t was an angel of a counselor who suggested attending the Day by Day Grief Support Group for one year. It was some of the best advice the Hargett's had ever received. Norman and Nena Hargett lost their fun-loving, handsome, basketball star, Robert, when his battle with drugs became too much to bear. The unforgettable year was 1989 and he was 23 years old.

They have never regretted the love and energy given in this role for the last 24 years.

Day by Day offers grief support for mothers, fathers, siblings, and other family members since everyone grieves differently. The group has various topics to help the bereaved including handling the holidays and steps to making progress. They meet every second Sunday of the month at 2pm in the Woodmont Baptist East Campus

building. There are two major events every year that are particularly

particularly therapeutic for parents and families that are held at Crosspoint Church of Christ.

The first is the balloon release on the second Sunday in October. The child's picture

along with the parent's information is attached to the balloon. It instructs the person who finds the balloon to contact the parents if the balloon is found. Balloons have been found in several states ranging from Mississippi to North Carolina.

The other big event is the Candlelight Ceremony in December where a candle is lit in memory of the child. The child's picture is displayed on a large screen and the family is recognized. Last year approximately 450 people were in attendance.

## Medicare Minute "Medicare"

When I began working with Medicare health plans a few years ago it became obvious to me that people aging into Medicare were joining a health insurance program that they really didn't understand. Although the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) do all they can to educate Americans about the benefits of Medicare, it still isn't enough for them to fully understand what they have as far as medical coverage through the federal government. Over the past year, we have discussed many aspects of Medicare but we have also picked up a lot of new readers along the way. Whether you are new to Medicare or have had Medicare for years it's good to know the basics.

On July 30, 1965, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed into law the bill, Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, which led to the establishment of Medicare. The original bill included Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Part B (Medical Insurance). Today we know these 2 parts as "Original Medicare". In the beginning Medicare was created to provide health insurance to people 65 years of age and older, regardless of income or medical history.

Over the past five decades changes have been made as to who qualifies for Medicare. In addition to people over the age of 65 Medicare now covers people under the age of 65 who are permanently disabled and have been receiving Social Security Disability Insurance for 24 months. Also anyone at any age can receive Medicare if they have End Stage Renal Disease or ALS.

Although Medicare provides medical coverage for those who qualify it is not 100% coverage!! We often hear "once I go on Medicare my medical insurance worries are over." Medicare has deductibles and coinsurance that the Medicare beneficiary is responsible for unless the beneficiary has additional coverage to supplement Medicare.



He has a sizable estate but does not have a Will. My mother (his sister) passed away six years ago. Her name is on his life insurance policies and the beneficiary to all his money. I have three brothers and just wanted to know if his estate should go to me and my brothers?

When there is a Will, property and money is distributed according to the terms of the Will. When there is not a Will, property and money is distributed under the laws of intestate succession. When there is a Will, the estate is probated. When there is not a Will, an estate is administered.

It is always better to have a Will because that saves the estate the cost of a bond and if the estate is not finished within the first year, then another bond must be purchased.

As you've heard on television, the State does have a Will that is written for

everyone and that is known as intestate succession. In Alabama, intestate succession provides that if there is a surviving spouse, the spouse would get a certain amount of money in value and that amount changes if the decedent (person who died and left the estate) and the surviving spouse together had children. If all of the children were by the decedent and the surviving spouse the spouse gets more. If the decedent has a surviving spouse and children that are not the issue (children of) the surviving spouse, then the surviving spouse receives less allowing for more to go to the surviving children of the person who died.

If there is no spouse, then to the children, if no children then to the parents, and if there are no children or parents, then to the aunts and uncles and so forth. You can read the rules at Alabama Code §43-8-41 and §43-8-42.

The way that the legislature is set up "the Will the State wrote for you" or intestate succession is about as rational and well thought out as any group of people could come up with. Remember that life insurance and investment accounts are

Remember that life insurance and investment accounts are going to be distributed according to the contract under which they are made. If your uncle left his life insurance to your mom and she has passed away, I would think that the money would be paid to her estate and distributed according to the terms of her Will or the rules of intestate succession. Remember that a home is usually held in a deed that provides that the survivor of a marriage gets the property. No matter what a Will provides, the deed controls the disposition of the property. ## **Diabetic Kidney Disease**

#### Diabetic Kidney Disease

Diabetes is a major risk factor for kidney disease. People with diabetes should be tested for kidney disease every year. Diabetic kidney disease is a decrease in kidney function that occurs in some people who have diabetes. Steps to control blood sugar and blood pressure will help those who already have diabetic kidney disease to avoid complications. The causes of diabetic kidney disease are complex and most likely related to many factors. About 30% of the people with Type I diabetes and about 10-40% of people with Type II diabetes will eventually develop end-stage kidney failure, requiring treatment to maintain life.

### What is diabetes?

Diabetes happens when your body does not make enough insulin or cannot use insulin properly. Insulin controls how much sugar is in your blood. A high level can cause problems in many parts of the body: heart, kidneys, eyes and brain.

#### What is Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD)?

When you have kidney disease, it means that the kidneys have been damaged. Kidneys can get damaged from a disease like diabetes. Once your kidneys are damaged, they cannot filter your blood nor do other jobs as well such as balancing the body's fluids, keeping blood pressure under control, help making red blood cells and removing waste products from the body. Over time, loss of kidney function can become life-threatening and can lead to kidney failure.

### How does diabetes affect the kidneys?

Over time, having high blood sugar from diabetes can cause damage inside your kidneys. Your kidneys contain filters that are filled with tiny blood vessels. High sugar levels in the blood can cause these blood vessels to become narrow and clogged. When the blood vessels in the kidneys are injured, your kidneys cannot clean your blood properly. As more damage happens, the kidneys will have less function causing waste to build up and your body will retain more water and salt than it should.

Diabetes can also cause damage to the nerves in your body, making it hard to empty your bladder. The pressure of the full bladder can back up and injure the kidneys.

#### How likely am I to get kidney disease?

About one-third of people with diabetes will get kidney disease. Diabetes is the leading cause of kidney disease and kidney failure. Some groups of people such as African Americans, Hispanics, and Native Americans have a higher risk of developing kidney disease and kidney failure from diabetes. However, there are steps you can take to lessen your risk.

• Keeping your blood sugar in control can help keep you from getting kidney disease. Having high blood sugar is a major risk factor for diabetes. The best way to prevent or slow kidney damage is to keep your blood

sugar well controlled. This is usually done with diet, exercise, and if needed, insulin or hypoglycemic pills to lower your blood sugar level.

- Controlling high blood pressure High blood pressure is one of the major factors that puts people with diabetes at risk for kidney disease. Keeping your blood pressure at the level your doctor suggests can help stop you from getting kidney disease.
- Keeping cholesterol and lipids levels under control. Control of blood lipids is important because it may slow down the progression of atherosclerosis within the kidneys and also in other blood vessels. In people with CKD, heart disease is very common.

### How do I know if I have kidney damage?

Most people with early kidney damage do not have symptoms. Not everyone with kidney disease get kidney failure. With the right treatment, you can prevent kidney disease from getting worse.

- The best way to find early kidney damage is to have a urine test once a year. This test checks for very small amounts of protein in the urine called albuminuria. It helps show kidney damage at an early stage in people with diabetes.
- A simple blood test to estimate GFR (Glomerular Filtration Rate). Your GFR number tells you how well your kidneys are working. Your GFR is estimated from a simple blood test for a waste product called creatinine.

New Treatments: Some studies suggest that a group of high blood pressure medicines called ACE inhibitors may help to prevent or delay the progression of diabetic kidney disease. These drugs reduce blood pressure in your body, and they may lower the pressure within the kidney's filtering apparatus (the glomerulus). They also seem to have beneficial effects that are unrelated to changes in blood pressure. Patients who take these medicines may have less protein in their urine.

That doesn't mean you should throw your metformin pills in the garbage. It is a wonderful drug for treating diabetes, it is simply advised that your B12 should be monitored periodically while on this medication.

So what are the symptoms of not having enough B12 in your system? As B12 is important for helping to produce red blood cells, anemia and fatigue can commonly happen in the setting of deficiency. Another common effect of having low B12 is the development of nerve damage. This commonly shows up in a patient as peripheral neuropathy, which is nerve damage that happens on the nerves important for sensation in your extremities. 

According the to Research Congressional Service, we have had eighteen government shutdowns in the last four decades. Most people are unaware of that fact. There was a shutdown in 1979 over congress wanting to give itself a raise. Jimmy Carter had five shutdowns, three of which were in 1977. Ronald Reagan had eight in his eight years. We had two between November/1995 and January/1996. The second was for 21 days. It furloughed in excess of 280,000 federal workers. Another 400,000 worked without pay for a short time. That was before the vindictive media and the era of social media, so it was a yawner for the

general public. That '95/'96 shutdown was also beneficial for both parties. Bill Clinton was able to balance his budget for a fourth consecutive That had not vear. happened since the 1920's and it got him reelected. The republicans showed they actually had some gumption on budget issues when they wanted to show it. That allowed them to retain both the house and senate in 1996 after the 1994 election conquest.

We may have a real government shutdown at some point, but it won't be from an annual budget vote. It would be based on one of a few other situations: We could have a financial recoil because of our incessant urge to live beyond our financial means or our hugely over-inflated stock market. We could be subjected to a military or electrical grid attack. We could be overtaken from within by an overthrow of the government. I would have said that was virtually impossible a year ago, but



We must work with China on resolving this situation and on the Chinese encroachment in the South China Sea and the trade deficit imbalance. At this juncture, the North Korean nuclear missile program is of primary concern. China can bring pressure on North Korea to stop its development of these weapons systems by reducing its trade with North Korea.

One area of trade that comes to mind is the large quantity of coal China imports from North Korea. It is estimated this amounts to 22 million tons per year which is 40% of North Korea's coal exports. A reduction in the importation of North Korean coal would significantly impact the North Korean economy, and could force it to change its position on arms

### **Do We Practice What We Preach?**

One of the best-selling books of all time was published in 1896 coming from the pen of Charles Monroe Sheldon. It carries the title, In His Steps. The title of the book comes from 1 Peter 2:21 where Peter is writing to encourage Christians that were hurting because of difficult situations. He reminded them that Jesus also suffered and wrote, "For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that we should follow His steps." In a nutshell, Sheldon's book is based on an incident

that caused a preacher to challenge his congregation for one full year to ask themselves, before they made any decision, "What would Jesus do?" In fact, the complete title of the book is, In His Steps: What Would Jesus Do? So, the WWJD bracelets, etc. of recent fame take their cue from a thought that has been around for a long time.

The book has become a classic and can still be easily purchased today. Through the years it has sold over 30 million copies. But Sheldon's story does not end with the conclusion of his book. Little did he know how personal the message of the book would become to his own life. What happened is that the book's publisher failed to register the copyright properly which allowed other publishers to take advantage and also publish the book without paying any royalties. This basically caused Sheldon to be cheated out of a fortune. Little did he realize how challenged he would be to follow "In His steps."

Let us turn our thoughts back to the text of 1 Peter which speaks of the mistreatment of Jesus and see what He did. The passage continues, "Who [Jesus] committed no sin, nor was deceit found in his mouth'; who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges *righteously..."* (1 Peter 2:22, 23).

Did Jesus have the power to take matters into His own hands? We know He did! But instead, he put the matter into the hands of the Heavenly Father. Why? Because He taught his listeners by word and example that they were to obey the law of God. And in dealing with such matters the law stated that vengeance belonged to God (Deuteronomy 32:35; Romans 12:19). Hence, Jesus practiced what he preached.

While telling others about the ways of God is not always an easy task; "practicing what we preach" is truly a far greater task! Jesus lived the example before us perfectly! How well are we doing what He did?
