle of the Bulge, JJ and many of his comrades yearned for a clean pair of socks, warm hay or a straw bed. He also learned to drink coffee as hot as it came. Many of us would be putting cream in it to cool it down. Not JJ. Nothing was too hot for him.

Many of us say it is a small world. That is so true, even in the Military. While serving overseas, JJ ran into a few of the locals. Tony Gerace in Sicily, Boo DiPasquale in Italy and Pat Montemerano in a field hospital while on rest. JJ, being the loving caring person he was, was asked to volunteer the next day along with others. JJ of course, said yes. Pat said no. Pat ended up being captured 2 days later and spent the rest of the war as a POW. I always knew JJ was smart.

After returning from the war, JJ told me that he was having the time of his life working, spending time with family and friends. He spent time in Buffalo. On one of his visits to Buffalo around 1955, he saw a young woman. He knew at that point he was going to marry her. Mind you, years before, this sweet lady lived up the road from him in Mount Morris.

On November 15, 1958, JJ's wish came true and he married the love of his life, Josephine Coniglio. He would always say, "That's my Josie". She was by his side until the very end, 58 years later. The love he had for Josie is something you cannot buy. It was real and every time he looked at her, you could always feel the love.

A year after JJ was married, Josie made JJ's life complete when she gave him a son. JJ's face would always brighten right up when he talked about Vinnie. He told me the story several times about how badly Vinnie wanted to go to the University of Rochester. JJ made sure it happened because of the love he had for Vinnie.

56 years, 364 days after they married, their beautiful granddaughter Valerie was married. They loved her so very much and could not be happier that her anniversary would be so very close to theirs. JJ loved Valerie more than anyone could imagine.

JJ retired from Letchworth State Park as a Mason. I always look at many of the walls and buildings and wonder if JJ's hands had touched them. He enjoyed his retirement, spending the time of his life with his beautiful wife, family and friends. His brothers and sisters-in-law were more like brothers and sisters to him. Nancy proved that these past several months. She has been such a rock. Many of his friends were like family. I remember JJ saying they would go to Sam Cipriano's on Christmas Eve for a drink before leaving to drive and spend Christmas with family. He also had a love for his church. Bob Donovan was, in every essence, like a brother to JJ.

A testament of JJ's life came this past year. After he turned 100, the Town of Mount Morris gave him a plaque, declaring October 23rd Joseph Palermo Day. It was a well deserved honor.

I have so many memories of JJ. One in particular was getting pulled over in Rochester with JJ and Josie in the car because the inspection had run out. The officer must have known better. She took one look at JJ and Josie and let us off. No ticket. Another was taking JJ for coffee and goodies while Josie was shopping. Most of all, I remember watching that sweet man sit on the front porch. So many cars never stopped and that always bothered him. He could have written all the plates down. Seeing him at Mass and him smiling at us made me smile. How could you not?

He really could have balanced the village budget if we had given him a pen and paper.

Anyone who knows me knows that it takes 45 minutes and 2 cups of coffee for me to realize I am vertical in the morning. Shortly after JJ passed, while taking my dogs out, I was looking at the sky. Above JJ's house was a cloud that looked like it had wings. I knew then that JJ was now our Angel and was looking over us all.

Valerie, embrace life like your Grandpa did and continue to do the right things. You were and will always be his little girl. He loved you so very much. Vinnie, he could not be prouder of the man that you became. You were always the best son a dad could ever ask for. Josie, you were everything to JJ. Like I said earlier, his love for you just radiated and comes once in a lifetime. He would have never made it this far without you.
