

College Advice From The 'Experts' Who've Been There



Only 60 percent of college freshmen will graduate within 6 years according to the latest report from the National Center for Educational Statistics. That's pretty scary stuff for college-bound students and their tuition-paying parents — especially if loans are part of the financial formula.

Even for those students who make it to graduation, there may be some question as to whether they made the most of their time on campus.

As this Northern Michigan University senior reflects, "There I was, about to graduate with some random degree and feeling like I'd wasted my parents money."

And from a University of Florida senior: "The problem with college is that you figure it out about the time you're ready to graduate."

Helping college students "figure it out" sooner rather than later is what the latest edition of the awarding-winning "Been There, Should've Done That — 995+ Tips for Making the Most of College," (Front Porch Press) continues to do. The 4th edition again draws from interviews with seasoned collegians across the U.S. According to author, Suzette Tyler, a former academic adviser at Michigan State University, "their 'expert' advice is refreshingly insightful and often more encompassing than might be found in an adviser's office."

"I could talk until I was blue in the face about things like time-management and self-discipline," Tyler explains, "but when a fellow student says, 'I got great grades and I never missed a party and here's how to do it,' it has far more impact.

Here are some tips from 'the experts':

- "The first few weeks are great. You're meeting people, partying ... no tests, no papers. Then ... WHAM! Everything's due in the same week! If you weren't hitting the books right along, you'll spend the rest of the term digging yourself out!" - Senior, University of California, Santa Cruz
- "Gather all the syllabi during the first week of classes and write down the due date for every single paper, project, test or whatever. You'll see instantly which weeks are potential killers." - Junior, Wake Forest
- "Sitting in a classroom is the easiest part of college and it cuts study time in half. Why make it hard on yourself? GO!" - Senior, University of Iowa
- "What separated me from the masses was 'connecting' with a faculty member. I didn't even know what the possibilities were until he laid out a 'roadmap' and showed me a few shortcuts to get there. When my confidence was shaky, he reminded me that I could do it." - Graduate, University of Michigan.
- "Pick the professor, not the time of day." Junior, Duke University
- "Get a job in the office of your major. You'll get to know everyone from the secretaries to the dean, all of whom can be very helpful. If any great opportunities come along, you'll be the first to know." - Senior, Indiana University
- "There's no reason to fail! There are people here to help and it's free. Actually, you've paid for it so you might as well use it." - Senior, Michigan State University

"The students who make the most of their college experience aren't necessarily the smartest ones. It's often the average kids who know how to utilize the system, connect with the professors, take advantage of extracurricular activities, and manage their time well who reap the rewards," Tyler says. "Been There, Should've Done That" can help students get all they can out of the next four years.



APRIL IS NATIONAL SAFE DIGGING MONTH

Danville Utilities wants to remind you that it is **STATE LAW** to call 811 before **y**ou start digging around your property for that spring project. When you call 811 a professional locator will come out to your property and locate all underground utilities that you may not know about, such as buried water, phone, electric, and gas lines. This service is free and can help you avoid a costly and possible dangerous excavation accident. When you call you must wait the required time (3 days) before digging, so plan ahead. Call by Tuesday to dig on Saturday.



Remember to always call before you dig, no matter how large or small your project is, if you



CARBON MONOXIDE

Incomplete combustion of any fuel produces carbon monoxide. Carbon monoxide is poisonous and has no odor.taste or color. Carbon monoxide detectors are very helpful in the detection of this harmful gas but they are no substitute for using gas burning appliances or apurtances properly. This includes having them serviced and inspected once a year by a certified contractor.

Possible symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning;

- Dull headache
- Weakness
- Dizziness Nausea and vomiting
- Chest pain
- Confusion
- Impaired judgment and irritability

WHAT TO DO IF YOU SUSPECT **A GAS LEAK**

Look for blowing dirt or continued bubbling of standing water.

Listen for loud hissing or roaring sound near natural gas appliances or lines.

Smell for the distinctive rotten-egg scent, act even if it is a small amount.

Leave the area at once if you detect a leak. Do not try to locate or fix the leak.

Call Danville Utilities at 434-799-5284 or 911 once you are safely away from the area. Stay away until a Danville Utilities representative or emergency personel indicate it is safe.

Remember while near a possible gas leak, do not touch or use anything that could cause a spark, such as lighters, matches, flashlights, light switches and telephones including cell phones.





REACH VET

We have yet another handy veterans-related acronym: REACH VET. That stands for Recovery Engagement And Coordination for Health -- Veterans Enhanced Treatment, and although you can't tell from the title, the goal of the initiative is to reduce the rate of veteran suicides.

While any effort is to be applauded, the numbers just aren't getting much better. Here are the averages for some recent years:

2001 -- 19 per day 2010 -- 21 per day

2012 -- 22 per day

2014 -- 20 per day

Yes, the Department of Veterans Affairs has taken steps, but it clearly isn't enough. We have the 24/7 Veterans Crisis Line for immediate help by phone, chat room and text message (1-800-273-8255, press 1) or online at www.VeteransCrisisLine. net or text 838255. We have analytics to predict who's at risk so providers can intervene. We have Tele Mental Health services for remote help. We have a PTSD phone app with self-management tools.

It's not enough. It's not enough because you can't fix a problem until you know exactly what it is. Getting correct numbers requires the data input from a great many locations. Each report that comes out assesses the numbers in a different way: by age group, drug and alcohol use, gender, era of service and comparison to the civilian population. The number that's hard to deal with is that no matter what, the rate of veteran suicide per day isn't significantly changing. Then there are those who say the daily veteran suicide rate is closer to 35.

One VA-provided stat offers hope: Those who are under the VA's care have a lower rate of risk for suicide. It's a huge decrease. If you're a veteran who's on drugs, who feels isolated, who has extreme mood swings -- go to the VA. Get help.

- 1 cup canned beets, drained 1/2 cup reduced-fat buttermilk, divided
- 1/2 teaspoon white vinegar 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3/4 cup, plus 2 tablespoons, unbleached all-purpose flour
 - 6 tablespoons unsweetened natural cocoa, plus 1-2 tablespoons for decorating
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder

- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/3 cup canola oil, chilled
- 3/4 cup sugar 1 large egg, cold
- Cream Cheese Frosting: 2/3 cup confectioners' sugar

4 tablespoons reduced-fat cream cheese

1/2-1 teaspoon vanilla extract Heat oven to 350 F. Drop paper liners into 12-cavity muffin pan.

Working knife up and down in measuring cup, coarsely chop beets. Place beets in blender, add 1/4 cup buttermilk and blend until beets are finely chopped. Add remaining buttermilk, vinegar and vanilla and blend to puree. Set beet mixture aside.

In small bowl, combine flour, 6 tablespoons cocoa, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon and salt, and set aside.

In medium bowl, combine oil and sugar. With hand mixer on medium speed, mix until sugar is evenly moistened. Add cold egg and beat on high until mixture resembles mayonnaise and sugar is almost completely dissolved, 90 seconds. Add beet mixture and beat until combined. Sift dry ingredients into bowl and mix, either on low speed or by hand

until combined with wet ingredients.

Divide batter evenly among lined muffin cups, filling them about two-thirds full.

Bake cupcakes 28-30 minutes, or until tops feel springy. Immediately transfer cupcakes to wire rack and cool completely before frosting. Ice cupcakes, using about 1 table-

spoon frosting for each. Place remaining cocoa in strainer and sprinkle over frosted cupcakes. If desired, let cupcakes sit at room temperature to allow frosting to set, about 2 hours.

Note: Frosted cupcakes can sit at room temperature for up to 12 hours.

To make Cream Cheese Frosting: In small bowl, work sugar and cream cheese together with wooden spoon or hand mixer until combined. Mix

in vanilla.

Note: Frosting is best when refrigerated 8 hours or overnight, loosely covered, before using. It keeps in refrigerator

About Autism

Autism is a general term used to describe a group of complex developmental brain disorders - autism spectrum disorders - caused by a combination of genes and environmental influences. These disorders are characterized, in varying degrees, by communication difficulties, social and behavioral challenges, as well as repetitive behaviors. An estimated one in 68 children in the U.S. is on the autism spectrum – a 78 percent increase in six years that is only partly explained by improved diagnosis.

DCC Speaker Brings Justice To The "Disappeared"

Danville, Va., April 14, 2017 — Danville Community College hosted renowned speaker and cultural anthropologist Fredy Peccerelli for a guest lecture on Thursday, April 13, in Oliver Hall about his organization's efforts to identify the bodies of more than 40,000 "disappeared" Guatemalan citizens from the country's 1960-1996 civil

Peccerelli founded an organization called the Forensic Anthropology Foundation of Guatemala (FAFG) to use DNA, archaeology, and storytelling to assist families with finding the previously unidentified bodies of their loved ones after he learned about cultural anthropology in college.

"It's a sobering task, but it can bring peace of mind — and sometimes, justice," Peccerelli explained.



Peccerelli delivered a TED Talk in 2014, available at ted.com, about his efforts to bring closure to the families of 40,000 of the more than 200,000 Guatemalan citizens who were killed during the Latin American country's 36-year civil war from 1960 to 1996. These 40,000 victims were never found and are referred to as the "disappeared."

La Comisión para el Esclarecimiento Histórico (CEH) or Guatemala's Historical Clarification Commission was formed in 1994 and produced much of the data and reports upon which FAFG's work is based.

According to FAFG's website, "El informe de CEH revela que 'La Desaparición Forzada fue una violación a los derechos humanos que se registró a lo largo de todo el período de duración del enfrentamiento armado."

Translated, the statement indicates that "Forced disappearance was a violation of human rights that was recorded throughout the entire duration of the armed confrontation."

For 36 years, family members, friends, coworkers, and others seemingly vanished with no explanation and no path to healing for those left behind.

On Thursday, Peccerelli talked to DCC students, faculty, and staff about what happened to the thousands of "disappeared" people and that they were mostly executed or forced into slave labor before being executed. During the question-and-answer session at the end of the lecture, he explained that he doesn't believe his work brings closure to families, but that it does create a pathway to healing and, in some cases, justice.

Starting in the mid-1990s, the "disappeared" began to be located in unmarked mass graves with very little identifying information to connect them with the CEH dossier. Enter Peccerelli and FAFG, who work to provide solace to the families of the "disappeared" and to provide evidence for the trials of those involved in their deaths.

Peccerelli was born in Guatemala, but he and his family fled to Brooklyn, New York, when he was nine years old after his father received threats from a death squad in 1980.

Peccerelli also talked about an upcoming Steven Spielberg documentary, Finding Oscar, which debuted on April 14 at select theatres in the United States.





THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- * On May 1, 1926, Ford Motor Company becomes one of the first companies in America to adopt a five-day, 40-hour week for its automotive factory workers. Other manufacturers soon followed Ford's lead, and the Monday-to-Friday workweek became standard.
- * On May 7, 1945, Gen. Alfred Jodl of the German High Command signs the unconditional surrender of German forces. Jodl had hoped to limit the terms of German surrender, but Allied commander Gen. Dwight Eisenhower demanded complete surrender.
- * On May 3, 1952, a ski-modified U.S. Air Force C-47 becomes the first aircraft to land on the North Pole. Lt. Col. Joseph Fletcher walked to the exact geographic North Pole, probably the first person ever to do so.
- * On May 2, 1964, an explosion of a charge assumed to have been placed by Viet Cong terrorists sinks the USNS Card at its dock in Saigon. No one was injured and the ship was eventually raised and repaired.
- * On May 4, 1970, National Guardsmen open fire on a group of unarmed antiwar demonstrators at Kent State University in Ohio, killing four students and wounding nine. The nearest casualty was 20 yards away. A federal court later dropped all charges against eight Ohio National Guardsmen.
- * On May 5, 1776, British Lt. Gen. Henry Clinton issues a proclamation denouncing North Carolina patriots' "wicked rebellion" and recommends that the inhabitants return their allegiance to the king. Although he offered full pardons to all persons, it was not a success and he abandoned the area.
- * On May 6, 1994, a rail tunnel under the English Channel officially opens, connecting Britain and the European mainland for the first time since the Ice Age. The "Chunnel" runs below the seabed for 23 miles. Each day, about 30,000 people, 6,000 cars and 3,500 trucks journey through the Chunnel.



CHICKEN LO MEIN

Here's an "Americanized" version of a classic Chinese dish that has a great flavor of the Orient!

1 (14-ounce) can Swanson Lower Sodium Fat Free Chicken Broth

■ 2 tablespoon reduced-sodium soy sauce

¹ 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger


1. In a large skillet, combine chicken broth, soy sauce, ginger and garlic. Bring mixture to a boil. Stir in vegetables and uncooked spaghetti. Continue cooking for 8 to 12 minutes or until vegetables are just tender, stirring occasionally. Add chicken. Mix well to combine.

2. Continue cooking until mixture is heated through and vegetables and spaghetti are tender, stirring often. When serving, top each dish with 1 tablespoon green onion. Makes 4 (1 cup) servings.

TIPS: 1) Thaw vegetables by rinsing in a colander under hot water for one minute. 2) If you don't have leftovers, purchase a chunk of cooked chicken breast from your local deli.




