ATTENTION ALL NEW YORK CORN PRODUCERS

On April 5, 2017, the Kansas City federal judge dismissed the lone legal claim on which the Syngenta national class action was based. This is a litigation game changer. There no longer is a national class action protecting the legal rights of New York corn producers who chose to stay in the class and not opt out.

Every New York farmer who has grown corn for market since 2013 has been damaged, has a claim, and may participate in the corn lawsuit to recover money damages from Syngenta. At this juncture, however, the only way New York Corn farmers can participate in the Syngenta corn lawsuit and share in any recovery is to hire a lawyer and file an individual case.
