ABANDON WILDLIFE **BABIES**

The first call about finding an abandoned fawn came to me last week, and I'm sure there will be more the next month or so as does will be dropping their fawns. Sure there are instances where a doe may have been hit on the road, thus leaving her fawn or fawns without a mother, but does just don't abandon their fawns. You may not see her, but she is nearby and is probably watching you!



Leave them be!

For the first week or so of their lives fawns remain hidden on the ground and do not travel with their mother. If a danger such as a human gets near them they remain motionless, depending on their camouflage to hid them. Their scent strength at this time is low and this also helps to prevent detection. Studies have also shown that their heart rate drops tremendously at this early stage when danger approaches. This cuts down the amount of breath scent and noise further, protecting the fawn.

After about a week the fawn will usually get up and run when danger gets too close. He will also get up and wander around from where his mother has left him. Wait! Where his mother has left them? Yes, until he is about three weeks old the doe does not spend much time near the fawn. She only goes to him to let him nurse about four or six times in a 24-hour period. The purpose of this habit is to cut down on the amount of deer scent near the fawn so predators do not find the fawn. In fact, if a doe has twins she usually hides them separately, sometimes as much as 200 feet apart so if one is detected by a predator the other has a good chance of not being found. After a week or so he may do some exploring on his own and get in some trouble, but ma is near by and will "save" him.

After three weeks the fawn will start to travel with the doe. It is the first few weeks of its life that people find a fawn and mistakenly think it has been abandoned, lost or the mother is dead. They then try to "save" the fawn taking it, which is illegal and usually ends up causing its death.

If you find a fawn, leave it be and stay away from it as your scent trail can lead a predator such as a coyote, dog or even fox to it as they often will scent trail a human out of curiosity. The mother is nearby, usually watching you, so just leave the area.

If you see a fawn and you know the mother is dead (such as a doe near by on the road) it is still not a smart thing to get involved. The best thing to do is call the local DEC officer and let him or her handle the situation. The officer to call in our area is Vernon Fonda, who can be reached at 585-735-6963 or Gary Wilson, at 585-683-0773.

Baby raccoons are another "cute" and "abandoned" problem. Again, it is illegal to have any wildlife, but with a raccoon there is a even more risky problem – rabies! Raccoon fur is almost worthless the last few years and so not many sportsmen are trapping or hunting them and thus their numbers are high. Raccoon are very susceptible to rabies, and if the mother has it so will the babies. It may not show, but it can be there and it is not worth the risk of dying for. If your dog tangles with a raccoon and it has rabies and then you handle the dog, you could get the virus transferred to you if you have just a small skin break and there is raccoon saliva on the dog. Just call the local conservation officer. Baby squirrels are also another "abandoned" problem. They will often wander around on their own when mother is not there and may seem friendly, but their bite can be very nasty and they are usually loaded with fleas and ticks. Leave them be! Speaking of ticks, there has been a large increase of Lyme disease in NYS in recent years and it seems to be getting worse. It is not the larger dog tick that is the problem, it's the tiny deer tick that is often not noticed. Lyme disease can be crippling for humans and pets, so you need to take precautions. Using tick spray on your pants and keeping your pants bloused are good habits to get into. When returning from an outdoor outing check out yourself for any signs of ticks and see a doctor if you develop a red circle rash or have any of the signs of the disease. There is medication your pet can take and if your pet spends time outside you will want to invest in this.
