

Dealing With Sin

My wife has a lot of family roots in Texas so stories I hear from there usually catch my attention more than others. Here is one that I particularly enjoyed. Back in 1873 there was a group of religious folks in Fort Worth that had grown quite concerned about the evil influence that the railroad was bringing to the cities of Texas. One of the primary concerns was how this exposure to evil and corruption would affect their young people.

So, in an attempt to escape this moral debauchery they migrated south of Fort Worth and established their

own little village. Within this village they established a school and called it Texas Christian University. Before long they began to advertise for others to come and live in their village and enroll their young in their school. Interestingly, they promoted the school with this unique phrase: "We are forty miles from the nearest sin". Unfortunately, that slogan was never true- - and for good measure the people who later moved there brought their own sins with them!

In reality, there is no such thing as moving away from sin in this world. In truth, the devil lives everywhere! You can find him at work, at school, at play, at home, next door, and even at church. In fact, Paul taught us that in order to avoid the presence of sin we would have to "go out of this world" (I Corinthians 5:10). That's a lot farther than a few miles out of town, don't you think?

Further, Peter teaches that "your adversary, the devil, walks around like a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour" (1 Peter 5:8). So, what is a person who desires to live for the Lord to do? Thankfully, Jesus himself gave us the solution to this problem by teaching us that we are "in the world" but not to be "of the world" (cf. John 17:16-18). In other words, you can't avoid sin's presence in life, but you can avoid its entrance into your life.

Another great passage that we need to keep close by is 1 Corinthians 10:13 which teaches: "No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it."

Hence, while it is impossible for us to avoid exposure to sin in this world; it is possible, with God's help, to deal with it successfully.



WHAT ARE THE **RULES AFTER A WRECK?**

I find certain questions to be frequently asked and the answers need to be known by everyone.

One of the rules about an automobile damage claim is that the liability carrier will pay for as little of a rental car as possible. The rental car company will ask you to pay for various fees and insurances that you may or may not need. This is a source of endless irritation for most

If you have a spare car, you might as well drive it rather than consider yourself entitled to a rental because the problems with a rental car and the unseen costs can be surprising and not in a good way.

The second problem that I see very frequently is when a car is totaled

and an offer is made. If you have owned a car and taken care of it, then you know that you have a reliable car, and that has a lot of value. The insurance company does not care. They can find ten cars just like yours and offer you the average of those ten and probably support that value in court. Certainly, there are instances where a lawyer could get you more but I certainly question whether or not you would get more by the time you pay an attorney.

When an offer is made on a totaled vehicle the insurance company is no longer required to pay for a rental car or storage costs. These add up quickly while people argue over the value of the wrecked car. I had a case where a lawyer who didn't do personal injury had allowed a car to sit in storage for two years over a \$1,100.00 difference at \$15.00 a day.

Typically, I tell people to take the offer and move on rather than argue and pay the costs. Now, if you have the vehicle towed to your home and you have a spare vehicle, you may argue about the value for a while.

Remember it doesn't cost anything to talk to a good personal injury lawyer, whether it's me or someone else. We don't charge for property damage – if they've offered you \$7,500.00, we may try and get you a little more but we're not going to take any portion of your \$7,500.00. We will not take a case where there is property damage only and we typically don't take cases where there is a very small injury such as where someone was treated in the ER and released and has had no further treatment. If you have been injured, we want to talk to you.





Dear Dave, How late is too late to get life insurance? Anonymous


Dear Anonymous, It's pretty easy to get term life insurance – the only kind of life insurance I récommend – up until around age 70. Depending on your overall health situation, there are a few affordable policies available past that point. But once you get into your seventies and beyond it can be difficult to find reasonably priced coverage.

I recommend that most people have 10 to 12 times their annual income wrapped up in a good, level term life insurance policy. But honestly, you shouldn't need life insurance at 70 or older. If you've been wise with your monev, and saved and invested, you should be self-insured by that point. This means having plenty of cash in the bank to cover burial expenses and enough for a spouse to live on after you're gone.

CROWDFUNDING REAL ESTATE?

Dear Dave,

I'd like to get involved in real estate investing, but I don't have a lot of cash at present. What do you think of the idea of crowdfunding as a way



to invest in real estate? Adam

Dear Adam,

I've got a bunch of real estate, and I love it. But I wouldn't go the crowd-funding route as a way to get started in real estate investing. I wouldn't give someone money to buy real estate in a crowdfund-

ing scenario, either. The late Beverly Sills had a great saying: "There are no shortcuts to anyplace worth going." Investing in real celebration in real estate is wonderful when you do it right. Get out of debt first, pay cash, and find great bargains. When you get in a hurry, and do dumb stuff like go into debt or get mixed up with partnerships in the process, real estate's a horrible investment.

The Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive occurs during an important time of year. School breakfast and lunch programs will be suspended for the summer months. Therefore, it is an important event to help local food pantries make up the shortfall.

"The Food Drive this year will be a little different. Instead of furnishing the food bags for the customers, we are asking the customers to furnish their own bags for their donations," said Steven McCrary, the Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive coordinator locally for NALC 892.

The Letter Carrier Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive is the outgrowth of a tradition of community service exhibited by NALC members over the last 125 years.

A number of branches collected food for those in need as part of local community service efforts over the years. Discussions were held by the NALC, USPS, and AFL-CIO to explore a more coordinated effort. A pilot drive in October of 1991 proved so successful that the parties worked to make it a nationwide effort.

Food banks and pantries suggested that late spring would be the best time for the drive. Most of their food donations are received over the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday periods, leaving the food shelves depleted by spring. In addition, school breakfast and lunch programs are not available during the summer. This places an even greater burden on local food pantries and food shelves.

A revamped drive was organized for the second Saturday in May of 1993. The goal was for at least one NALC local branch to participate in each of the 50 states. Over eleven million pounds of food were collected that day by over 220 union branches – a one day record in the United States. NALC branches collected over 80 million pounds of food in 2016 for a cumulative total of 1.5 billion pounds over the history of the drive.

It's up to us to make the 2017 drive the biggest drive yet. All donations from the event will benefit local people through local pantries and distribution channels.

Medicare Minute "Signing up for Medicare Part 1"

The most common way to qualify for Medicare is when you are turning 65. You will have a specific time period, set by Medicare, to enroll in Part A and Part B Medicare. This is known as the Initial Enrollment Period (IEP).

If you are qualifying for Medicare by turning 65 you will have a 7 month window to enroll in Medicare. This window is based off of the month you turn 65. It starts 3 months prior to the month you turn 65 and extends 3 months past the month you turn 65. For example, if you are turning 65 in September your IEP begins in June and extends all the way through the month of December. You can sign up for free Part A (if you're eligible) any time after you become eligible. If you have to buy Part A and/or Part B you can only sign up during a valid enrollment period.

For those electing to sign up for Part B after their IEP a late-enrollment penalty may be assessed. This penalty can last as long as you have Part B and there may be a gap in your health coverage. However, one exception to this rule is being employed and having coverage through your company's group health plan. If this applies to you check with your benefit coordinator, Medicare or contact our office.

In most cases, if you are already drawing your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board benefits you should automatically be signed up for Part A and Part B. If you are not drawing your Social Security or RRB benefits and want to sign up for Medicare you can do so by signing up online at ssa.gov, visit your local Social Security office or give our office a call and we can help direct you.

What is a kidney biopsy?

What is a kidney biopsy?

A kidney biopsy is a procedure that involves taking one or more tiny pieces of kidney tissue for examination under a regular microscope AND a highly-specialized electron microscope. A pathologist (a doctor who specializes in diagnosing diseases) examines the kidney tissue sample in a renal pathology lab to look for signs of kidney disease or

Why is a kidney biopsy needed?

Some kidney problems can often be found by blood and urine tests, a sonogram (an image made by ultrasound) or other specialized x-rays, and a physical examination rather than a biopsy. But in some patients with certain types of kidney disease, and those with a kidney transplant that is not working properly, a correct diagnosis can only be made with a kidney biopsy. The kidney tissue sample can show inflammation, scarring, infection, or unusual deposits of a protein called immunoglobulin.

Specific reasons to do a kidney biopsy include

• Blood in the urine (hematuria) or protein in the urine (proteinuria) • Acute or chronic kidney disease with no clear cause. If a person has chronic kidney disease - any condition that causes reduced kidney function over a period of time - the biopsy may show how quickly the disease is advancing. • Nephrotic Syndrome (which happens when the filtering units of the kidneys are damaged)

• A particular disease to see if it gets better with treatment or if it is getting worse. It may also show a problem that cannot be cured, but can be slowed down by other therapy. • If the kidney has been transplanted and is not working, a kidney biopsy may be helpful to identify the cause. • A kidney tumor.

A kidney biopsy is done in a hospital. An overnight stay may be needed to watch for any complications. You may be awake with only light sedation. You will be lying face down with a pillow under your rib cage. If the biopsy is done on a transplanted kidney, you will be lying on your back. The kidney tissue is taken using a needle placed through the skin over the kidney and guided to the right place in the kidney, usually with the help of ultrasound. The entire procedure, from start to finish, usually lasts about one hour. Sometimes the biopsy may take longer than an hour.

After the tissue sample is taken, work to study the biopsy is really just beginning. There are specially trained pathologists and laboratories with specialized equipment for reading and interpreting kidney biopsies. It often takes three to five days to get the full biopsy results. In some cases, you may have a partial or full report within 24 hours or less.

What Causes Anemia?

I will discuss a common condition called Anemia basically means that you don't have either enough red blood cells don't make enough red blood cells or hemoglobin, you have a harder time carrying oxygen in your blood to different parts of your body. Since oxygen is important fuel for your body, it can lead to symptoms such as fatigue, shortness of breath, lightheadedness and fainting.

way is when somebody develops what is called iron deficiency anemia or "low iron". Iron is an important what carries the oxygen on the red blood cells. Without enough iron in your system, your hemoglobin levels drop and the symptoms of anemia begin. A common cause of iron deficiency anemia is blood loss. Obviously, one can have a lot of blood loss if they have been involved in a traumatic accident, but the blood loss can often be more subtle. For instance, one may have slow bleeding from the gastrointestinal tract such as with a bleeding ulcer. Polyps and colon cancer can also cause iron deficiency anemia, so this is something that I always think about in patients with iron deficiency. Women with heavy menstrual periods can also develop anemia, sometimes to the point that they require supplementation or transfusions. One can also iron deficiency develop anemia if they are not absorbing iron properly through their digestive tract, such as what is seen in patients who have undergone gastric bypass surgery. Treating iron deficiency anemia involves identifying what is causing the iron deficiency and supplementing with iron when necessary.

While common, having low iron levels isn't the only reason one may have anemia.

This is because B12 and folic acid are needed to help make the DNA necessary to cause the new red blood cells to divide and multiply. As a result, you have less red blood cells floating around that are bigger in size but not functioning the way that they should. This is treated simply by supplementing B12 and folate. There are other causes of anemia out there, but these are the most common ones seen in practice. Always consult with your primary care provider before implementing any advice in this column.

unbridled refugee resettlements. In addition, voters wanted to secure religious freedom and a wall on the Southern border.

The house did make some amends on Thursday with the passing of the American Health Care Act that eliminates 80% of the \$553 million in federal funding of Planned Parenthood. Thus, the lives of thousands of unborn are protected for at least one year.

H.R. 1628 is considered a reconciliation bill, meaning that it only needs 51 votes in the Senate to pass and cannot be blocked by a Senate filibuster.

On Thursday President Trump also took a step toward re-establishing some religious freedom with an executive order.

I can't help wondering why this is so difficult. Why does anyone even vote republican if those elected can't unite on core conservative principles and objectives?

This second version of the GOP-led house healthcare bill still has Obamacare all over it. Predictably the dramatic whiners on the left are claiming that AHCA abandons those pre-existing conditions and that thousands will die. It's a fat-out lie. The AHCA not only retains coverage for those with pre-existing conditions it offers extensive layers of protection that cover even the most unlikely of unfortunate scenarios.

Some premiums may be more expensive in the legislation, but socialism GOP-style came to the rescue with increased funding for those individuals to help offset the higher premiums. That must be the contribution of the GOP moderates, creating yet another area where taxpayers will still have to cover those who put more pressure on the system.

The bill does allow individual states to establish work requirements for ablebodied Medicaid recipients who receive coverage, includes provisions eliminate the tax penalties on Americans who choose not to purchase insurance, converts insurance subsidies to tax credits that rise with a qualified person's age.

Are You SURE You're Ready to Sell?

Why are you considering selling? Is it because you know you're ready, and can visualize yourself in another house? If not, there may be external reasons. You have to decide if those reasons are valid. If there's no way around it, I'm sorry. That happens sometimes. People sometimes have to move before they are ready, and it is emotional. But just know that you get to take the most important parts of your home with you, no matter what: your family and the memories you've made there. The people living inside are what makes a house a home. As hard as it may be to accept now, you will make new memories at a new location, and will take the memories you made in your current home with you wherever you go.



in Fort Yargo State Park in Winder, GA, I am watching our daughter, Lora, with her community, a community that she has created through her business Freedom to Grow Unschool. Lora bought this business when she was twenty-three. FTGU is an alternative, democratic learning center for families who have chosen nontraditional means to educate their children. Today the community consisted of 15 children, Ruby (our granddaughter), 3 parents, 3 babies, 2 interns, Lora and me. Today is one of the last gatherings of the school year. Actually, it is one of the last gatherings of the unschool. Freedom to Grow Unschool will close

for good on May 11th. As I watch, I see water splashing, children chattering, sandy soccer balls flying, moms sharing and babies under sunhats smiling. All of these wethaired, sun-soaked people are just enjoying visiting with one another. No one is stressing. No one is fussing because the culture of this community has been set for quite some time. Lora and the children have predefined respect for each other. They have set their limits. They are kind to each other. They resolve their own conflicts because they have been trained how... "Stop, seriously." They use descriptive terms and they listen to each other because they know that they can learn from each other. These children are now best friends and so are their moms. Our daughter has had campouts, overnights,

As I lie on this blanket on this lakefront beach in Fort Yargo State Park in Winder, GA, I am watching our daughter, Lora, with her community, a community that she has created through her morning circles, farewell circles, community dinners at her house, and so much more to create one heart of freedom and safety for her participants and their families over the past six years.

These unschoolers and many more from the past done successful have and intriguing focus projects, creative units, and individual portfolio presentations. They have built true forts and handstarted fires, hosted dinners and retail sales, learned computer programming languages and drum rhythms. They have taught each other multiplication and fractions and have created word games and "Froggie". They have been sumo wrestlers, done mock trials, produced medieval festivals, created bullying videos, and have gotten letters answered by the president of the United States. These children have been the interior designers for the school and painted the un-bus. They have endeavored in community service and they have all been between the ages of 5 and 12 years old. To say that Freedom to Grow Unschool has been a success would be a tremendous understatement, but now it is time for it to close.

now is a time of change for our daughter and her family. FTGU is a spoton concept and has indeed been a passion of Lora's, but it has not created enough income for her family. Our daughter has decided "that it is time to make more money". It's a tough decision that we all have come to at different times. Deciding what the family needs and going after it is being responsible. I read somewhere once that on average women have at least five different careers in their lifetime because of their families. I have had more than five. One of the reasons that I left my job recently was because our last child finished college. I took that job when our about to go to college so that I could help cover some of the expenses. Mission accomplished! There is nothing but honor in doing what your family needs.

Time brings change and

Time creates the ebb and flow of life's decisions. You work to meet the needs of the present phase. My husband and I have been super proud of Lora's hard work toward FTGU, but her family has needs. She and her husband are doing what they need to do. As she joins a private school faculty as the only teacher of color, we say "Way to go Lora!" My second thought is "They don't know what just hit them!"
