New DVDs Reviewed in This Column Will be Released the Week of May 8, 2017



Fifty Shades Darker (R) second installment in the movie franchise based on the obscenely well-sold erotica books offers more less-wild-than-you'd-think sex scenes packaged in a degradingly dumb romantic plot.

In the last movie, Ana (Dakota Johnson) ditched chiseled billionaire bedroom badboy Christian (Jamie Dornan) after things got a little rough. Now he really wants her back, and Ana can barely say no before giving in to whatever Stubbleface McMoneybags wants.

To try to develop the plot this time around, producers deftly avoided giving Ana or Christian any kind of depth or meaningful shift in their relationship Instead, there's a plot with Ana's aggressive lawsuit-liability of a boss. Ana says she wants independence, before handing control of her life and career to Chris

in exchange for lavish wealth and sexy times in a really nice shower.

Things to Come (R) years of marriage, Nathalie (Isabelle Huppert) learns that her husband (Andre Marcon) is moving in with his much-younger lover. Nathalie still has "intellectual fulfillment" as a professor of philosophy, with strong bonds to her adult children and former students. As she explores the newfound freedom she didn't ask for, a former student (Roman Kolinka) appears as a potential romance. Nathalie also must care for her ailing mother (Edith Scob) grappling with dementia.

Huppert's performance already has award rumors popping up, as she handles a strong and complicated character. There's a fine balance between coping with loss while embracing new beginnings and facing life's ongoing struggles. All the while, Huppert gives a performance of stern intellect mixed with human vulnerability.

Void (R) - This low-budget love letter to 1980s horror traps a smalltown cop (Aaron Poole) and a bunch of Canadian locals in a hospital sur rounded by robed knife-wielding cultists. The night really takes a turn when people in the hospital start turning into twisted shape-shifting gore monsters, a la 1982's "The Thing." As a true fan of that cinematic classic, this reviewer was impressed by the dedication to practical effects, and the confirmation that using good ol' rubber parts and fake blood makes better horror than any CGI. Too bad the plot's a bit top-heavy and the characters aren't as



fleshed-out as the fleshy monsters.

A Street Cat Named Bob (Not Rated) — James Bowen (James Treadaway) lived on the streets, strumming his guitar for money between methadone treatments and meetings with his addiction counselor (Joanne Frog gatt). As James starts to piece a life together in a new apartment, a rambunctious orange cat breaks into his – and into his heart. Dubbing him Bob, the cat and human help each other through their respective recoveries. Based on the best-selling memoir by the real-life Bowen, it's predictability puts up barriers around many of the sentimental moments in the uplifting drama checklist. Cats are good at get ting around barriers though, and Bob defies you not to be charmed by him.





Made without mayo, this company-worthy combo of egg, shrimp and potato salad gets its creaminess from a tangy yogurt-and-mustard dressing. Plate it alongside fresh-picked peas tossed in a light lemon-dill vinaigrette.

- lemon
- sprigs fresh dill ounces large shrimp (16- to 20-count)
- ounces Yukon gold potatoes
- Salt and pepper ounces sugar snap peas

bare simmer; cook 3 minutes or until shrimp just turn opaque throughout. Drain, rinse under cold water until cool, and drain again. Discard lemon rind and dill sprigs.

3. In same pan, place potatoes and enough cold water to cover. Add 1 teaspoon salt. Heat to boiling on high, cover and reduce heat to simmer 15 minutes or until just tender; drain well.

4. While potatoes cook, heat 3-quart saucepan of water to boiling on high. Add snap peas and frozen peas. Cook 2 minutes or until bright-green; drain

5. In large bowl, whisk yogurt, mustard, 1 tablespoon lemon juice, and 1/4 teaspoon each salt and freshly ground black pepper. Add hot potatoes, onion, celery, shrimp, eggs and half of chopped dill. Fold gently until well-combined.

6. In another large bowl, whisk vinegar, oil, remaining 2 tablespoons lemon juice and 1/8 teaspoon each salt and ground black pepper; add all peas and remaining dill. Toss until well-coated.

7. Spoon shrimp salad into center of serving platter, then spoon pea mixture all around. Garnish with reserved egg quarters and serve immediately.

neurologists are the experts in dystonia. The neurologist will have an opinion on trying a different form of botulinum toxin, as well as other treatments.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm a 61-year-old woman who was diagnosed with notalgia paresthetica about five years ago. Several years later, my general practitioner told me to use capsaicin, which helps with the tingling feeling, but sometimes it feels like someone is pinching my spine and the skin tingles, bringing on a very uncomfortable feeling. Can you tell me any more about this skin condition? I am beginning to believe that it is getting worse. — Anon.

ANSWER: Notalgia paresthetica is common, but often not diagnosed, and usually causes an itching under one shoulder blade. It sometimes is associated with curvature of the spine (scoliosis). It isn't curable, and often gets better and worse. Capsaicin, lidocaine patch and other creams usually some relief. Botulinum toxin and nerve block occasionally are used for people with more severe symptoms who don't respond.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 79-year-old male with mild Parkinson's disease and Type 2 diabetes. I can walk about 10 feet before becoming terribly short of breath and weak. I have been this way for several years, and it has become increasingly worse. Can you help me? — K.C.

ANSWER: Neither Parkinson's disease nor Type 2 diabetes explains terrible shortness of breath on mild exertion. Severe shortness of breath can come from serious heart or lung problems (many types) or severe anemia. I can't help: Get to your doctor right away.

Botox Can Ease Blepharospasm

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have been contending with blepharospasm for years. I got some relief from Botox for around four years, but then it stopped working and my doctor moved me to Dysport, which was horrible. It did not relax my symptoms, and it made me constantly very uncomfortable (with a feeling that my eyes were swollen all the time).

stopped the treatments and have been able to cope, until the past six months. I am almost unable to read. look at a computer screen or drive. Do you have any suggestions? I use Ativan to try to relax the stress of the blinking, but even that has lost its effect. I have been discouraged from getting a limited myectomy because of the risks. My ophthalmologist said that a neurologist would be a waste of time. I am desperate for another opinion. — B.B.

ANSWER: Blepharospasm is an uncontrollable muscle spasm around the eyes, often causing blinking and twitching. It ranges from occasional and mild to the much more severe and disabling condition you report. Treatment with botulinum toxin is

effective for most people. Botulinum toxin, directly injected into muscle, weakens or paralyzes the muscle. There are three types of botulinum toxin A currently available in the United States: Botox, Dysport and Xeomin, as well as botulinum toxin B (Myobloc). I suspect your ophthalmologist changed brands because of the concern of antibodies your body may have developed to the Botox.

I would never say that a neurologist would be a waste of time. Blepharospasm is a limited form of dystonia, and

Five Years Dead

Five years ago, Aaron Hernandez was one of the brightest prospective players in the NFL, a 22-year-old allpro tight end out of the University of Florida who had just signed a lucrative five-year, \$40 million contract with the perennial champion New England Patriots.

During that span of time, if Aaron Hernandez had chosen to walk a different path, barring injuries, he would have made the playoffs all five of those years and would be wearing two Super Bowl rings. More than likely, he would be negotiating an extension. On April 19, he'd be joining his teammates at the White House, celebrating their latest Super Bowl victory.

Instead, sometime during the early morning of April 19, Aaron Hernandez hanged himself inside his cell at the Souza-Baranowski Correctional Center in Lancaster, Massachusetts, where he was imprisoned for life for murder, five days after being acquitted in a separate double murder trial.

Think about that for a moment. The man could have made millions ... won two Super Bowls as part of the best TE super tandem in NFL history with Rob Gronkowski, lived happily ever after with his pretty fiancee and beautiful daughter in their mansion with in-ground pool, but he thought this was the better path to take:

—July 16, 2012: Two men, Dan-

iel de Abreu and Safiro Furtado, are shot to death in their car as they wait at a red light in Boston's South End neighborhood.

-August 27, 2012: Hernandez signs a five-year, \$40 million contract with the New England Patriots.

-February 2013: An associate, Alexander Bradley, is shot in the face in Florida. Bradley files a lawsuit alleging that Hernandez shot him after they argued at a strip club. -June 17, 2013: The body of Odin

Lloyd, a semi-professional football player who was dating the sister of Hernandez's fiancee, is found about a mile from Hernandez's mansion in North Attleborough, Massachusetts. -June 26, 2013: Hernandez

is arrested on a murder charge in Lloyd's slaying and later pleads not guilty. The Patriots release him hours after his arrest.

-May 15, 2014: Hernandez is indicted on two counts of first-degree murder and other charges in connection with the shootings of de Abreu and Furtado. -May 28, 2014: Hernandez

pleads not guilty to charges in connection with the deaths of de Abreu and Furtado.

-Jan. 9, 2015: Hernandez goes on trial for murder in Lloyd's killing.

-April 15, 2015: Hernandez is convicted of first-degree murder; carries a mandatory sentence of life imprisonment.

-Feb. 14, 2017: Hernandez goes on trial for murder in the 2012 killings of Daniel de Abreu and Safiro Furtado.

—April 7, 2017: The jury begins

deliberating.

—April 14, 2017: Hernandez is acquitted of murder in the 2012 killings of Daniel de Abreu and Safiro Furtado -April 19, 2017: Hangs himself at

age 27.

This is a bizarre world, and the world of sports is supposed to offer you an escape. I have no words to convey how truly sad I am that Aaron Hernandez turned out to be such a disappointment. May God have mercy on his soul and bless his daughter and family.







Five Years Dead

Five years ago, Aaron Hernandez was one of the brightest prospective players in the NFL, a 22-year-old allpro tight end out of the University of Florida who had just signed a lucrative five-year, \$40 million contract with the perennial champion New England Patriots. During that span of time, if Aar-

on Hernandez had chosen to walk a different path, barring injuries, he would have made the playoffs all five of those years and would be wearing two Super Bowl rings. More than likely, he would be negotiating an extension. On April 19, he'd be joining his teammates at the White House, celebrating their latest Super Bowl victory.

Instead, sometime during the ear-

ly morning of April 19, Aaron Hernandez hanged himself inside his cell at the Souza-Baranowski Correctional Center in Lancaster, Massachusetts, where he was impris-oned for life for murder, five days after being acquitted in a separate double murder trial.

Think about that for a moment. The man could have made millions ... won two Super Bowls as part of the best TE super tandem in NFL history with Rob Gronkowski, lived happily ever after with his pretty fiancee and beautiful daughter in their mansion with in-ground pool, but he thought His was the better path to take:
—July 16, 2012: Two men, Daniel de Abreu and Safiro Furtado, are

shot to death in their car as they wait at a red light in Boston's South End neighborhood.
—August 27, 2012: Hernandez signs a five-year, \$40 million con-

tract with the New England Patriots.

—February 2013: An associate

Alexander Bradley, is shot in the face in Florida. Bradley files a lawsuit alleging that Hernandez shot him after they argued at a strip club. -June 17, 2013: The body of Odin

Lloyd, a semi-professional football

player who was dating the sister of Hernandez's fiancee, is found about a mile from Hernandez's mansion in North Attleborough, Massachusetts. is arrested on a murder charge in

Lloyd's slaying and later pleads not guilty. The Patriots release him hours after his arrest. —May 15, 2014: Hernandez is indicted on two counts of first-de-

gree murder and other charges in connection with the shootings of de Abreu and Furtado.
—May 28, 2014: Hernandez pleads not guilty to charges in connection with the deaths of de Abreu

and Furtado.
—Jan. 9, 2015: Hernandez goes on trial for murder in Lloyd's killing.

—April 15, 2015: Hernandez is convicted of first-degree murder: carries a mandatory sentence of life imprisonment.

-Feb. 14, 2017: Hernandez goes on trial for murder in the 2012 killings of Daniel de Abreu and Safiro Furtado.

-April 7, 2017: The jury begins

deliberating.

—April 14, 2017: Hernandez is acquitted of murder in the 2012 killings of Daniel de Abreu and Safiro Furtado.


-April 19, 2017: Hangs himself at age 27.

Financial Aid for Pet Care

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I have two cats, one of whom suffers from a number of health conditions, including diabetes. The cost of her care is way more than that of my other cat, but I will pay it no matter what. Still, it's sometimes difficult to cover veterinary bills and medications. Do you have any suggestions?
— Greg in Austin, Texas

Pet care cially pet health care, have risen steadily over the past several years. Even routine care can take a bite out of your budget. And in all but a few cases pet owners must bear the cost of care.

You do have a few immediate options: Negotiate payments or care costs with the vet. While routine visits are usually required to be paid for up front, the vet may be willing to work with an owner to pay for treatment of acute ill-

nesses or long-term conditions.

—Financing through a service like CareCredit can close the gap between a vet visit and your next paycheck. Read the terms carefully, though; you may be better off paying with a major credit card when it comes to interest rates.

—Pet insurance can ease the financial burden of pet care, although you may only be able to insure your healthy cat. This insurance reimburses you for medical costs after treatment, so you'll still need to have a way to pay up front for your cats' care. Consumers Advocate recently rated its top 10 insurers.

What if you need more assistance in paying for your pets' care? Low-cost vaccination clinics in your area can help with routine care; assistance for more complex issues is provided by some animal care facilities. Best-Friends.org lists resources by state.



• My dad was a banker in Kansas, and I never saw him use a writing instrument that wasn't a fountain pen. I inherited one of his favorite ones, a Parker Duofold Senior. It is a beautiful pen, and I would like to know about when it was made. — Stan, Overland Park, Kansas

A Your pen was manufactured in 1958 and is quite collectible. I found it listed in "Collecting Pens," by Edward Kiersh and published by House of Collectibles. Kiersh values your pen at \$175, but this may be a little low since fountain pens have become a hot collectible and values have steadily risen. I occasionally write with a ly risen. I occasionally write with a "Big Red" from the 1930s, and it is one of the pleasures of life to write a note or letter with a vintage pen.

My grandparents immigrated to the United States from Europe in about 1920. Among the heirlooms they managed to bring with them is a set of sterling flatware in the Acanthus pattern by Georg Jensen. What can you tell me about it? — Martha, Waco, Texas

out Europe. His mark is distinctive: a wreath topped by a crown and the words "Georg Jensen, Inc." Georg Jensen Inc., USA, opened in New York in 1941, but closed within a decade.

Your pattern was introduced in 1917. Typical pieces of this pattern are three piece carving set, \$800; dinner knife, \$280; sugar tongs, \$190; and salad \$280; sugar tongs, \$190; and salad fork, \$120.

A • Quezal glass was made from • 1901 until about 1924 in the Queens, N.Y., studio of Martin Bach Sr. Other companies made similar art glass, including Loetz, Steuben and Tiffany. Since Quezal vases generally sell for well above \$1,000, my advice is to contact a reputable dealer or appraiser in your area and find out if your piece is authentic.
