Chicken with Caribbean Pecan Sauce

April is National Pecan Month, and it's one of the good-for-you nuts. The pecan lends this recipe some real trop-

- ounces skinned and boned uncooked chicken breast, cut into 4 pieces
- cup unsweetened orange juice
- tablespoons cornstarch cup Splenda Granular
- (8-ounce) can crushed pineapple, packed in fruit iuice, undrained (11-ounce) can mandarin
- oranges, rinsed and drained tablespoons chopped pecans
- teaspoons dried parsley flakes
- teaspoons dried onion flakes
- 1. In a large skillet sprayed with butter-flavored cooking spray, brown chicken pieces for 4 to 5 minutes on each side. Meanwhile, in a covered jar, combine orange juice, cornstarch and Splenda. Shake well to blend. Pour mixture into a medium saucepan sprayed with butter-flavored cooking spray. Stir in undrained pineapple. Cook over medium heat until mixture thickens, stirring constantly.
- 2. Remove from heat. Add mandarin oranges, pecans, parsley flakes and onion flakes. Mix well to combine. Evenly spoon sauce mixture over browned chicken pieces.
- 3, Lower heat and simmer for 5 minutes. When serving, evenly spoon sauce over chicken pieces. Serves 4.
- Each serving equals: 253 calories, 5g fat, 24g protein, 28g carbohydrate, 61mg sodium, 26mg calcium, 1g fiber; Diabetic exchanges: 3 Meat, 1 Fruit; Carb Choices: 2.

Marble Paper Eggs Using Shaving Cream

While the older kids are busy coloring Easter eggs, your preschoolers will enjoy this tactile and fun way to make marbled paper eggs using an unlikely art supply: shaving cream! When complete, enjoy the artsy egg-shaped designs as decor in your home. Make a large one to hang on a door, and cut out minis for a charming garland to display just about anywhere!



Here's what you'll need:

- -2-by-4-inch piece of corrugated cardboard
- -16 toothpicks
- -9-by-13-inch baking tray or pan with edges -Shaving cream
- Liquid food coloring, poster paint or acrylic paint, diluted 1 part paint to 2 parts water
- -Heavy-duty white construction paper
- -Squeegee
- Scissors, ribbon and craft supplies for decorating eggs

Here's the fun:

1. First, make a tool for swirling the color. Poke ends of the toothpicks 1/4 inch apart into the gaps of one

long side of the piece of corrugated

cardboard. The toothpicks should fit

snugly in the cardboard, to resemble

- 2. Spray shaving cream in the baking tray or pan. Kids will have fun playing with it as you guide them to level it out
- with their hands. 3. Drop two to three different colors of food coloring or diluted acrylic paint on top of the shaving cream. (When using paint, I use small spoons or an eyedropper saved for crafts when transferring paint to the shaving cream.) The tray should now be filled with blobs of irregular colorful polka
- 4. Use the toothpick "comb" to make a few swirls down and across the paint. Aim to make the designs on the surface of the shaving cream rather than dragging the colors too deep. Your child might say with delight, "Hey,

I'm combing shaving cream!' 5. Immediately set a sheet of paper on the design, bringing the

left and right sides up slightly. Press gently all over the paper, then lift. Let set for a minute or two, then, using the squeegee, remove the shaving cream in one smooth motion into the sink to reveal a beautiful marbled design. Rinse the squeegee. Let paper dry completely. Add more coloring or paint to make more designs.

6. Cut marbled paper into a large Easter egg shape. Decorate with a few craft supplies if you wish. Punch a hole at the

top and tie a string for hanging. Or, make small egg shapes and glue to a long string or ribbon for a springtime

NOTE: Remind young children that although the shaving cream may look like whipping cream, it is not edible.

Growing Your First Apple Tree

(NAPSA)—According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, each American eats about 120 apples a year.

sits about an inch above the surrounding soil level.
• Mulch around the tree

root. About an inch or two of mulch helps keep the weeds out and the moisture in.

As Interest In Backyard Poultry Grows, So Does Need For Healthy Birds

(NAPSA)—Raising "backyard poultry" has become increasingly popular all over the U.S. these days. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) reminds both new and experienced poultry owners it's important to keep your birds healthy by practicing backyard biosecurity.

While "biosecurity" may not be a common household word, for poultry and bird owners it can spell the difference between health and disease. Practicing biosecurity can help keep disease away from farms and backyard pens and keep birds healthy. By using biosecurity practices, poultry owners can help reduce the chances of their birds being exposed to infectious poultry diseases such as avian influenza.

According to Dr. Fidelis Hegngi, senior staff veterinarian with USDA's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, backyard biosecurity means doing everything needed to protect birds from disease-similar to what people do every day to protect themselves from human infections-essentially good hygiene.

"That's what protects us from germs—we wash our hands, avoid contact with people who have colds and flu, and we cover our mouths and noses when we sneeze," says Dr. Hegngi. "If you follow basic hygiene activities with your birds, you'll go a long way to keeping your birds safe from disease.

By taking a few simple steps, vou can protect your birds. Dr. Hegngi recommends bird owners wash their hands thoroughly with soap, water and disinfectant before and after handling birds. When you're through working with your birds, disinfect your



shoes and equipment. Cages, food and water should be cleaned daily. Poultry owners should remove feed from bags; place it in clean, sealed containers; and throw the bags away. Finally, bird owners should not borrow or share bird supplies. If they must, items should be cleaned and disinfected before being brought home.

Be sure to isolate new birds you bring in from your other birds for at least 30 days. You should restrict access to your birds, especially from people who own birds that are housed outside. Keep your birds away from other birds whenever possible.

Look your flock over regularly so you can watch for signs of illness or unexpected deaths among your birds. Report sick birds or die-offs to the local cooperative extension office, a veterinarian, State Veterinarian, State animal diagnostic laboratory or USDA Veterinary Services toll free at (866) 536-7593.







Hints For The Home

In Pursuit Of The Perfect View

(NAPSA)—Getting windows clean and sparkly doesn't have to be that hard.

Store-bought window cleaning solutions can work well but are not necessary for great results. Old-fashioned household cleaners are plentiful in most homes and

Experts at Andersen Windows have some suggestions on how to clean your windows to the envy of your neighbors. First, begin with the right stuff: rubber gloves, two buckets or one bucket with two wells: sudsy ammonia cleaner: white vinegar; rubbing alcohol; several clean, dry rags; a squeegee; coffee filters; and a ladder, if necessary.

Now follow these steps to a

1. Read and follow manufacturer's instructions on each cleaning agent and all tools before beginning. In addition, use extreme caution when using ladders and working around open windows to maintain safe operation and avoid injury. Don't stand on furniture; use only equipment intended for that purpose, including ladders, scaffolding and step stools. Follow instructions for safe operation.

2. Fill both buckets with one to two gallons of the hottest water your gloved hands can stand. Use caution in handling hot water to avoid burns and scalding. This is your wash and rinse water.

3. In one bucket, add one cup each of ammonia and vinegar. In the other bucket, add two tablespoons of rubbing alcohol. The latter helps water evaporate quickly and gives windows that twinkle factor.

4. To avoid dripping on your work, start at the top; top floor, top of the window.

5. Wipe the entire surface with the sudsy solution. Bugs, stickers and other stubborn marks may be removed using a synthetic scraping tool. Avoid straight-edge metal blades, as they can damage the 6. Rinse the window using

clean water and immediately



It's a bright idea to clean windows on cloudy but dry days. Sunlight dries the solution too quickly and makes streaks more likely.

squeegee any remaining. Start at the top, pressing firmly in a vertical motion and drying the squeegee with each stroke. This reduces streaks from wet lines forming at the squeegee's edge and limits drips from wet tools on your sparkling windows.

7. Use a clean cloth to wipe only the corners and sill. If lint is a problem, use a coffee filterthey're lint free-to touch up these areas.

Some extra tips:

• Never leave a window unattended, especially when children are present. Falls may result in serious injury or death.

·Swipe in only one direction, horizontal or vertical, on the inside of the house and the other direction on the outside. If you find streaks, you'll know which side needs touching up. Coffee filters are good for this, too

• Change water often to limit or eliminate streaks.

• Tie a rope to your squeegee and secure it to the ladder or your belt in case you drop it.

· Clean windows on cloudy, dry days. Sunlight may dry the solution too quickly, making streaks more likely.

Isn't It Dangerous to Give Pets Yeast?

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: You recently told a cat owner that it was OK to give her pet yeast as a supplement. Yeast is supposed to be very bad for pets. Why did you recommend it? — Concerned in Cincinnati

DEAR CONCERNED: This is a great opportunity to discuss the difference between live yeast and brewer's or nutritional yeast

You're right that live yeast, particularly dough leavened with yeast, can be a danger to pets. If, for example, your cat gets up on the kitchen counter where your soon-to-be loaf of bread is rising, and eats the raw dough, trouble could be brewing. That dough may continue to rise in its stomach, and could cause a blockage in the digestive system that, if not treated immediately, could be fatal.

Brewer's or nutritional yeast, on the other hand, is a "dead" yeast. Once it has been propagated (grown) in a medium like molasses (for nutritional yeast) or as part of the beer-brewing process (for brewer's yeast), it's pas-teurized and dried. This stops the yeast from multiplying, while retaining its nutrients, like B vitamins. Brewer's yeast has either a powder or flake consistency, unlike active yeast, which is packaged as small granules.

The amount of brewer's yeast to give

a pet depends on its weight. Follow the dosage instructions on the package typically the yeast is mixed in with a pet's food.

Most pet formulations of brewer's yeast also contain powdered garlic, which is said to help ward off fleas and ticks. Garlic can be toxic to cats and dogs, making it doubly important to follow instructions exactly and contact the vet immediately if a pet consumes

Celebrating 110 Years Of The Race That Changed Everything (NAPS)—There's more to the

old adage "If at first you don't succeed, try, try again" than many people realize.

For example, consider the automobile pioneer Henry Ford. For him, the motto was quite appropriate, because while on his way to creating one of the most successful automobile companies in the world, he suffered his share of setbacks that included the failure of the Detroit Automobile Company in January 1901. He was 38 vears old, married with one son and, after losing \$86,000 in the failed venture, he was broke. He had to move in with his father, William, and plan the next move toward achieving his dream of owning a car company.

"He knew that racing grabbed the public imagination and it just so happened that one of the biggest races in the country was being planned practically in Henry Ford's backyard," recalled Edsel B. Ford II. "I don't think it was my great-grandfather's intention to ever win this race. He couldn't afford to hire anyone, so he had to drive his own car. He had never raced before and he was up against the greatest driver in the country.

That greatest driver, Alexander Winton, proved to be Ford's lone competition on Oct. 10, 1901 as 8,000 fans came to the Detroit Driving Club to watch. All the other competitors dropped out when their vehicles failed to start, so the main event essentially became a 10-lap match race with the winner receiving \$1,000.

Even though Winton jumped to a big early lead, Ford slowly be-

gan to close the gap. As the cars

raced past the front stretch grand-stand on the eighth lap, Winton's car began to sputter and Ford took the lead for good in front of a cheering crowd. "It was a thrilling moment. It was an historic moment and a

moment that identified Henry Ford as a winner worth watching," said Edsel Ford. "After he drove into the winner's circle, a great crowd of spectators crowded him and shouted that they were willing to back him in any venture that involved wheels."

Now, Ford Racing is celebrat-

ing that momentous day by highlighting great moments in its storied history at www.fordracing 110.com.

In addition, fans can learn about the ongoing search for the trophy Ford won that day—a cutglass punch bowl that was sold at auction following his death in 1947. Now, Edsel Ford wants it back. He launched a search 10 years ago but failed to find it. So for a Ford of today, it's time to try,

HOLLYWOOD - "Feud: Bette & Joan" is the most-watched FX show since "The People vs O.J. Simpson," which only proves people still love old movie stars. Joan Crawford wanted to work with Bette Davis since their Warner Brothers Studios days in 1945. Joan knew the two of them together would be box-office magic. But Davis' no-nonsense Broadway training was the opposite of Crawford's Hollywood hype and phony press-release practices

In 1962, Crawford scrambled to make a comeback, and she sent the book, "Whatever Happened to Baby Jane," to producer Robert Aldrich, as a vehicle for her and Bette Davis. But she didn't count on the studio deliberately fueling a fire between them to get more heat for the film. When it opened in New York City, the studio provided a tour bus for them to travel to the 26 theaters, but Crawford wouldn't ride in the bus saying, "Stars don't ride in

This infuriated Davis. I wrangled my way onto the bus, and when I asked where Crawford was, everyone pointed to the back of the bus. I finally saw her, through the back window, following the bus in a limo. Bette ranted the entire time, from theater to theater!



YOUR GARDEN **Plant A Healing Garden**

(NAPSA)—Here's an idea that's growing in popularity: Plant a garden to help you or someone you care about heal physically, spiritually or emotionally.

For most of history, gardens have had a strong relationship to health and healing. Today, people use healing gardens to restore the body, spirit and mind. Gardens create a sense of calm, balance, hope and inspiration, which greatly improve the recovery process. A healing garden is an opportunity to observe and be a part of the life cycle, giving a sense of purpose and fulfillment. Gardens offer fresh air, exercise and sunlight, important for reducing stress, anxiety and depression.

In fact, doctors at the Jupiter Medical Center in Florida discovered that patients who had a view of the healing garden from their rooms took less pain medication and had shorter hospital stays than those without such a view.

Healing gardens are often used to help women in their battles against breast cancer. That's important, since the National Cancer Institute estimates that one in eight women will be diagnosed with breast cancer at some point during her lifetime. When planting a home healing

garden, consider the following to maximize its healing qualities:

• Overall layout: Include places to sit and reflect, pray, meditate or relax, such as a wooden swing. Picture what calms or inspires you and include these elements and items. A small pond, garden art, wind chimes, even interesting rocks might add to your garden's tranquility. Enclose



with pretty pink plants such as the Invincibelle Spirit Hydrangea.

it with shrubs or fencing to create a secluded retreat and include paths for walking.

 Aromatic plants: Sweetsmelling plants can enhance the relaxing atmosphere. Plant herbs such as basil, rosemary, sage, lemon thyme or lavender. Surround your garden with scented trees, such as pine and eucalyptus, to create shade and shelter. A new compact, reblooming lilac, called Bloomerang, has clusters of purple-pink, sweet-scented flowers, making it excellent for creating a fragrant hedge.

• Healing plants: Include medicinal plants to symbolize the health aspects of your garden. Lavender, sage, basil, thyme and St.-John's-wort have been prized for centuries for their medicinal qualities. Fruits and vegetables can symbolize—and supply—nutrition. For example, the fruit of Sambucus, also called elderberry, is rich in antioxidants. An elderberry called Black Lace has intense purpleblack, finely cut foliage. Its fruit

can be used in jam or even wine.

• Attracting wildlife: Add a birdbath, bird feeders or birdhouses and put in plants that attract butterflies. A new shrub. Lo & Behold Blue Chip buddleia, attracts flocks of butterflies as well as hummingbirds. It's the only miniature butterfly bush with loads of fragrant blue flowers that bloom continuously.

• Color: Plants with bright colors can lift the spirits. To show support for overcoming breast cancer, consider pink flowers. A newly available choice, Invincibelle Spirit Hydrangea, is the very first pink-flowered "Annabelle" hydrangea. You can see more than 100 blooms on a single plant. Its dark-pink buds open to hot-pink flowers, which mature to a soft pink. • On April 17, 1964, the Ford Mustang is officially unveiled by Henry Ford II at the World's Fair in Flushing Meadows, New York. The new car debuted in Ford showrooms on the same day, and almost 22,000 Mustangs were immediately snapped up by buyers.






