



James W. Rye from Montgomery Academy in Montgomery was the other Alabamian honored. He is a Fifth-Diamond recipient, the only such designee at that level.

The National Speech & Debate Association's Honor Society has been recognizing student and coach achievements in speech and debate since 1925. The prestigious diamond award recognizes a professional career that combines excellence and longevity in speech and debate.

Coaches earn distinction in the national honorary through team participation, student achievement, public service, and leadership work. To earn a diamond award, a coach must be a member of the National Speech & Debate Association for at least five years. Coaches earn additional diamond levels the more points they receive in the Honor Society. To think that so many (and a whole lot more) had paid the ultimate price for the freedoms and privileges that you and I enjoy daily is a humbling thought indeed. And what a debt of gratitude is due to each one of them!

Standing in the midst of tombstones that seemed endless in all directions and pondering that thought, my mind soon gravitated to the price that was paid for our spiritual liberty by the Son of God. Jesus was willing to undergo the atrocities of a Roman execution that ended with crucifixion so that you and I might be set free from sin and have the hope of eternal life in heaven (cf. Ephesians 1:7; 2 Corinthians 5:21 et

For that, we should be especially humbled and overflowing with gratitude. Shouldn't we also have a "Memorial Day" for Him? We do- - each first day of the week (cf. Matthew 26:28f; 1 Corinthians 11:23f).

eight-time Forrest Wood Cup qualifier. "The fish are going to be just getting out on the ledges so they haven't been pressured and will be easy to catch. Those schools will be really big and some of the guys will likely be able to catch fifty bass off one spot.

"There also a lot of smaller areas where you only catch five or six fish, but they weigh a bit more,' continued Canterbury. "This tournament could be won in the upriver current near the dam, down in the mid-lake eelgrass, or out on the ledges. It's going to come down to who can get that six or seven pounder to bite."

Canterbury swimbaits will be favored in this event, as well as big crankbaits and spoons on the ledges.

"When we competed there on Tour in 2016, Buddy Gross won it using a hair jig in eelgrass. So, look for that," said Canterbury. "Everyone was on the lower end on the ledges while he hit areas midlake. Spinnerbaits may also be a player in the eelgrass, but it's the tail-end of the shad spawn so we'll see."

The Alabama veteran said a three-day cumulative catch of seventy-three pounds should be enough o win it all.

"A 10-pounder could be caught any day," said Canterbury. "I wouldn't be surprised to see some FLWFishing.

SLIP AND FALL CASES

I have always handled slip and fall cases. Lawyers call these "premises liability" cases. We get a lot of calls and talk with potential clients about these cases but there are a lot more slip and falls than there are lawsuits.

Let me share with you how the law analyzes slip and fall or premises liability cases. The law presumes that all land is always owned by some person or entity. The law classifies people who occupy the land of another into three groups. These three groups are defined or decided by how they are using the property where they were

The first group of people and the most common source of viable slip and fall cases are people who are on

property for the benefit of the owner. That means if a person is injured while doing business in a store, they are an invitee. This would apply if they were buying insurance in an insurance agency or milk at the grocery store. These invitees are not "insured" against injury and there is no automatic (outside of workers compensation) liability for the property owner if someone is hurt. The property owner owes the person on their property the duty of keep their premises in a reasonably safe condition. What this means is that a store owner must not have a defect in the premises such as a door jam that is high or a floor that is wet or waxed without warning. A store owner is not responsible if another shopper spills or drops something slippery on the floor unless and until they either know that something is on the floor or enough time passes that they should have known. They are responsible if one of their own employees spills or drops something on the floor.

The second group of people are social guests. Those are defined by law as licensees and they may simply be a guest in a home. The duty owed to a licensee or a social guest is the warn them of known dangers. Obviously, they may not be willfully or wantonly injured. In other words, if you know of a dangerous condition that wouldn't be obvious, you have to warn them. If you know your stairs are slippery or shaky, either repair them, don't let others use them or put up a sign.

The third group of people are trespassers and as for people who are on land without the permission of the owner the duty owed to those people is that they may not be intentionally injured. There are cases where people have set traps or guns to go off in isolated cabins that have been broken into and that is absolutely prohibited by law. There are cases where land owners who used excessive force against a trespasser, such as

shooting them as they are leaving, were successfully sued.

The most common defense to grocery store and other premises liability cases is that the person who fell and was injured does not know and cannot say what caused them to fall and/or how long the substance had been on the floor. Another common defense is that whatever they tripped over or slipped on was out in the open and would have been obvious had the person been using ordinary caution. This is the open and obvious defense which is a form of contributory negligence. Buckle up and drive safely.



Medicare Minute 4 Parts of Medicare

Did you know there were four parts to Medicare not two? Did you know that two of the parts you can get through the federal government but the other two parts, if you choose to take them, must be purchased through private insurance companies? 

Memorial's **40th Event**

FLORENCE - A combined Memorial Day Ceremony and 40th Anniversary of the Florence-Lauderdale Veterans Memorial Museum takes place at 11am, Monday, May 29 in Veterans Park off of Cox Creek Parkway South.

The Florence-Lauderdale Veterans Memorial Museum was the dream of Anson Cooper, a U. S. Army, WW II Veteran who enlisted the aid of others to help the project become a reality. Its purpose was to perpetuate the memory of the men and women who fought and died for our country.

Monday's event is presented by Mayor Steve Holt and the City of Florence, Lauderdale County, American Legion Post #11, and the Veterans Memorial

Committee. They invite the public to join them. The Veterans Memorial Museum is believed to be unique in Alabama, and perhaps the nation. It was completed in 1975 and dedicated on May 30, 1977. The construction took several years, and when it was completed the cornerstone was laid. It tells the story of the Veterans Memorial – "BUILT BY PEOPLE WHO CARED"

1972 – 1975."

Additional military static displays have been added to the site over the years. The City of Florence and the American Legion Post #11 implemented plans to enhance the Veterans Memorial by restoring and adding static displays in 2002. These displays include an AH-1F Cobra Helicopter, a F-4D Phantom Jet, a Medal of Honor recipient display, a 75mm Howitzer, a Hawk Missile, a AGM-28 "Hound Dog" Missile, and historical markers listing all of the names of the Lauderdale County Veterans of WW I, WW II, the Korean, and the Vietnam Wars who paid the ultimate sacrifice in defense of their country. These memorials stand as symbols of the patriotism of the citizens of Lauderdale County.

Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend the commemoration of freedom and celebrate 40th Anniversary of the Museum.

Dear Editor:

Why do so many religious people resist using the name Yahweh in their worship and prayer when "Yahweh" is the authentic name of our Heavenly Father? The scriptures are absolutely clear on this point. Over and over throughout the scriptures, Yahweh reinforces the sanctity of his personal name, although few of us even bother to listen.

However, many other people who can't read the Hebrew need help because they've been incompletely or improperly educated in the Scriptures. affordable health care, gun rights, higher paying jobs, tax cuts and taxing the rich, criminal justice and social justice, etc.

Obviously, few candidates will fall away as the election approaches and some won't scratch in the primary. So many candidates virtually guarantees runoffs for both parties September 26, minimizing crossover However, it is possible for the two runoff candidates in each party to have less than 25% of the vote. Is that a true representation of the best two candidates from each party?

One thing is for sure. There will be far less attention to senate business now than had Governor Ivey not set a special election. Does the law mean voters should have the say ASAP? It is waste of taxpayer and political dollars, and creates more political ads crowding TV and radio air time. Did we not just get our fill of that?

Remember, this is a special election. The winner on December 12 has to turn around and defend the seat again only seven months later in the primaries for for 2018 midterms. We are literally in for perpetual campaigning.







of us How many remember that this day was originally called Decoration Decoration Day Day? was named after the American Civil War in 1868, when the Grand Army of the Republic, an organization of Union veterans of Decatur, Illinois, established it as a time for the nation to decorate the graves of the Union war dead with flowers. Today we place flags on the graves or our war dead instead to remember the ultimate sacrifices they made. What is a Buddy Poppy?

The Buddy Poppy was inspired by the poem "In Flanders Fields" by Colonel John McCrae of the Canadian forces before the US entered World War I. During the 1923 campaign the VFW evolved the idea which resulted in the VFW Buddy Poppy. Fashioned disabled veterans who were paid for their work as a practical means of providing assistance those comrades. This plan was formally presented for adoption to the 1923 encampment of the VFW at Norfolk, Virginia. Disabled veterans assembled the poppys at a factory in Pittsburgh, PA. The designation "Buddy Poppy" was originated Poppy" with the men themselves and was adopted at that time and patented in Washington DC. American Legion followed suit and adopted the same plan in 1923, at New Orleans.

House Calls with Dr. Barco

How Do I Get Better Sleep?

This week on House Calls, I discuss insomnia, which affects millions of Americans and can can certainly be a challenge and there is no one magic pill or technique that will help everyone. A mistake that is sometimes made is thinking that the only way to get sleep is through medication without trying non-medication techniques The foundation of managing insomnia should be proper sleep hygiene. What I mean by that is having the best habits possible to promote sleep. For starters, you want to make sure that the environment you are sleeping in at night is conducive to sleep. The room should be dark, free of electronics that are emitting light, and with a temperature set slightly cool. You should also ensure that your mattress is comfortable and that the room is quiet (faint, consistent, background noise may be ok for some people but avoid playing the television or radio). Don't do anything on the bed besides sleeping or having intimate relations; reading or doing work on the bed is a big no-no. During the day, avoid napping as this robs you of sleep later in the night. If you must nap, don't nap for more than 45 minutes in a day. A common piece of advice is also to avoid caffeine later in the day. Since caffeine can linger in your system for several hours, it is best to not consume any caffeine after 2pm for someone going to bed around 9 or 10 pm. In fact, some folks have to hold off on caffeine as early as noon. It is also helpful to try to avoid watching television or computer screens a few hours before going to bed, as the light from those devices can stimulate the brain to make histamine, which promotes wakefulness. Going to bed at a consistent time also helps promote proper sleep patterns. If it is taking you more than 15-20 minutes to get to sleep once you lay in the bed, get up and sit in a dark room until the


sleepiness sets back in.

If maintaining proper sleep hygiene is not doing the trick, there is another technique that lead to a poor quality of life can be tried before resorting because of the consequences to medicine called sleep it carries. Treating insomnia compression. This is how it works. The patient is asked to collect a sleep diary estimating how much time they lay in the bed at night and how of that time is actually spent sleeping. The patient presents the sleep diary to their primary care provider who will then gradually cut down the amount of time the patient is allowed to stay in the bed to match the actual amount of time that is spent sleeping. For example, if you lay in the bed for 8 hours but only sleep 4, you will be given a schedule that will end with you only laying in the bed for 4 hours on a given night. During those precious 4 hours, it is likely that you will spend most of it asleep. After a little while of doing this, the amount of time is gradually increased, with the hope that you will spend more time asleep in the bed.

While many people do well with proper sleep hygiene and sleep compression therapy, there are some that require medication therapy. recognize now that the brain has two kinds of signals that affect sleep, a signal promotes sleepiness and another that promotes wakefulness. Many of the medicines for sleep increase the sleepiness signal and that can work well for some patients. Others slow down the signal that promotes wakefulness, which may be appropriate for other patients. The strategy to getting proper whether involving medication or not, should always be discussed with your primary care provider.


