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

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

NOODLES FLORENTINE

Ingredients

5 cups uncooked medium egg noodles

2 tablespoons butter

2 tablespoons all-purpose flour

1 cup milk

1 package (10 ounces) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and squeezed dry

1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg Salt and pepper to taste

1 cup (4 ounces) shredded Swiss cheese

Directions

1. In a large saucepan, cook noodles according to package directions until tender.

2. In another saucepan, melt butter; stir in flour until smooth. Gradually add milk. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in the spinach, nutmeg, salt and pepper. Drain noodles. Add to spinach mixture; toss gently to coat.

3. Transfer to a greased shallow 2-qt. baking dish; sprinkle with cheese. Cover and bake at 350° for 20 minutes or until heated through. Yield: 4 servings.

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FANCY FRENCH BEANS

Ingredients

4 cups frozen French-style green beans

1 cup canned bean sprouts

1 can (8 ounces) sliced water chestnuts, drained

2 tablespoons butter

2 tablespoons all-purpose flour

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/8 teaspoon pepper

Dash cayenne pepper

1-1/2 cups half-and-half cream

1/2 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1/2 cup sliced almonds

1/4 cup shredded Swiss cheese

1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese

Directions

1. Cook beans according to package directions. Add bean sprouts and water chestnuts; heat through. Drain well and set aside. In a saucepan, melt butter. Stir in flour, salt, pepper and cayenne until smooth. Gradually add cream. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Add Worcestershire sauce and bean mixture; toss to coat. Pour into a greased 2-qt. baking dish. Combine almonds and cheese; sprinkle over the top. Broil 4-6 in. from the heat for 5 minutes or until almonds are golden brown and cheese is bubbly. Yield: 6-8 servings.

CREAMY MINT CARROTS

Ingredients

2 to 2-1/2 pounds carrots, thinly sliced

1 teaspoon cornstarch

2 teaspoons cold water

1 cup heavy whipping cream

1/4 cup packed brown sugar



SIDES

2 to 3 tablespoons minced fresh mint or 2 to 3 teaspoons dried mint

2 tablespoons butter

1 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

Directions

1. Place carrots in a saucepan; cover with water. Bring to a boil; reduce heat. Cover and simmer for 10 minutes or until crisp-tender; drain. In a small bowl, combine cornstarch and water until smooth. In a small saucepan over medium heat, bring cream to a boil. Stir in cornstarch mixture. Cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in the remaining ingredients. Pour over carrots. Yield: 8 servings.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS SUPREME

Ingredients

1 pound fresh brussels sprouts, trimmed

1 cup chopped celery

2 tablespoons butter

2 tablespoons all-purpose flour 1 cup milk

1/2 cup process cheese

(Velveeta) 1/4 teaspoon salt

Pinch cayenne pepper, optional

Directions

1. Cut an X in the core of each brussels sprout. Place brussels sprouts, celery and a small amount of water in a large saucepan; cover and cook for 8-9 minutes or until crisp-tender.

2. Meanwhile, in another large saucepan, melt butter. Stir in flour until smooth. Gradually add milk; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Add cheese, salt and cayenne if desired; stir until cheese is melted. Drain brussels sprouts and celery; top with cheese sauce. Yield: 4-6 servings.

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PARMESAN ONION BAKE

Ingredients

6 medium onions, sliced 1 cup diced celery 8 tablespoons butter, divided

1/4 cup all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon pepper
1-1/2 cups milk
1/3 cup grated Parmesan
cheese



Claybank Master Gardeners



The Claybank Mater Gardeners' Plant Sale on April 1st, along with the Ozark-Dale County Library Book and Bake Sale, was a great success, thanks to a weather-perfect day

bringing out many shoppers. All proceeds went directly to the library, which provides so many great services for our community.

Now that summertime heat is cranking up, your outdoor plants, especially potted ones, will be needing more watering, once or twice a week for most plant types. Try to water just the soil below the leaves. Avoid wetting the leaves. Watering the leaves is an invitation to viral and fungal diseases. If you have automatic sprinkler systems, watering early in the morning before the sun gets high, will give the leaves time to dry off before nighttime dampness, and will help keep away diseases. Mulch the soil with pine straw or leaves, to help cool the root systems. Yellowing or curling leaves may be helped by spraying with Epsom salts (magnesium sulfate), one tablespoon per gallon of water. Magnesium strengthens the cellular structure of the plants. Sprinkle 2 tablespoons around the base of the plant for more protection. Google "Epsom Salt in



the garden" for some more great tips. The Master Gardener monthly one hour Lunch and Learn workshops have been well-attended and provide interesting and helpful information plus new research findings on each topic. Last month's tomato growing presentation was very informative, and as usual,

many of the participants shared their own successes and failures. The next Lunch and Learn topic, on May 10th, "Controlling Weeds in the Garden", will be presented by Dale County Extension Coordinator Thomas Agee, from 12 noon to 1 PM, at 202 South Hwy 123 in Ozark next to the AGPlex Arena. 




