

The Struggle to Find Pet-Friendly Housing

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I'm having a very hard time finding a new apartment where the management will allow my two cats. And those that do allow pets have really high pet fees. I'm not sure what to do. Is there a law or something that would force landlords to allow pets? After all, there are laws to keep animals off the street, but it seems like apartment rules banning pets may cause more pets to be abandoned. — *Christine B., Atlanta*

DEAR CHRISTINE: I wish I could say there were laws like that — you make a very good case for them. But I doubt that there are any laws like that on the books in the U.S.

While some might say you just need to keep looking for an apartment that takes pets and has reasonable fees, the reality is that fewer apartments allow pets at all. A new study by the National Association of Realtors surveyed homebuyers, and found that 61 percent said "it is very difficult or difficult to find a rental property or a homeowner association that accommodates animals." At the same time, 95 percent of buyers who are pet owners said that it's important for housing communities to allow animals.

Pet owners paid about \$150 a year in fees to communities — either association dues or rental applications — in 2016, the study said. But that didn't include fees like monthly dues for pets that some apartment communities charge.

For now, keep looking. Some new communities are adding pet-friendly features like dog parks, while others are revisiting their policies. Be prepared to pay a nonrefundable deposit for each pet, however, no matter how accommodating the apartment community is.





• "Use a large hair clip to hold your dish towel on the oven door handle." — *M.W. in Iowa*

• "An easy way to save money is when you write a check [or make a debit or check-card purchase], round it up to the nearest dollar in your checkbook register [or spreadsheet]. Do You Hear, but it's Not Clear?




The ear canal's job is to funnel sound to your ear drum. Sometimes the canal becomes plugged with wax, which mimics a hearing loss because it blocks sound from reaching your eardrum. Use of a cotton swab will pack wax even more. We will check for impacted wax with a video ear camera to see if this is a problem. sound between your ear drum and your cochlea. Otosclerosis is the calcification of these bones, resulting in conductive hearing loss. About 10% of people have this type of loss.

Hearing Problem #3

The cochlea is a snail-shaped organ containing thousands of living hair cells called stereocilia. A condition known as Sensorineural hearing loss (nerve type hearing loss) occurs when any of the hair cells become damaged. About 90% of hearing loss is this type. A new hearing computer has now been released that is programmed specifically for the frequencies of hair cells that are damaged, resulting in improved speech understanding.

Hearing Problem #4

Tinnitus is the phantom sensation of ringing in the ears. It is the result of damaged or misfiring nerves between the cochlea and the brain. A specialist will identify the tone of your tinnitus and demo how the hearing computer may reduce it. In a healthy cochlea, all hair cells are alive and standing upright. As sound waves move through the fluid within the cochlea, each hair cell fires and sends an electrical impulse through the Eighth Nerve to the brain.



Damaged hair cells don't fire properly and some sounds (fricatives and high tones) are not transmitted to the brain. Hair cell damage is a natural part of aging. It can be caused by moderate sounds over long periods, loud sounds over short periods, or even by prescriptions.



He doesn't just hook-up with singular supermodels, but tangles with a volleyball team's worth at a time. He can surf a tidal wave on his dirt bike. Be ready for the extreme, and you just might survive to the superfight at the end.

The Space Between Us (PG-13) -Gardner (Asa Butterfield) is the first human born on Mars, to a surprised astronaut mother who died during childbirth. As the only teen on Mars, Gardner has a hankering for Earth so he can meet with Tulsa (Britt Robertson), the girl he's been chatting with online. Besides the long-distance romance, he's also looking for his unidentified father and dealing with the threat that Earth's gravity could be fatal for his Mars-conditioned organs before he's done coming-of-age. The movie plays it fast and loose with




