

LIBERTY HAS CONCRETE BELLS

Tumbleweed Smith



Liberty, Texas has an exact replica of the original liberty bell in Philadelphia. It hung for a long time in a downtown plaza and was rung on special occasions. The bell is inoperative now due to damage from hurricanes. Various fundraisers are in place to get the bell repaired.

Tumbleweed Smith Bill Brackin of Liberty has a lake house in Jacksonville, which is known as the tomato capital of the United States. All over town concrete tomatoes are displayed in front of businesses and homes. These are giant tomatoes weighing hundreds of pounds and decorated in different colors and designs. Some offices or stores put their business names on the tomatoes and place them at the entrance of their

Bill was in Jacksonville at a time when he was looking for a fundraiser for his Rotary club. He's been a Rotarian 33 years.

"All of a sudden when I saw those concrete tomatoes it just kind of rung a bell with me. I thought it would be a great idea to have bells made of concrete and sell them to residences and businesses in Liberty."

He searched Google and discovered that Texas Tradition Molds in Lufkin makes molded concrete.

"I called and said what I wanted to make and the person I talked to was very interested and said the company could make the concrete bells. It just so happens that Liberty National Bank had just come out with a commemorative mug in the shape of the Liberty Bell. I sent one of these and asked if it was possible to make a replica in concrete. I said it must weigh at least 300 pounds so it can't be stolen and I want it to be at least three feet tall so if a lawyer buys one the name of the firm or street address can go on the bell."

Personnel at the company said they could comply with the requirements and sent Bill a design.

"I showed it to the Rotary club and the members gave their enthusiastic approval. We made sure we had Rotary International on the back of the bells, which sell for \$300. Half goes to Rotary, half goes to repair the city's

When word from the company came that a sample bell was ready, Bill drove to Lufkin to pick it up.

"I loaded it on the back of my trailer, took it to the Rotary meeting and all the Rotarians got to come out and look at it. I was a little nervous but the bell looked so good I just knew they would like it and of course they did. We pre-sold approximately 20 bells right away." Now the concrete bells are all over Liberty.

"I enjoy driving through town and seeing the ideas people have come up with."





The first day of Spring 2017 was March 20 and Easter fell on Sunday April 16. Within the four weeks between those important dates, many of us gardeners anticipated the hazards of the season... frost, hail or damaging conditions....to harm our cultivated patches. Guess what...so far they haven't. Most of us have been blessed instead with smiles from heaven, and rewarded with verdant growth. Here's a few peeks at Nature in her everyday clothes.





Been a good Spring for Poke Salad. It's everywhere. Pick the leaves when young. Go ahead and put it through two par-boilings and change water between each, before finally cooking it to your taste. The extra step may not actually be necessary health-wise, but some of us remain obedient to the traditional ways anyhow. A meal or two of poke salad serves as a tonic and improves sluggish "wintertime" bowels. I checked the fencepost on Easter weekend and sure enough, the bluebird is nesting there. The female Eastern Bluebird lays 4-5 eggs, one per day, in loose nests or natural cavities in tree trunks. The eggs hatch after 11-19 days of incubation, and babies stay in the nest about 19 days. After learning to fly, the young remain with their parents in family groups before relocating as mature birds. A pair may raise 2-3 broods per year.





Sandy-land garden and young peach tree.

The Brashear area of Hopkins County has sandy land and grows great gardens and fruit trees. This photo shows the onions at the right, which have been vigorous and are now making nice large bulbs. The cabbage and broccoli took off well and quickly doubled then tripled in height and width. Squash, on the left, came up from seed in a hurry, made sturdy roots and is setting blooms. The new little peach tree is barely waist-high and is covered with 200 or more peaches, some now about as big as a regular-size peach seed and turning a rosy red. I don't know how all these peaches can possibly mature, but even in high winds with the last storm, they all stayed on their stems. I also don't know what variety of peach this is, because it was a rescue tree. It came up in a neighbor's flowerbed from a seed and got too big for it's space She dug it up and gave me the tree, but had cut most of the roots. It lived anyway, and is now at home in full sun in sandy soil. I'm getting my peach ice cream recipe ready.
