I am a lifelong resident of Nunda and a graduate of Keshequa Central School. My daughter Olivia, also attended and graduated from Keshequa. I've been on the board since 2013 and it's been incredible the things I've learned.

I, like so many of you, grew up in Nunda and graduated from her great halls. I have, as I hope you do, many fond memories of attending Keshequa. I have always been proud of that. It is my hope that the students graduating from here now think the same thing. I want them to be proud to be a Keshequa graduate.

There is no reason why we can't continue to build Keshequa into being the best school district in the county. And I can honestly say right now, we're doing that!
